Discontent	Not being at peace with a situation or circumstance
Compress	To flatten something by pressure
Rife	In a great quantity
Fascinating	Capable of arousing and holding the attention
Indivisible	Impossible of undergoing division
Indelible	Difficult to remove or wash away
Pensive	Deeply thinking about something especially because you are worried
Obsequious	Excessively submissive; Overly obedient
Dilemma	A situation in which you have to make a tough choice
Assault	A physical attack
Sordid	Very bad or dirty
Forfeit	To lose or give up something
Coincide	Existing at the same time
Exaggerate	To make something seem larger or better than it really is
Tempting	Able to attract someone
Uncanny	Strangely weird
Subterfuge	Trickery or deceit used to achieve one's goals
Agitated	Troubled emotionally and usually deeply

Penitent	feeling or expressing remorse for misdeeds
Barbaric	Cruel and violent / uncivilized
Integrate	To come together or be put together
Omission	Remove or not include something
Seizure	The act of taking a person or thing into custody
Hoax	an act to make someone believe something (unpleasant) that is not true
Agile	Able to move fast and easily
Ruin	To damage
Radiant	Shining with happiness
Delicate	Easily broken or damaged
Glee	Intense happiness or joy
Prodigal	Wasteful in spending money
Populous	Densely populated
Impasse	A situation that stops progress
Restrain	To control or restrict
Lethal	That can cause great damage or death
Implementation	The process of putting a plan into action
Impute	To lay the responsibility or blame on someone else
Consciousness	Awareness of the mind / be in senses
