

1.Humble:- Marked by modesty (बहुत सीधा और विनम्र स्वभाव)

Mnemonics:- human hi to hain sab



Synonyms:- Modest, Polite, Courteous

Antonyms:- Complex, Unkind, Brutal

Eg:- Despite being extremely rich , he is very humble.

2.Onerous:- Involving great effort and difficulty (बहुत भारी और थकाऊ काम)

Mnemonics:- uska owner usse onerous tasks deta hai



Synonyms:- Difficult, Arduous, Cumbersome

Antonyms:- Calm, Effortless, Mild

Eg:- When Jack agreed to help his father cut the grass, he did not realize the chore would be so onerous.

3.Dispatch:- To quickly send off an individual or thing (किसी को कहीं भेजना या निपटाना)

Mnemonics:- packet ko pack karke jaldi dispatch karo

Eg:- Your order will be dispatched as soon as we get the payment .

4.Exemplary:- something so good that it is an example for others to follow (दूसरों के लिए एक मिसाल)

Mnemonics:- best example/ jo example set kare dusro ke liye

5.Ancient:- Referring to something that is extremely old or something that happened long ago (बहुत पुराने या प्राचीन समय का)

Synonyms:- Antique, Archaic, Timeowrn

Eg:- The students are constantly asking about the relevance of studying ancient history when they live in the present time.

6.Dissent:- To differ in opinion (किसी विचार से असहमत होना)

Mnemonics:- dis + assent / disagree/ jinke dissent ho unse distance bna lo



Synonyms:- Discord, Objection, Denial

Antonyms:- Acceptance, Agreement, Concurrence

Eg:- The union is going to dissent with management's offer of a small pay increase.

7. Valor:- Courage in the presence of danger (युद्ध या संकट में बहादुरी)

Mnemonics:- brave sailor ne dikhaya valor

Antonyms:- Timidity, Meekness, Cowardice

Eg:- The guard showed valor when when the building was attacked by the terrorists .

8. Guilty:- Responsible for wrongdoing (अपराध बोध या खुद को दोषी मानना)

Mnemonics:- jisne badi galti (crime) kiya ho



Synonyms:- Convicted, Culpable, Remorseful

Antonyms:- Immune, Innocent, Irresponsible

Eg.:- Because he was guilty of the crime, Charles was sent to the jail for several years.

9.Established:- Brought about or set up (पूरी तरह जमा हुआ या स्थापित)

Mnemonics:- ye ab stablise ho gya hai

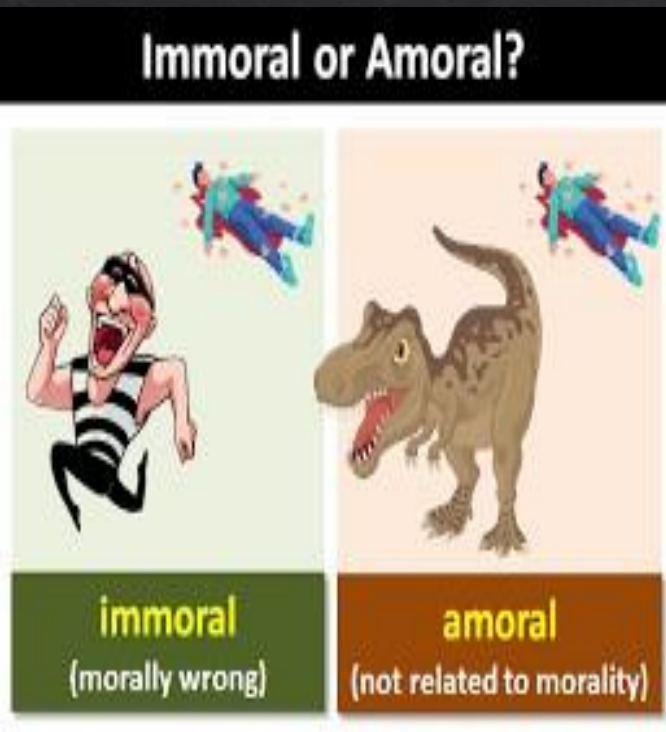
Synonyms:- Entrenched, Settled, Vested

Eg:- Grandpa established his cattle ranch in 1936 and started his meat processing business the following year.

