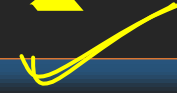

Parts of speech

NOUN:- acts as subject/object

E.g. Kunal sang a song.
(N)S V Obj (N)

verb → What/whom
= Obj

PRONOUN:- comes in place of noun

E.g. He sang a song.
S(P) V Obj (N)

VERB:- represents action

E.g. Kunal sang a song.
Sub(N) verb obj (N)

ADJECTIVE:- qualifies a noun or pronoun

E.g. Kunal sang a romantic song.
S(N) v Adj. Obj (N)

ADVERB:- qualifies a verb, adjective, adverb

E.g. Kunal sang a song sweetly.

S(N) V Obj(N) Adv

CONJUNCTION:- joins two words or clauses

E.g. Rahul and Dinesh sang a song.

S(N) Conj S(N) V Obj(N)

PREPOSITION:- relates a noun or pronoun
with other words of a sentence

E.g. Kunal sang a song in the class.

S(N) V Obj(N) prep Noun (Prep Obj)

INTERJECTION:- expresses feelings or
emotions

Int S(P) V Obj(N)

E.g. Hurray ! We won the match.

$S(N)$ Verb Prep \leftarrow $PO(N)$

2) *Common* – Student, City, Book, Monument, etc.] countable

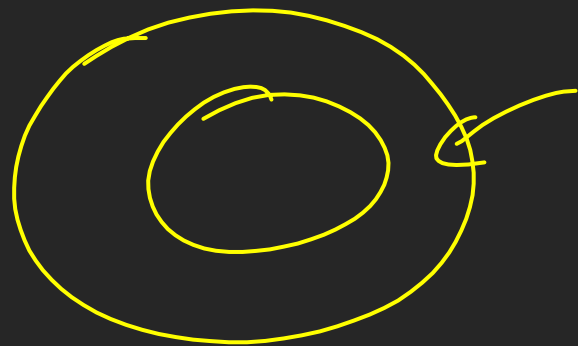
3) *Collective* – Team, Jury, Gang, Bevy, etc]
