

**1. Wily:-** skillful in deception (बहुत चालाक और शातिर इंसान)

**Mnemonics:-** lily bhut wily hai 5 ladko ko dhoka de chuki hai

Aman Sir English



**Synonyms:-** Crafty, Cunning, Crooked

**Antonyms:-** Honest, Frank, Forthright

**Eg:-** The casino manager banned the wily gambler for counting cards.

**2.Opulent:-** Rich and superior in quality (शानो-शौकत और अमीरी से भरा)

**Mnemonics:-** apan rent pe thode rahenge apan opulent hain



**Synonyms:-** Lavish, Palatial, Sumptuous

**Antonyms:-** Economical, Poor, Depressed

**Eg:-** Because the movie star made over ten million dollars a film, she was able to maintain an opulent lifestyle.

**3.Discontent:-** Not being at peace with a situation or circumstance  
(असंतोष या मन की नाराजगी)

**Mnemonics:-** dis + content

**Synonyms:-** Dissatisfaction, Depression, Uneasiness

**Antonyms:-** Contentedness, Satisfaction, Pleasure

**Eg:-** Discontent filled the heart of the underpaid worker .



**4. Compress:-** To flatten something by pressure (दबाकर छोटा या कम करना)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** press karke compact kar dia



**Synonyms:-** Abbreviate, Constrict, Cram

**Antonyms:-** Amplify, Enlarge, Expand

**Eg:-** The diner found his sandwich to be too big for his mouth and used his hands to compress it down.

**5.Rife:-** In a great quantity (बहुत अधिक मात्रा में)

**Mnemonics:-** wo rice rife quantity me khata hai /  
wife ka wardrobe is rife with clothes

**Synonyms:-** Abundant, Plentiful, Rampant

**Antonyms:-** Scarce, Limited, Uncommon

**Eg:-** The beach is rife with young people during the summer months.

**6.Fascinating:-** Capable of arousing and holding the attention  
(बहुत आकर्षक और दिलचस्प चीज)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** her face is fascinating



**Synonyms:-** Intriguing, Bewitching, Alluring

**Antonyms:-** Boring, Repellent, Repulsive

**Eg.:-** The most fascinating aspect of space is how the universe is expanding.

**7.Indivisible:-** Impossible of undergoing division (जिसे अलग न किया जा सके)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** in( not ) + divisible



**Synonyms:-** United, Unified, Inseparable

**Antonyms:-** Separable, Divisible, Fragile

**Eg:-** Army men are indivisible because they consider the nation is above any religion .

**8. Indelible:-** Difficult to remove or wash away (अमिट निशान जो मिट न सके)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** in( not) + delete



**Synonyms:-** Lasting, Enduring, Stirring

**Antonyms:-** Delible, Erasable, Destructible

**Eg:-** After the kindness he has shown to our family during this difficult time, he will always have an indelible place in all our hearts.

**9. Pensive:-** Deeply thinking about something especially because you are worried (गहरे ख्यालों या सोच में डूबा)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** pension na milne ki wajah se pensive



**Synonyms:-** Contemplative, Broody, Severe

**Antonyms:-** Unreflective, Goofy, Light-headed

**Eg:-** After losing his job, Alex became more pensive than ever.

**10. Obsequious:-** Excessively submissive; Overly obedient  
(चापलूसी करने वाला जी-हुजूर इंसान)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** obsession to please somebody



**Synonyms:-** Complacent, Cringing, Flattering

**Antonyms:-** Arrogant, Brazen, Assertive

**Eg:-** The princess had obsequious servants who showered her with attention.

**11.Dilemma:-** A situation in which you have to make a tough choice  
(दुविधा या कश्मकश की स्थिति)

**Mnemonics:-** Dil vs Maa



**Synonyms:-** Predicament, Quandary, Puzzle

**Antonyms:-** Solution, Certain, Clarity

**Eg:-** Our teacher presented us with a dilemma when he shared that we could choose where to take our yearly field trip.