10. Immoral:- not adhering to ethical principles (अनैतिक या गलत आचरण वाला)

Mnemonics:- not moral



Synonyms:- Dishonest, Corrupt, Illegal

Antonyms:- Appropriate, Decent, Ethical

Eg:- It was indecent and immoral for the young teenagers to rob the vulnerable old lady crossing the street.

11.C condone:- Be lenient with (गलत बात को नजरअंदाज करना)

Mnemonics:- koi ni it was done by mistake



Synonyms:- Overlook, Forget, Ignore

Antonyms:- Attend, Deny, Refuse

Eg:- To condone your recent absences from my class, I will need a written note from your parent or guardian.

12.Cogent:- Simple for the mind to accept and believe (बहुत ठोस और प्रभावशाली तर्क)

Mnemonics:- agents ki baaten cogent hoti hai

Synonyms:- Effective, Compelling, Convincing

Antonyms:- Ineffective, Impotent, Invalid

Eg:- When the agent provided me with a cogent answer to my question, I knew he was the right person to buy goods from.

13. Advisable:- Worthy of being recommended (उचित या सलाह देने योग्य)

Mnemonics:- advise + able



Synonyms:- Recommended, Desirable, Appropriate

Antonyms:- Improper, Unwise, Injudicious

Eg:- It is advisable to do yoga during pregnancy .

14. Interdiction:- An official order stopping a person from doing a task
(कानूनी रोक या पाबंदी लगाना)

Mnemonics:- inter (beech me) + diction (kehna order dena)

Synonyms:- Ban, Embargo, Prohibition

Antonyms:- Allowance, Approval, Freedom

Eg:- For safety reasons, the city issued an interdiction which prohibits minors from being outside after 10 pm.

15. Nonchalant:- Relaxed and calm in a way that shows you do not care or are not worried about anything (बिल्कुल बेफिक्र और शांत रहना)

Mnemonics:- nonchalant hoke bike chalaoge to challan to katega



Synonyms:- Aloof, Apathetic, Casual

Antonyms:- Biased, Careful, Deliberate

Eg:- Surprisingly, the women were nonchalant about the traffic rules.

16.Penniless:- Without any money (जिसके पास एक पैसा न हो)

Mnemonics:- penny + less



Synonyms:- Bankrupt, Destitute, Impoverished

Antonyms:- Affluent, Solvent, Wealthy

Eg:- We saw a penniless homeless man holding a sign that said, “Will work for food”.

17.Deny:- Refuse to accept or believe (किसी बात से साफ मना करना)

Mnemonics:- dene nhi paise

Synonyms:- Renounce, Decline, Rebuff

Antonyms:- Accept, Allow, Sanction

Eg:- The traffic officer will definitely give you a ticket if you lie and deny that you were speeding.

18.Immune:- Protected from something unpleasant (बीमारी या असर से सुरक्षित)

Mnemonics:- immunity



Synonyms:- Exempt, Resistant, Unaffected

Antonyms:- Hindered, Susceptible, Unguarded

Eg:- Nobody is immune from this new virus.

19. Bulk:- The larger part of something (किसी चीज का भारी हिस्सा)

Synonyms:- Majority, Gross, Mass

Antonyms:- Minority, Trivial, Insignificant



Eg:- We will provide discounts if you place bulk orders.

20. Influence:- Power to change, affect, control or manipulate someone or something (किसी पर अपना प्रभाव डालना)

Mnemonics:- influencer



Synonyms:- Impact, Domination, Command

Antonyms:- Weakness, Unimportance, Powerlessness

Eg:- Since they would influence my decisions, my mother told me to choose my friends wisely.

21.Fickle:- Changing one's mind frequently (जल्दी-जल्दी विचार बदलने वाला)

Mnemonics:- itni pickle ki variety dekh ke wo fickle ho gya

180 Years Old Pickle Shop



Synonyms:- Capricious, Changeable, Unpredictable

Antonyms:- Constant, Stable, Steadfast

Eg:- The fickle man placed order then returned the product and after 2 days bought that again.

