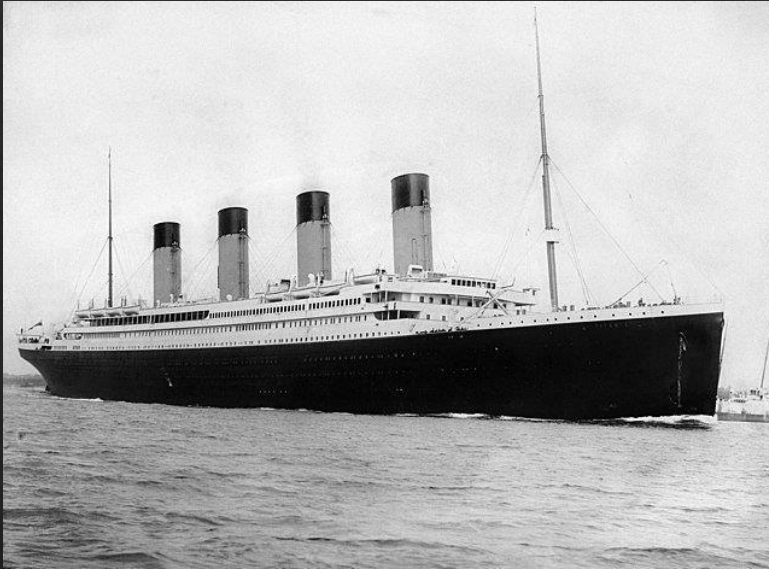


Titanic :- extremely large (आकार या शक्ति में बहुत ही विशाल और बड़ा)

Mnemonics :- Titanic ship



Synonyms: - Huge, Colossal, Gigantic

Antonyms:- Tiny, Small,

E.g.:- The company faced titanic challenges as it tried to expand into new markets.

Implicate :- to show or suggest that someone is involved in a crime or wrongdoing. (किसी को अपराध या गलत काम में फंसाना)

Mnemonics :- he broke our gate isliye humne kiya usko implicate

Synonyms: - Accuse, Incriminate, Involve

Antonyms:- Exonerate, Vindicate, Exclude

E.g.:- If the evidence is found, it will implicate the person behind the brutal act.

Discriminate :- To recognize or show a difference between things, often by making fine distinctions. (भेदभाव करना या अंतर समझना)

Mnemonics :- this cream ate only by son

Synonyms: - Differentiate, Segregate, Distinguish

Antonyms:- Equate, Integrate, Combine

E.g.:- Parents should not discriminate among their children.

Remission :- to the forgiveness or cancellation of a debt, charge, or penalty.
(किसी कर्ज़, चार्ज या पेनल्टी को माफ़ करना या रद्द करना।)

Mnemonics :- Re tune ye mission poora kar dia to tuje remission de denge

Synonyms: - absolution, amnesty, exemption,

Antonyms:- Relapse, Punishment, Aggravation

E.g.:- He was given three months' remission for good behaviour.



Frivolity:- lack of seriousness; light-heartedness. (गंभीरता की कमी या ओछापन/मजाक)

Mnemonics :-free aur vele baith ke frivolity wali baaten hi karte hain

Synonyms: - Triviality, Insignificance, Playfulness

Antonyms:- Gravitas, Sobriety, Earnestness

E.g.:- You shouldn't treat such a serious subject with frivolity.

Austere :- severe or strict in manner or attitude. (व्यवहार या रवैये में कठोर या सख्त)

Mnemonics :- our strict teacher



Synonyms: - Severe, Stern, Ascetic

Antonyms:- Luxurious, Lavish, Lenient

E.g.:- He was a tall, austere, forbidding figure.

Lousy :- very poor in quality, unpleasant or unsatisfactory
(बहुत ही घटिया या बहुत बुरा)

Mnemonics :- lazy admi to lousy kaam hi karega

Synonyms: - Awful, Pitiful, Subpar

Antonyms:- Excellent, Fantastic, Wonderful

E.g.:- The government does a lousy job when it comes to managing floods.

Peculiar :- unusual, strange, or distinct from what is normal or expected. (अजीब या जो सामान्य से थोड़ा अलग हो)

Mnemonics :- pikku ka cooler ka bda hi peculiar

Synonyms: - Eccentric, Distinctive, Unique

Antonyms:- Normal, Ordinary, Typical

E.g.:- He had a peculiar way of arranging his books that only he understood.