**12.Assault:-** A physical attack (किसी पर अचानक हमला करना)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** assault with belt



**Synonyms:-** Invasion, Onslaught, Violation

**Antonyms:-** Retreat, Praise, Safeguard

**Eg:-** Holding a belt in his hand, the angry man threatened to assault his wife.

**13.Sordid:-** Very bad or dirty (बहुत घटिया या नीच काम)

**Mnemonics-** sorry + deed / sorry i did that



**Synonyms:-** Abject, Ignoble, Impure

**Antonyms:-** Wonderful, Honorable, Reputable

**Eg:-** If people learn of the politician's sordid past, they will not vote for him.

**14. Forfeit:-** To lose or give up something (जुर्माने के तौर पर खो देना)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** four feet land forfeit kar di taki ladai na ho



**Synonyms:-** Relinquish, Abandon, Sacrifice

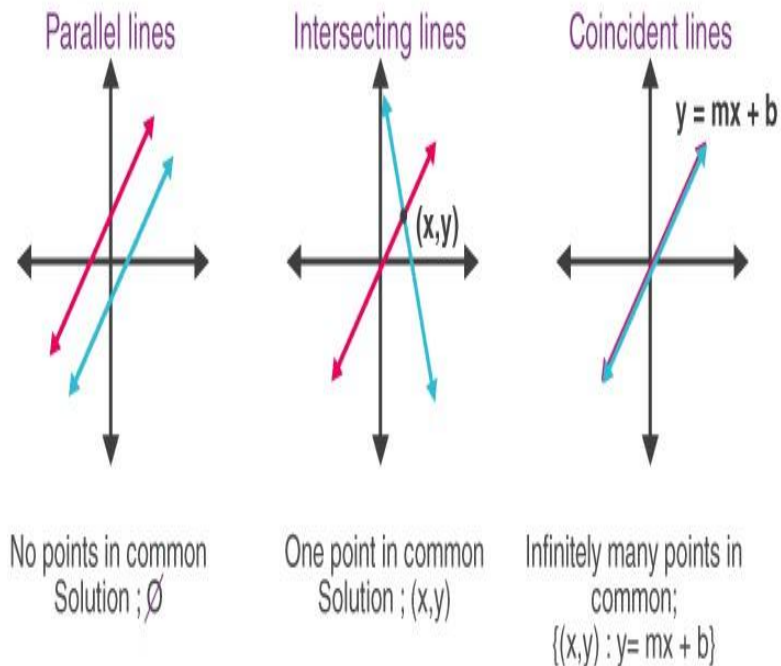
**Antonyms:-** Capitalise, Gain, Grab

**Eg:-** I forfeited my share of land to avoid a fight in the family.

**15.Coincide:-** Existing at the same time (एक ही समय पर होना)

**Mnemonics:-** co (with) + inside

Aman Sir English



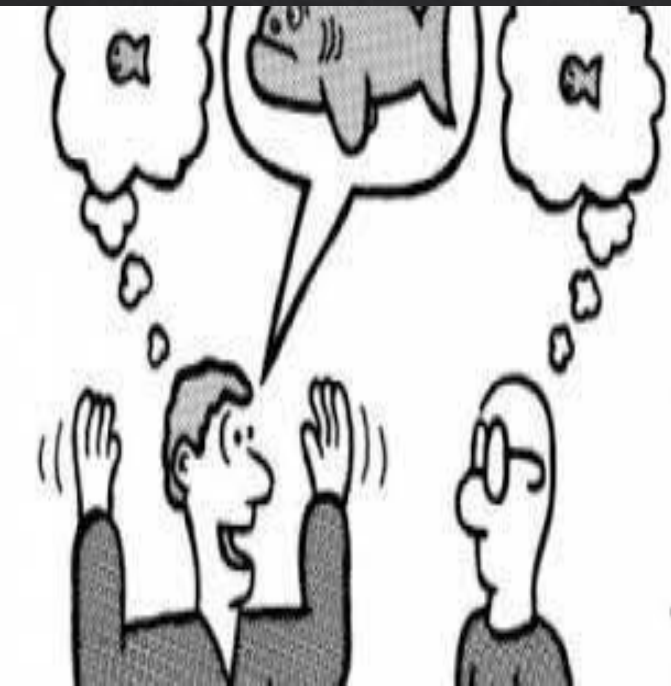
**Synonyms:-** Coexist, Correspond, Accompany

**Antonyms:-** Differ, Disagree, Protest

**Eg:-** Their wedding dates coincided, so I had to pick one of the ceremonies .

**16.Exaggerate:-** To make something seem larger or better than it really is. (बात को बढ़ा-चढ़ाकर पेश करना)

**Mnemonics:-** extra generate karke btana



**Synonyms:-** Overdo, Amplify, Hyperbolize

**Antonyms:-** Actual, Minimize, Reduce

**Eg:-** The arrogant businessman liked to exaggerate his net worth and make it seem like had a lot more money than what was in the bank.