22.Ravage:- To destroy (बुरी तरह तबाह या बर्बाद करना)

Mnemonics:- rage me aake ravage



Synonyms:- Demolish, Devastate, Disrupt

Antonyms:- Aid, Assist, Build

Eg:- Despite the efforts of the firemen, the fire continued to ravage the forest.

23. Vigilant:- Watchful, especially for danger or disorder
(खतरे के प्रति बहुत सावधान)

Mnemonics:- vigilance department



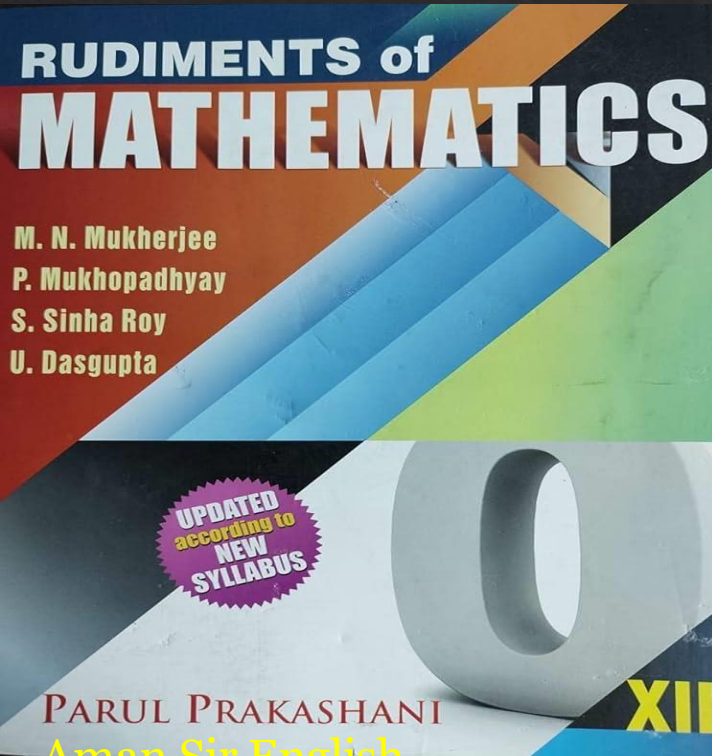
Synonyms:- Wakeful, Cautious, Observant

Eg:- Although this highway is a beautiful drive,
You have to stay vigilant for deer and other animals
in the road.

24. Rudimentary:- Being in the earliest stages of development
(बिल्कुल शुरुआती या बुनियादी ज्ञान)

Mnemonics:- Elementary



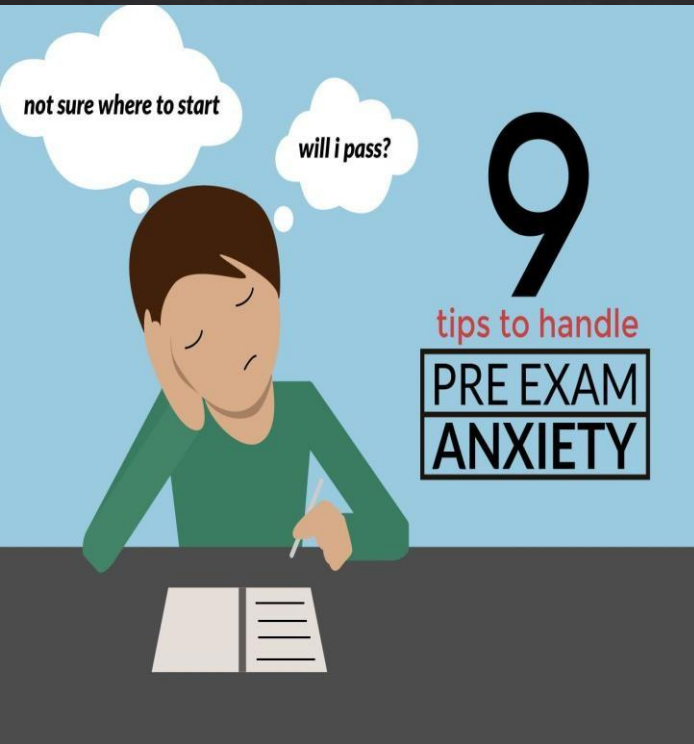
Synonyms:- Fundamental, Basic, Elemental

Antonyms:- Additional, Advanced, Derivative

Eg:- You need to have at least a rudimentary understanding of technology before you can upload a video on that website.