Affirm :- to publicly verify something (किसी बात को दावे के साथ सच बताना)

Mnemonics :-usne affirm kiya ki uska decision firm hai.

Synonyms: - Confirm, Assert, Endorse

Antonyms:- Deny, Refute, Reject

E.g.:- The army recruits affirm their commitment to the country by taking an oath.

Sceptical :- having doubts that a claim or statement is true or that something will happen (जिस पर विश्वास करना मुश्किल हो और शक हो)

Mnemonics :- jiska dimag shak pe tika

Synonyms: - Distrustful, Cynical, Suspicious

Antonyms:- Trustful, Believing, Confident

E.g.:- She was sceptical about the new study's findings, as they seemed too good to be true.

Attire:- one's dress or clothes (पहनने के कपड़े या औपचारिक पोशाक)

Mnemonics :- attire try kar kar ho gyi tired



Synonyms: - clothing, Apparel, Garb

Antonyms:- Disrobe, Undress, Nakedness

E.g.:- I hardly think jeans are appropriate attire for a wedding.

Alleviate:- to make something less severe (किसी दर्द या परेशानी को कम करना)

Mnemonics :- I ate medicine to alleviate pain

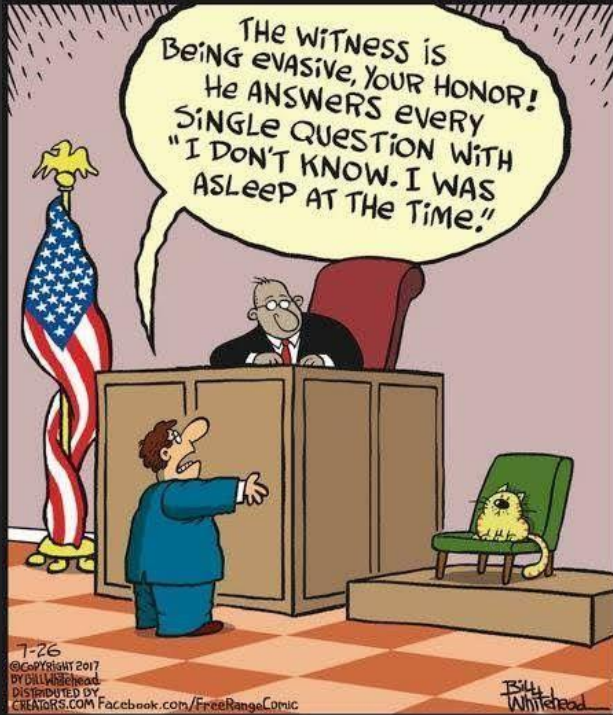
Synonyms: - Reduce, Mitigate, Soothe

Antonyms:- Aggravate, Exacerbate, Worsen

E.g.:- You should use this gel it can alleviate your back pain.

Evasive:- not straightforward or honest (टालने वाला)

Mnemonics :- evade



Synonyms:- Ambiguous, Vague, Avoidant

Antonyms:- Direct, Clear, Frank

E.g.:- Anjali was evasive about why she had not been at home that night.

Homilies:- a speech or piece of writing giving advice on the correct way to behave, etc. (नैतिक उपदेश)

Mnemonics :- home me lie nhi karte ye ek homily hai

Aman Sir English



Synonyms: - Homilies, Lectures, Preaching

Antonyms:- Silence, Absence of preaching

E.g.:- I don't need homilies from him about how to lead my life.

Candid:- to being honest, straightforward, and open in expression (साफ-साफ बोलने वाला)