**17.Tempting:-** Able to attract someone (लालच देने वाला या मनमोहक)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** tent me date ka idea usko tempting lga



**Synonyms:-** Appealing, Tantalizing, Enticing

**Antonyms:-** Repellent, Disenchanted, Ugly

**Eg:-** When on a diet, all of the unhealthy food placed on the table seems to be tempting me.

## 18. **Uncanny**:- Strangely weird (अजीब और समझ से बाहर)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics**:- uncle ke sath beer can peena thoda uncanny ho gya



Aman Sir English

**Synonyms**:- Unusual, Astonishing, Spooky

**Antonyms**:- Boring, Common, Ordinary

**Eg**:- Jeff is an uncanny man who likes to eat raw meat.

**19. Subterfuge:-** Trickery or deceit used to achieve one's goals  
(चालबाजी या छल-कपट भरा बहाना)

**Mnemonics:-** sab tere fuse conductor nikal liye



Gendaswami fuse conductor  
nikal liya gya hai ! ab tum haar gye

**Synonyms:-** Bluff, Ploy, Deception

**Antonyms:-** Fairness, Reality, Honesty

**Eg:-** The prisoners resorted to subterfuge, tricking the guards into letting them out of their cells.

**20. Agitated:-** Troubled emotionally and usually deeply (मन की बेचैनी या घबराहट)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** aaj uski gf kisi or ke sath date pe chali gyi isliye wo agitated hai



**Synonyms:-** Aroused, Upset, Flustered

**Antonyms:-** Unagitated, Peaceful, Calm

**Eg:-** Barbara felt agitated when her husband did not pick up her calls, especially since she had been calling all day.