25. Anxiety:- An uncomfortable feeling of worry or nervousness
(मन की घबराहट या चिंता)

Mnemonics:- exam me anxiety



Synonyms:- Tension, Concern, Angst

Antonyms:- Advantage, Belief, Blessing

Eg:- Because she was suffering from anxiety, her therapist recommended taking some medication to help.

26.Hazard:- A source of danger (खतरा या जोखिम भरी स्थिति)

Mnemonics:- hazard se hazaro logo ki maut hui bhopal me



Synonyms:- Peril, Risk, Threat

Antonyms:- Safety, Assurance, Protection

Eg:- Lead paint is an environmental hazard and can harm children.

27. Disregard:- To ignore or dismiss something (किसी बात की अनदेखी करना)

Mnemonics:- dis + regard



Synonyms:- Contempt, Antipathy, Scorn

Antonyms:- Admiration, Approval, Care

Eg:- If you disregard the red light at an intersection and keep driving you are not only breaking the law but also endangering your life.

28. Irresolute:- not certain about something (जो फैसला न ले पाए)

Mnemonics:- not resolute



Synonyms:- Changing, Doubting, Fluctuating

Antonyms:- Definite, Resolute, Willful

Eg:- she was irresolute and could not decide which college she wants to apply for.

29.Everlasting:- Lasting forever (हमेशा बना रहने वाला अंतहीन)

Mnemonics:- lasting forever

Synonyms:- Eternal, Abiding, Immortal

Antonyms:- Brief, Ending, Ephemeral

Eg:- All teenagers believe that their love for their lover is everlasting .

30. Jeopardy:- At risk of loss or harm (खतरे या जोखिम में होना)

Mnemonics:- leopard ke paas jana jeopardy me dalna



Synonyms:- Peril, Risk, Vulnerability

Antonyms:- Assurance, Certainty, Safety

Eg:- You have put your dog's life in jeopardy by keeping it outside.

31. Dishearten:- Take away the enthusiasm of (हिम्मत तोड़ना या उदास करना)

Mnemonics:- dis + heart



Synonyms:- Daunt, Deject, Demoralize

Antonyms:- Praise, Stimulate, Compliment

Eg:- You should not let this defeat dishearten you.

32. Appropriate:- Right or suited for a particular situation (हालात के हिसाब से बिल्कुल सही)

Mnemonics:- ye appropriate property hai jaisi hume chahiye thi

Synonyms:- Applicable, Apt, Befitting

Antonyms:- Evil, Improper, Unskilled

Eg:- Her speech on retirement was appropriate for her middle-aged audience.

33.Feud:- A state of long-standing mutual hostility (पुराने समय से चली आ रही दुश्मनी)

Mnemonics:- food stall location ko leke fued

Antonyms:- Accord, Agreement, Concurrence

Synonyms:- Altercation, Broil, Combat

Eg:- At first, Hanna tried to talk things out in a friendly way, but the guy wouldn't listen and a bitter feud broke out.

