

**1. Behold:-** See with attention (ध्यान से देखना)

**Mnemonics:-** hold your eyes / old man behold the sight



**Synonyms:-** Discern, Notice, Observe

**Antonyms:-** Disbelieve, Ignore, Overlook

**Eg:-** One of my wishes is to behold the greatest wonders of the world.

**2. Aggravate:-** To make worse (भड़का देना)

**Mnemonics:-** aur ugar bna dena



**Synonyms:-** Provoke, Irritate, Bother

**Antonyms:-** Aid, Delight, Soothe

**Eg:-** I left the party early so that the noise would not aggravate my headache.

**3.Prolong:-** Lengthen in time (किसी चीज़ को लंबा खींचना)

**Mnemonics:-** very long time



**Synonyms:-** Perpetuate, Protract, Stretch

**Antonyms:-** Abbreviate, Advance, Cease

**Eg:-** The teacher decided to prolong the test, giving the student 15 more minutes to finish the exam.

**4.Cruise:-** An ocean trip taken for pleasure (समुद्र की आरामदायक लंबी यात्रा)

**Synonyms:-** Sailing, Voyage, Jaunt

**Antonyms:-** Toil, Stay, Lumber



**Eg:-** MS Dhoni decided to cruise with the Players in the Caribbean sea when the team was on the tour of west indies for two test matches.

**5.Factual:-** Having the quality or characteristic of being true  
(पूरी तरह हकीकत पर आधारित)

**Mnemonics:-** based on facts



**Synonyms:-** Accurate, Credible, Legitimate

**Antonyms:-** False, Invalid, Imaginary

**Eg.:-** That two plus two equals four is a completely factual statement, and no one can ever claim it to be false.

**6.Reminiscence:-** A retelling of a past experience (पुरानी यादों का ताज़ा होना)

**Mnemonics:-** ye scent uski yaade remind karata hai



**Synonyms:-** Anecdote, Recollection, Remembrance

**Antonyms:-** Forget, Repress, Dismiss

**Eg:-** Although my brother and I were at the same party, his reminiscence of the night is somewhat different from mine.

**7.Rehabilitate:-** To bring back to a healthy or useful state  
(पुरानी अच्छी हालत में लाना)

**Mnemonics:-** rehab

**Synonyms:-** Mend, Rebuild, Reintegrate

**Antonyms:-** Damage, Destroy, Decline

**Eg:-** After my surgery, I will attend physical therapy sessions to rehabilitate the muscles in my knee.

**8. Harrowing:-** Producing pain or discomfort (दिल दहला देने वाला अनुभव)

**Mnemonics:-** horror / horror movie



**Synonyms:-** Agonizing, Distressing, Heart-wrenching

**Antonyms:-** Pleasant, Calming, Unfrightening

**Eg:-** Because of a harrowing experience I had on a roller coaster when I was a teenager, I no longer visit amusement parks.