Mnemonics :- candid interview



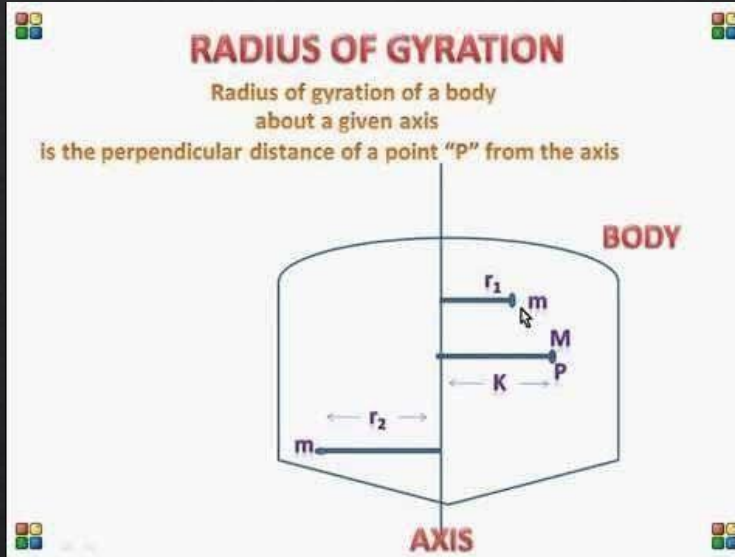
Synonyms:- Frank, Direct, Sincere

Antonyms:- Deceitful, Guarded, Insincere

E.g.:- The two presidents have had candid talks about the current crisis.

Gyration:- the act of turning quickly in a circle is gyration. (गोल घूमना)

Mnemonics :- rotation



Synonyms: - Revolution, Rotation, Spin

Antonyms:- Stillness, Stability, Immobility

E.g.:- Gyration in this manner will help in relieving your pain.

Reckon:- to calculate an amount, a number, etc. (अनुमान लगाना)

Mnemonics :- re kon kon aaye hain reckon karo



Synonyms:- Calculate, Estimate, Consider

Antonyms:- Disregard, Ignore, Mistrust

E.g.:- The age of the earth is reckoned at about 4.6 billion years.

Dainty :- something that is delicately small and pretty (छोटा और सुंदर)

Mnemonics :- daina ko dainty jewellery hi pasand hai

Synonyms: - Elegant, Graceful, Exquisite

Antonyms:- Clumsy, Coarse, Rough

E.g.:- She wore a dainty silver bracelet that complimented her elegant evening gown.

Fecundity :- the ability to produce children, crops, etc. (उपजाऊपन)

Mnemonics :- ye hen bhut ande deti hai ye fecund hai

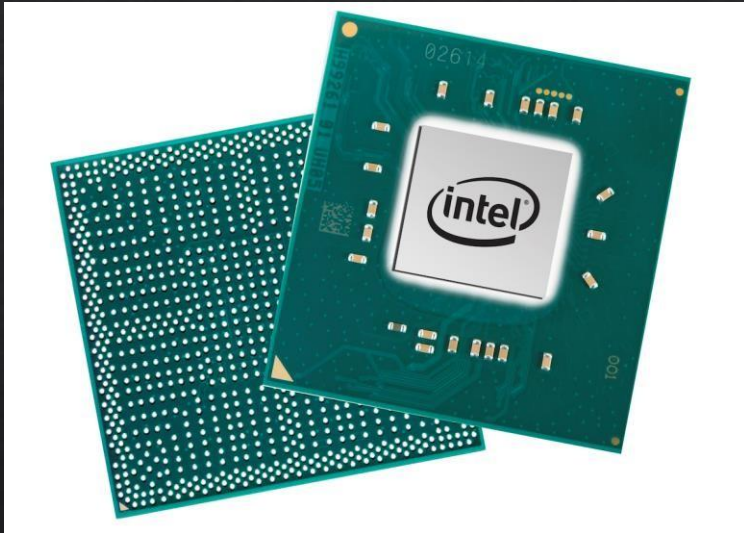
Synonyms: - Fertility, Productivity, Generativity

Antonyms:- Sterility, Infertility, Drought

E.g.:- Fecundity declines rapidly after the age of 40.

Entail :- to make something necessary, or to involve something.
(आवश्यक बनाना)

Mnemonics :- Intel Ki chip ko computer mein entail karna bahut jaruri hai Aman Sir English



Synonyms: - encompass, involve, necessitate

Antonyms:- Exclude, Prevent, Omit

E.g.:- The holiday party for three hundred guests will entail a lot of work from the event planner.

Grisly :- Causing horror or disgust; gruesome. (भयानक या डरावना)

Mnemonics :- Grizzly bear is grisly

Synonyms: - Horrifying, gruesome, ghastly,

Antonyms:- Pleasant, delightful, cheerful, appealing.

E.g.:- The grisly details of the crime scene left everyone feeling deeply unsettled.

Concordant :- in agreement with something (मिलता-जुलता)

Mnemonics :- accord / according to something



Synonyms: - Harmonious, agreeable, compatible.