34. Entrench:- Occupy a trench or secured area (अपनी स्थिति बहुत मजबूत करना)

Mnemonics:- in + trench

Synonyms:- Embed, Fortify, Ingrain

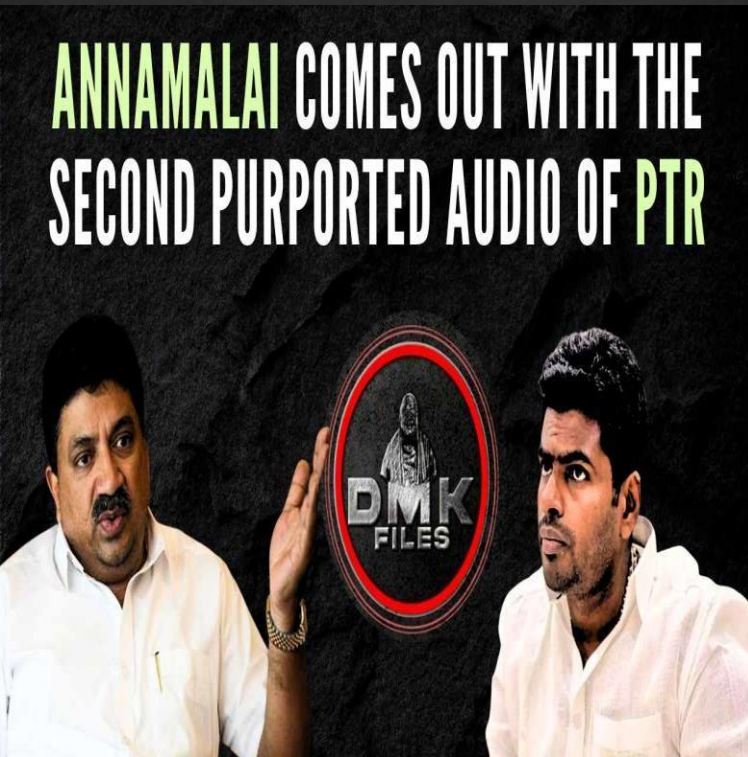
Antonyms:- Discourage, Dissuade, Weaken

Antonyms:- Improbably, Unlikely

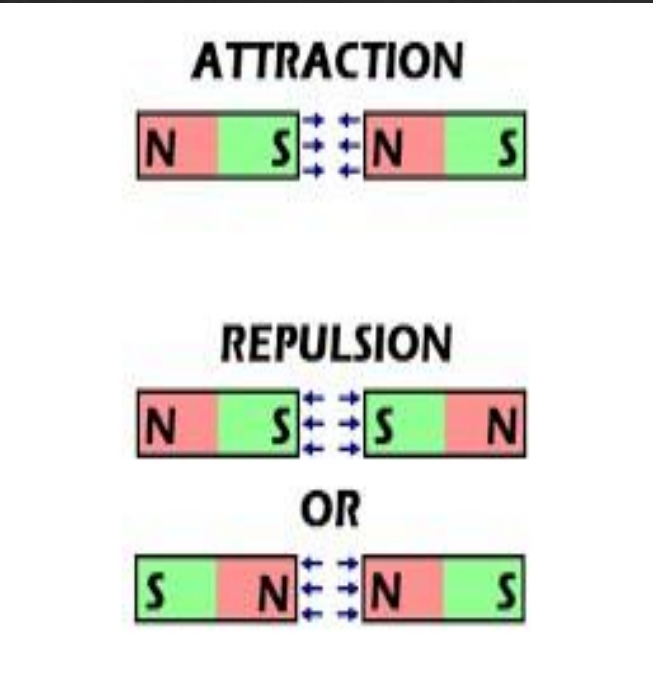
Eg:- The house is purportedly worth a million dollars, but will probably appraise for much more.

37.Ardent:- Feeling great passion (उत्साह और जोश से भरा हुआ)

Mnemonics:- car dent nikalne ke liye adrent



Synonyms:- Passionate, Fierce, Intense

Antonyms:- Apathetic, Calm, Dull

Eg.:- When the rockstar checks his mail, he almost always finds one or two bizarre gifts from some of his ardent fans.

38.Dwindle:- To decrease, reduce in size (धीरे-धीरे कम या कमजोर होना)

Mnemonics:- strong wind dwindle ka crop production



Synonyms:- Decay, Decline, Decrease

Antonyms:- Ascend, Enhance, Enlarge

Eg.:- The production estimates dwindled after that strong wind and rain.

39. Adversity:- A difficult situation or condition (मुसीबत या कठिनाई का समय)

Mnemonics:- inti adversity ke bawjood wo pahuncha in top university



Synonyms:- Calamity, Catastrophe, Difficulty

Antonyms:- Advantage, Assistance, Benefit

Eg.:- Despite having all those adversity he successfully completed his graduation from a reputed university.

40.Cease:- To put an end to something (किसी काम को रोक देना)

Mnemonics:- cease fire = stop fire



Synonyms:- Break off, Desist, Discontinue

Antonyms:- Commence, Continue, Initiate

Eg.:- Once the treaty is announced, the fighting on the border should cease.

41.Consolidate:- To put together (चीजों को जोड़कर मजबूत बनाना)

Mnemonics:- kisi cheez ko or solid (strong) bnana