## 9. Diabolical:- very evil (बहुत ही बुरा या शैतानी)

**Mnemonics:-** Devil

**Synonyms:-** Cruel, Heinous, Hellish

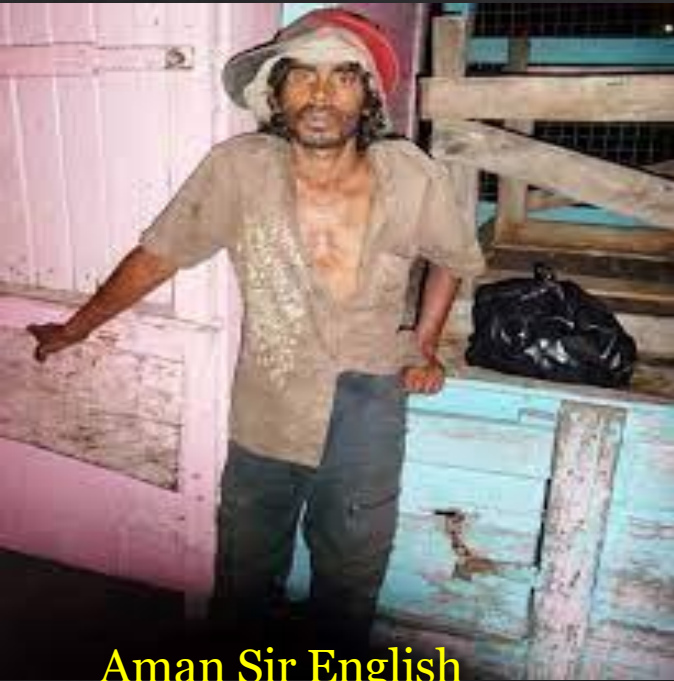
**Antonyms:-** Gentle, Good, Kind

**Eg:-** The mastermind created a diabolical plan to take over the world.

**10. Vagrant:-** An individual who lacks regular work and moves around frequently (बिना घर-बार का घुमक्कड़)

**Mnemonics:-** bhag yha se rent bhi nhi hai tere paas



**Synonyms:-** Aimless, Drifting, Wanderer

**Antonyms:-** Settled, Steady, Unvarying

**Eg:** The media was quick to publicize the story of how the penniless vagrant won a scholarship to Harvard University.

**11.Desolate:-** Empty; without life (बिल्कुल सुनसान और उजाड़ जगह)

**Mnemonics:-** Isolate



**Synonyms:-** Bare, Bleak, Derelict

**Antonyms:-** Cherished, Befriended, Inhabited

**Eg:-** Before Las Vegas became a mobster's paradise, the entire area was nothing but a desolate desert.

**12. Imitate:-** To copy or simulate the function of something else (किसी की नकल उतारना)

**Mnemonics:-** If you imitate I am not your mate

**Synonyms:-** Emulate, Replicate, Mimic

**Antonyms:-** Differ, Reverse, Disregard

**Eg:-** Some people find it funny when you imitate someone grumpy or silly in an attempt to make fun of them.

**13. Ingredients:-** Any substance used to create a particular dish  
(चीज़ बनाने की ज़रूरी सामग्री)

**Synonyms:-** Additive, Constituent, Innards

**Antonyms:-** Whole, Undiluted



**Eg:-** In my opinion, butter is an absolutely vital ingredient to great popcorn, it just doesn't taste right without it.

**14. Elevate:-** Raise in rank or condition (किसी को ऊंचे पद पर उठाना)

**Synonyms:-** Heighten, Raise, Uplift

**Antonyms:-** Deprecate, Disdain, Spurn



**Eg:-** The heat would elevate from a comfortable 75 degrees to a staggering 99 degrees during the marathon.

**15.Explicit:-** Specific about rules or what is required (बिल्कुल साफ-साफ कही गई बात)

**Mnemonics:-** explained clearly



**Synonyms:-** Accurate, Absolute, Certain

**Antonyms:-** Ambiguous, Obscured, Fuzzy

**Eg:-** The difficult woman left the maid explicit details about how she wanted her house cleaned.

**16. Commotion:-** The act of making a noisy disturbance (भारी शोर-शराबा या अफरा-तफरी)

**Mnemonics:-** confusion + motion



**Synonyms:-** Disturbance, Clamor, Uproar

**Antonyms:-** Calmness, Harmony, Ease

**Eg:-** There was a commotion among the sheep when the dog broke loose from its leash.

**17.Affluent:-** A person who is financially well off (बहुत ही धनी और समृद्ध)

**Mnemonics:-** affluent log pent house me rehte hain



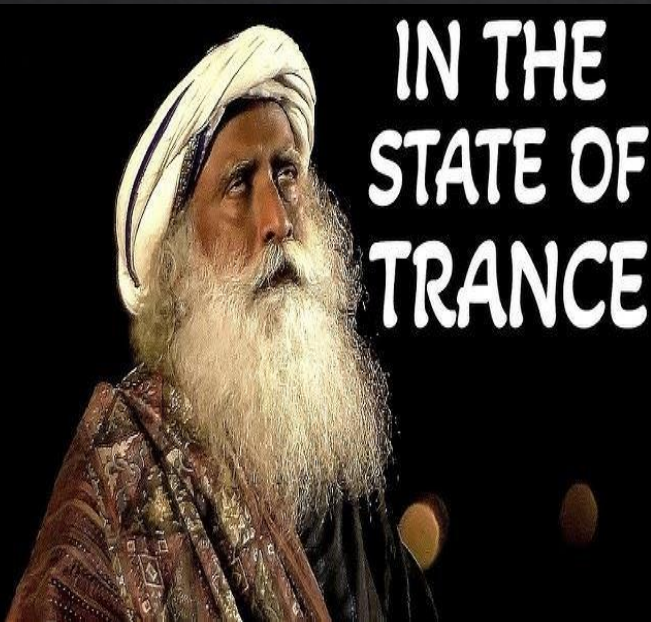
**Synonyms:-** Wealthy, Prosperous, Plentiful

**Antonyms:-** Destitute, Poor, Penniless

**Eg:-** Only affluent families could afford the top-dollar price tags attached to the homes in that neighborhood.

**18. Whimsical:-** Determined by chance or impulse or whim rather than by necessity or reason (मनमौजी या अनोखे स्वभाव वाला)