Antonyms:- Discordant, conflicting, incompatible,

E.g.:- The findings are concordant with similar studies in other countries.

Insipid :- having almost no taste (फीका या बेस्वाद)

Mnemonics :- insipid hai ye ek sip tak nhi le sakta iski



Synonyms: - Bland, dull, tasteless

Antonyms:- Flavorful, exciting, stimulating

E.g.:- The soup was insipid, lacking any distinct flavor.

Indigent :- Lacking basic necessities of life due to poverty (दरिद्र या गरीब)

Mnemonics :- India ki bhut saari janta indigent hai

Synonyms:- destitute, needy, impoverished

Antonyms:- Wealthy, affluent, prosperous

E.g.:- The charity provides assistance to indigent families.

Strive :- to work hard towards a goal. (कड़ी मेहनत करना)

Mnemonics :- strive to learn how to drive



Synonyms:- Endeavor, labor, struggle

Antonyms:- idle, procrastinate, give up.

E.g.:- I will strive to win the race.

Felicity :- a state of happiness (परम सुख)

Mnemonics :- festival ke time jab city decorated hoti hai to felicity feel hoti hai

Aman Sir English



Synonyms: - Bliss, joy, delight,

Antonyms:- Misery, sorrow, gloom.

E.g.:- She was filled with felicity when she received the news of her promotion.

Frisky :- full of energy; wanting to play (चंचल और फुर्तीला)

Mnemonics :- frisky hona acha baat hai but risky kaam mat karna



Synonyms: - Playful, energetic, spirited

Antonyms:- Lethargic, sluggish, tired

E.g.:- The puppy was frisky, running around the yard.

Embezzlement :- the act of stealing money that you are responsible for or that belongs to your employer (पैसे या धन का गबन या हेराफेरी करना)

Mnemonics :- apne bag me daal lena management ka paisa

Aman Sir English



Synonyms: - theft, fraud, pilfering.

Antonyms:- Honesty, integrity, reimbursement

E.g.:- She was found guilty of embezzlement.

Insolent :- Showing a rude and arrogant lack of respect. (बदतमीज या ढीठ)

Mnemonics :- insulting ya rude way me baat karne wala

Synonyms: - Rude, disrespectful, impudent

Antonyms:- Polite, courteous, humble.

E.g.:- The student's insolent behavior towards the teacher shocked the entire class.

Deprived :- Suffering from a lack of basic material benefits or necessities. (सुविधाहीन या वंचित)

Mnemonics :- Deprived bache private schools nhi ja paate

Synonyms: - Impoverished, destitute, needy

Antonyms:- Privileged, affluent, prosperous

E.g.:- They are probably the most deprived children in the whole city.

Plethora :- A large or excessive amount of something. (जरूरत से ज्यादा)

Mnemonics :- Thoda nhi hai plethora hai plate bhar lo

Synonyms: - Abundance, surplus, profusion.

Antonyms:- Scarcity, lack, deficiency.

E.g.:- The plethora of regulations is both contradictory and confusing.

Lullaby :- A soothing song or melody, typically sung to help a child fall asleep. (सुलाने वाली लोरी)

Mnemonics :- baby sulane ke liye lullaby use karte hain

Aman Sir English



Synonyms: - Cradle song, sleep song,

Antonyms:- Noise, clamor, racket.

E.g.:- The mother softly sang a lullaby to her baby.

Envoy :- A person sent as a representative on a special diplomatic mission. (दूत या प्रतिनिधि)

Mnemonics :- Envoy karta hai govt ka message convey

Synonyms: - Messenger, delegate, ambassador

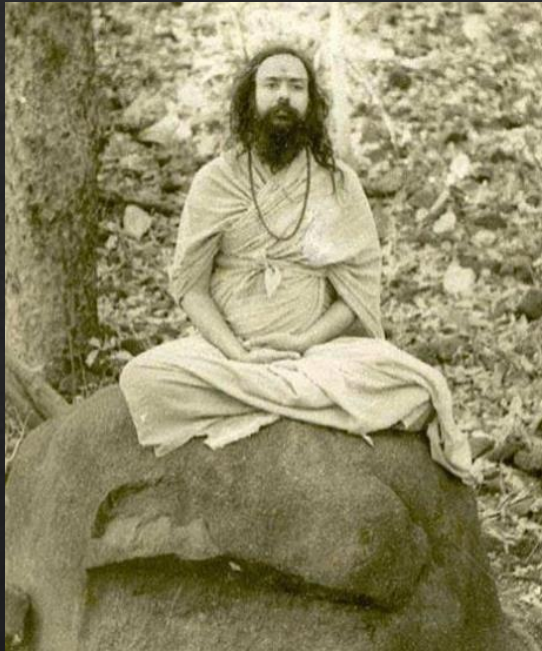
Antonyms:- resident, non-representative.