**21. Penitent:-** feeling or expressing remorse for misdeeds  
(अपनी गलती पर पछतावा करने वाला)

**Mnemonics:-** repent / pen chori karne ko leke penitent feel karna



**Synonyms:-** Abject, Apologetic, Atoning

**Antonyms:-** Happy, Unashamed, Unrepentent

**Eg:-** The penitent husband spends days at his wife's grave because he regrets not spending more time with her.

**22.Barbaric:-** Cruel and violent / uncivilized (बहुत क्रूर और जंगली व्यवहार)

**Mnemonics:-** babar barbaric tha



**Synonyms:-** Wild, Uncivilized, Brutal

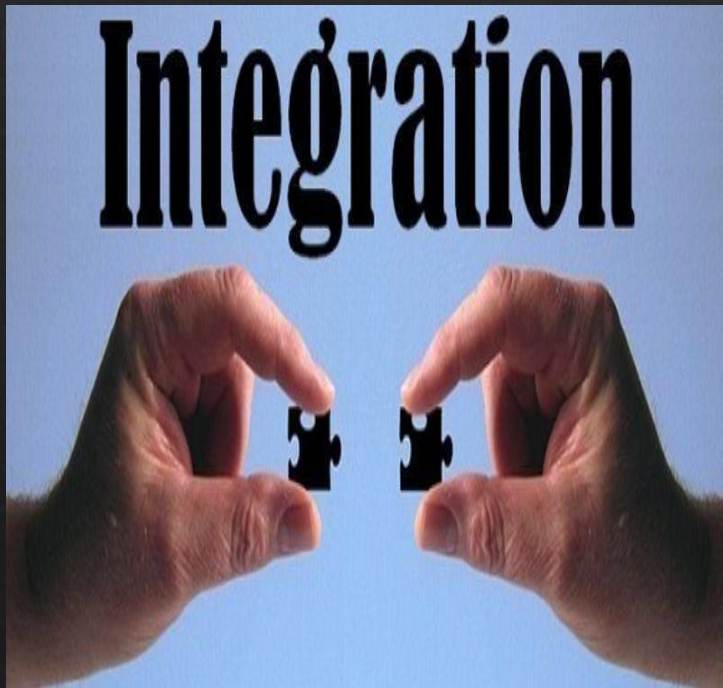
**Antonyms:-** Civilized, Gentle, Kind

**Eg:-** The barbaric ruler tortured many people just for fun.

**23. Integrate:-** To come together or be put together (जोड़कर एक हिस्सा बना लेना)

**Mnemonics:-** integrate karke great company bnate hain /  
integration in mathematics

**Synonyms:-** Unite, Assimilate, Blend

**Antonyms:-** Disarrange, Confuse, Disperse

**Eg:-** The activists marched and protested to integrate schools so children of all races could learn together.

**24.Omission:-** Remove or not include something (किसी चीज को भूल से छोड़ना)

**Mnemonics:-** omit karna

**Synonyms:-** Breach, Exclusion, Lapse

**Antonyms:-** Addition, Inclusion, Insertion

**Eg:-** The omission of my name from the topper's list made me regret the fact I had played around all semester.

**25. Seizure:-** The act of taking a person or thing into custody (जब्त करना)

**Mnemonics:-** bike seize kar li police ne

Aman Sir English



**Synonyms:-** Capture, Abduction, Confiscation

**Antonyms:-** Letting go, Liberation, Release

**Eg:-** The seizure of his bike was conducted because he didn't have any documents .

**26. Hoax:-** an act to make someone believe something (unpleasant) that is not true (मजाक में फैलाया गया झूठ)

**Mnemonics:-** fox aya / jokes



**Synonyms:-** Bluff, Fool, Bamboozle

**Antonyms:-** Be Honest, Clarify, Support

**Eg:-** The hoax about the bomb was enough to get the prankster arrested.

**27. Agile:-** Able to move fast and easily (फुर्तीला और तेजी से हिलने वाला)

**Mnemonics:-** young age mein atheletes agile hote hain

Aman Sir English



**Synonyms:-** Athlectic, Buoyant, Energetic

**Antonyms:-** Brittle, Clumsy, Dispirited

**Eg:-** Sohan was difficult to chase through the crowd due to his agile movements.

**28.Ruin:-** To damage (पूरी तरह बर्बाद या तबाह करना)

**Mnemonics:-** Rain cricket match ko ruin kr deti hai



**Synonyms:-** Demolish, Wreck, Collapse

**Antonyms:-** Build, Construct, Attainment

**Eg:-** A downpour of rain would ruin our family trip to the amusement park since all of the rides are outdoors.

**29. Radiant:-** Shining with happiness (चमकता हुआ या बहुत खुश)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** Radium ki Tarah radiant /  
raid marne ke baad officer ne radiant smile di

**Synonyms:-** Beaming, Sparkling, Glittering

**Antonyms:-** Cloudy, Dull, Gloomy

**Eg:-** The bride looked radiant as she walked  
down the aisle.

**30.Delicate:-** Easily broken or damaged (बहुत कोमल या नाजुक चीज)

**Mnemonics:-** mere delicate dil ki care karna tod mat dena



**Synonyms:-** Fragile, Subtle, Gentle

**Antonyms:-** Firm, Tough, Harsh

**Eg:-** Most of the items in the box are delicate and should be handled with care.

**31.Glee:-** Intense happiness or joy (अत्यधिक खुशी या मन का उत्साह)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** glow karna hapiness se



**Synonyms:-** Delight, Elation, Exuberance

**Antonyms:-** Depression, Worry, Sorrow

**Eg:-** Smiling with glee, the child unwrapped his birthday gift.

**32.Prodigal:-** Wasteful in spending money (बहुत ज्यादा फालतू पैसा खर्च करने वाला)

**Mnemonics:-** If you are with your girl you become prodigal

**Synonyms:-** Profligate, Spendthrift, Lavish

**Antonyms:-** Modest, Frugal, Thrifty

**Eg:-** After the prodigal son spent all of his inheritance, he had to get a low-paying job.

**33.Populous:-** Densely populated (घनी आबादी या बहुत भीड़ वाला)

**Mnemonics:-** jha ki population bhut jada ho

Aman Sir English



**Synonyms:-** Crowded, Numerous, Jammed

**Antonyms:-** Deserted, Vacant, Uninhabited

**Eg:-** As the area became more populous, residential prices began to rise.

**34. Impasse:-** A situation that stops progress (काम रुक जाना या गतिरोध आना)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** isme se paas hona possible nhi hai /  
Impossible to progress