**Mnemonics:-** musical mahol me wo whimsical imagination me kho gya Aman Sir English



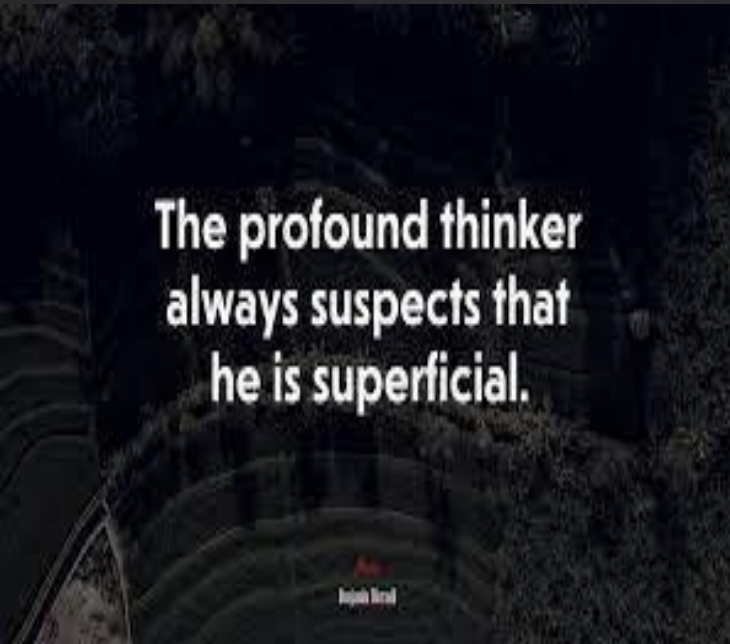
**Synonyms:-** Amusing, Arbitrary, Chancy

**Antonyms:-** Boring, Dramatic, Normal

**Eg:-** When my little girl is alone, she often engages in a whimsical conversation with her imaginary best friend.

**19.Profound:-** Of the greatest intensity (बहुत ही गहरा या गंभीर)

**Mnemonics:-** profound thinker proof find karte hain



**Synonyms:-** Intellectual, Subtle, Philosophical

**Antonyms:-** Ignorant, Mild, Dull

**Eg:-** The speaker's profound words made me think about my future.

**20.Melancholic:-** Characterized by or causing or expressing sadness  
(उदास या गमगीन कर देने वाला)

**Mnemonics:-** melenge kholi me



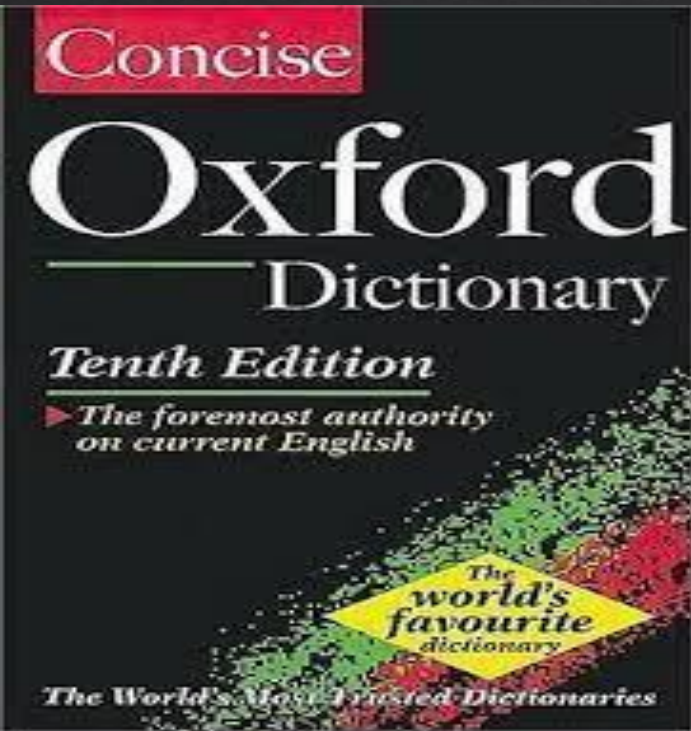
**Synonyms:-** Gloomy, Lugubrious, Downcast

**Antonyms:-** Cheerful, Happy, Joyful

**Eg:-** Spanning 60 years, Anne Tyler's novel is a melancholic story of a mismatched marriage.

**21. Concise:-** Expressing much in few words (कम शब्दों में सटीक बात)

**Mnemonics:-** cise (cut)



**Synonyms:-** Pithy, Succint, Terse

**Antonyms:-** Expansive, Wordy, Redundant

**Eg:-** If a concise answer can provide the information requested, there is no reason to bore a person with a long response.