E.g.:- The president sent an envoy to negotiate a peace treaty between the two countries.

Anchorites :- a religious person who lived alone and avoided other people (एकांतवासी संन्यासी)

Mnemonics :- inhone chor dia sab

Aman Sir English



Synonyms: - Hermits, recluses, ascetics.

Antonyms:- Socialites, extroverts, etc

E.g.:- The anchorites lived a life of solitude and prayer in their remote hermitages.

Confiscate :- to officially take something away from somebody especially as a punishment (जब्त करना)

Mnemonics :- confess kar nhi teri property karenge confiscate

Synonyms: - Appropriate, Expropriate, Impound.

Antonyms:- Return, release, restore.

E.g.:- According to school policy, the principal has the authority to confiscate suspicious items from students.

Abscond :- escape into hiding; to leave quickly and hide to avoid punishment (चुपके से भागना)

Mnemonics :- Wo kaand karke kar gaya abscond

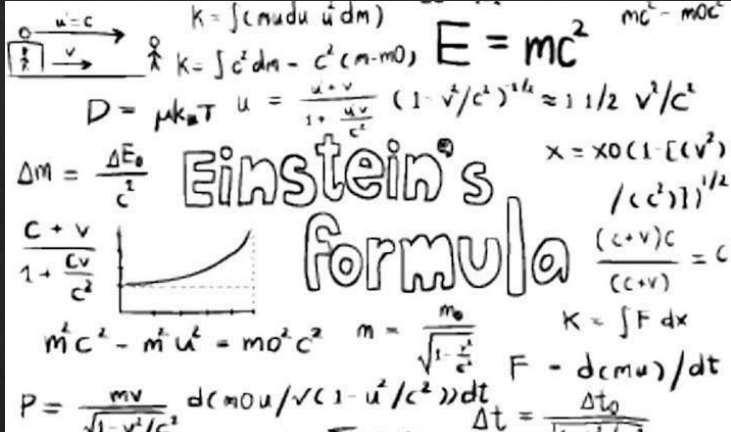
Synonyms: - Flee, Escape, decamp

Antonyms:- Stay, Abide, Avoid

E.g.:- He absconded from the trial, leaving the court without permission.

Interpret :- explain or understand the meaning of something (अर्थ समझाना)

Mnemonics:-inn presentations ko mai interpret nhi kar paa rha hun Aman Sir English



Synonyms:- Clarify, Decipher, Construe

Antonyms:- Obscure, Misconstrue, Misinterpret

E.g.:- His silence was interpreted as a sign of agreement.

Ablaze :- burning fiercely; in a blaze; on fire (जलता हुआ)

Mnemonics :- flames

Synonyms: - Burning, Fiery, Ignited

Antonyms:- Extinguished, dim, dark

E.g.:- The building was ablaze, sending bright flames high into the night sky.

Ascend :- to rise; to go up; to climb up (ऊपर चढ़ना)

Mnemonics :- accent car hills me bhi asani se ascend kar jati hai



Synonyms: - Elevate, Soar, Climb

Antonyms:- Descend, Fall, Decline

E.g.:- The hikers began to ascend the mountain early in the morning.

Venom :- the poisonous liquid that some snakes, spiders, etc. produce when they bite or sting you (जहर या नफरत)



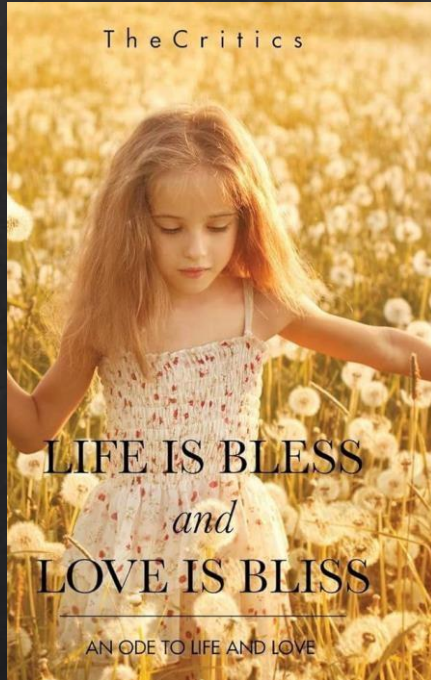
Synonyms: - Poison, Toxin, Malice

Antonyms:- Antidote, Benevolence, Kindness

E.g.:- The snake injected venom into its prey with a bite.