**Synonyms:-** Deadlock, Quandry, Standoff

**Antonyms:-** Agreement, Breakthrough, Boon

**Eg:-** Yesterday, the two parties did not make any progress on the contract terms because they had reached an impasse.

**35. Restrain:-** To control or restrict (नियंत्रण करना या रोक कर रखना)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** police training me restrain karna sikhate hain



**Synonyms:-** Hold back, Detain, Constrain

**Antonyms:-** Liberate, Assist, Permit

**Eg:-** You should restrain this thief till the police come.

**36.Lethal:-** That can cause great damage or death (जानलेवा या बहुत ही घातक)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** Lethal cheezein hamesha ke lie leta deti hain



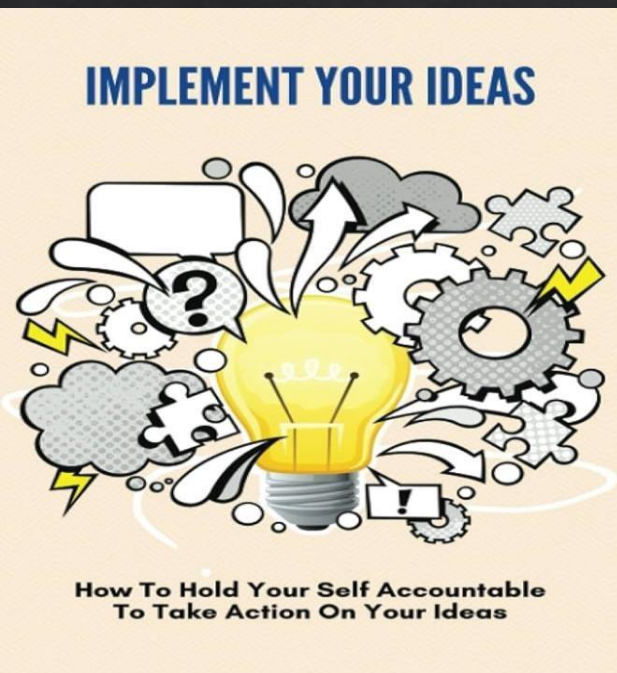
**Synonyms:-** Deadly, Destructive, Fatal

**Antonyms:-** Healthy, Harmless, Helpful

**Eg:-** Drinking and driving is a lethal combination.

**37.Implementation:-** The process of putting a plan into action  
(किसी योजना को लागू करना)

**Mnemonics:-** apply or implement your ideas



**Synonyms:-** Utilization, Execution, Fulfillment

**Antonyms:-** Idleness, Failure, Prohibition

**Eg:-** Many people are calling for a nationwide gun registry, but implementation of such a program would be difficult.

**38. Impute:-** To lay the responsibility or blame on someone else  
(किसी पर दोष या आरोप मढ़ना)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** i am putting blame on you



**Synonyms:-** Ascribe, Assign, Attribute

**Antonyms:-** Absolve, Exculpate, Exonerate

**Eg:-** It was wrong of me to impute you for the failure of the dinner party when I was the one who did not properly plan the event.

**39. Consciousness:-** Awareness of the mind / be in senses  
(होश या मन की जागरूकता)

Aman Sir English

**Mnemonics:-** can you see us??



**Synonyms:-** Awareness, Heed, Sensibility

**Antonyms:-** Ignorance, Carelessness, Negligence

**Eg:-** He was hit on the head and briefly lost his consciousness.

**40. Addict:-** Someone who is physiologically dependent on a substance  
(किसी चीज की बुरी लत लगना)

Aman Sir English

**Antonyms:-** Renounce, Give up, Withdraw
