Valor	Courage in the presence of danger
Guilty	Responsible for wrongdoing
Established	Brought about or set up
Immoral	not adhering to ethical principles

Cogent	Simple for the mind to accept and believe
Advisable	Worthy of being recommended
Interdiction	An official order stopping a person from doing a task
Nonchalant	Relaxed and calm in a way that shows you do not care or are not worried about anything