Bliss:- perfect happiness or enjoyment (अत्यधिक खुशी)

Mnemonics :- bless me with bliss



Synonyms: - Euphoria, Ecstasy, Contentment

Antonyms:- Misery, Sorrow, Agony

E.g.:- Lying on a sunny beach in Goa is my idea of perfect bliss.

Luminous:- shining in the dark; giving out light (चमकदार)

Root word :- lumen (light)



Synonyms: - Radiant, Lustrous, Bright

Antonyms:- Obscure, Shadowy, Dull

E.g.:- The luminous stars lit up the night sky, creating a breathtaking view.

Retract:- to refuse to keep an agreement, a promise, etc. (बयान वापस लेना)

Mnemonics :- Re + track

Aman Sir English



Synonyms: - Revoke, Renounce, Recede

Antonyms:- Assert, Reaffirm, Confirm

E.g.:- Soldiers of both the countries retracted after the ceasefire.

Petty:- small and insignificant (तुच्छ या मामूली)

Mnemonics :- agar mai pretty hoti to itni petty tip na milti





Synonyms: - Trivial, Narrow, Unimportant

Antonyms:- Significant, Major, Grand

E.g.:- She became angry when he picked up the petty tip left by the customer.

Assume:- to suppose to be true, especially without proof (मान लेना)

Mnemonics :- assumption/ aas lgana ki kuch sach hai

Synonyms: - Presume, Believe, Take on

Antonyms:- Prove, Reject, Disregard

E.g.:- It is never wise to automatically assume anything to be true, especially without any kind of proof.

Condemn:- to express strong disapproval of something or someone (निंदा करना)

Mnemonics:- jab uske father ne usse condom buy karte pakda to [Aman Sir English](#) condemn kiya.



Synonyms: - Denounce, Criticize, Blame

Antonyms:- Praise, Acquit, Commend

E.g.:- The council condemned the company for its unethical business practices, urging people to boycott its products.

Mourn:- to feel or express deep sorrow or grief (शोक मनाना)

Mnemonics :-Mourn ke time 2 minutes ka maun rakha gya.

Synonyms: - Grieve, Lament, Sorrow

Antonyms:- Rejoice, Celebrate, Exult

E.g.:- The entire community gathered to mourn the loss of their beloved leader.

Bind :- to tie somebody/something with rope, string, etc. (बांधना या जोड़ना)

Mnemonics :- bandha hua / bond

Synonyms: - Secure, Obligate, Confine

Antonyms:- Release, Free, Liberate

E.g.:- The contract will legally bind both parties to the terms and conditions agreed upon.

Hypothesis :- a proposed explanation or theory that is studied through scientific testing (शुरुआती धारणा)

Mnemonics :- guess

Synonyms: - Theory, conjecture, assumption

Antonyms:- Fact, certainty, conclusion

E.g.:- Each student gave a hypothesis and theorized which plant would grow the tallest during the study.

Warm :- showing affection, kindness, or enthusiasm.
(हल्का गरम या व्यवहार में बहुत मिलनसार)

Mnemonics :- warm welcome, warm hug

Synonyms: - cozy, friendly, affectionate.

Antonyms:- chilly, distant, indifferent.

E.g.:- Her smile was warm and friendly.

Enormous :- Extremely large in size, quantity, or extent.
(आकार या मात्रा में बहुत ही विशाल)

Mnemonics :- this bus is enormous

Synonyms: - Huge, immense, colossal

Antonyms:- Tiny, small, minute

E.g.:- The bus was so enormous that it could fit at least 500 people.

Antique:- old and often valuable (बहुत पुरानी और कीमती वस्तु)



Synonyms: - ancient, Vintage, Historic

Antonyms:- Modern, Contemporary, Recent.

E.g.:- This antique gramophone was gifted to me by my uncle who lives in Germany.