**22.Glorious:-** Characterized by grandeur (शानदार या बहुत गर्व वाला)

**Mnemonics:-** full of glory/ itna acha jis par garav ho

**Synonyms:-** Magnificent, Wonderful, Adored

**Antonyms:-** Dull, Gloomy, Lowly

**Eg:-** Kara stared up at the glorious sunset, amazed by how beautiful the setting sun looked over the mountains.

**23. Adequate:-** Sufficient for the purpose (ज़रूरत के लिए बिल्कुल काफी)

**Mnemonics:-** adequate pani piyoge to ae dikkat nhi ayegi

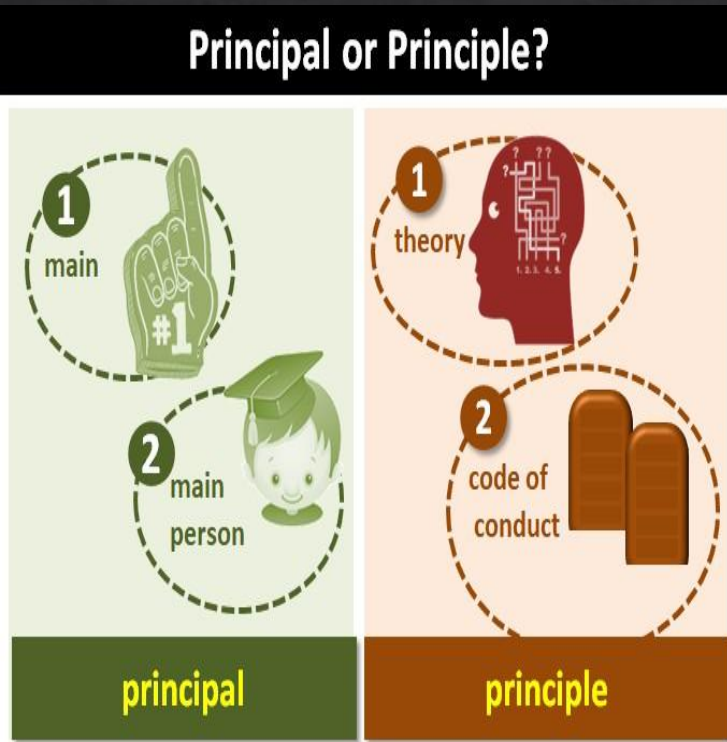
**Synonyms:-** Ample, Enough, Sufficient

**Antonyms:-** Inadequate, Incapable, Inept

**Eg:-** Adequate water intake is necessary for your body to function properly.

**24.Principal:-** Most important element (सबसे मुख्य या सबसे बड़ा)

**Mnemonics:-** jaise school me principal main hota hai



**Synonyms:-** Major, Dominant, Leading

**Antonyms:-** Least, Minor, Trivial

**Eg:-** Matt Damon is the principal actor in the Bourne Identity series.

**25. Intelligible:-** Capable of being comprehended (जो आसानी से समझ आ सके)

**Mnemonics:-** intelligent + ible

**Synonyms:-** Understandable, Comprehensible, Distinct

**Antonyms:-** Ambiguous, Equivocal, Obscure

**Eg:-** Because the intoxicated man slurred his words, his speech was far from intelligible.

**26. Acquisitive:-** Eager and capable of making acquisitions  
(चीजें बटोरने की लालच वाला)

**Mnemonics:-** acquisition karke wala/ acquire karne wala

**Synonyms:-** Rapacious, Avaricious, Avid

**Antonyms:-** Apathetic, Satisfied, Disinterested

**Eg:-** The company has grown so big and profitable we have become acquisitive and now purchase smaller firms.



**27. Anguish:-** Extreme suffering or grief (बहुत गहरी मानसिक या शारीरिक पीड़ा)

**Mnemonics:-** anger me kuch kar dia fir hua anguish



**Synonyms:-** Agony, Sorrow, Affliction

**Antonyms:-** Delight, Happiness, Contentment

**Eg:-** When my husband died, the anguish I felt was nearly unbearable.

**28. Disgruntled:-** In a state of sulky dissatisfaction (काम से नाखुश और चिड़चिड़ा)

**Mnemonics:-** this grant was not passed

**Antonyms:-** Satisfied, Contented, Pleased

**Eg:-** Even though Harry is disgruntled about losing his job, he still plans to find another one in the same field.

**29.Sincere:-** Open and genuine (पूरी तरह सच्चा और ईमानदार)

**Mnemonics:-** sin nhi karta



**Synonyms:-** Genuine, Trustworthy, Real

**Antonyms:-** Counterfeit, Deceitful, Devious

**Eg:-** I have full trust in shayam, due to his decades of sincere friendship.

**30. Intricate:-** Highly involved or complex (बहुत उलझा हुआ या पेचीदा)

**Mnemonics:-** Bhulbhulaiya me entry gate ko dhunda intricate ho jata hai

**Synonyms:-** Baroque, Complex, Tangled

**Antonyms:-** Apparent, Clear, Obvious

**Eg:-** It took me months to put the intricate puzzle together.

**31.Parched:-** Having a strong need for moisture (प्यास से बिल्कुल सूखा हुआ)

**Mnemonics:-** march ke baad ke months land parched ho jati



**Synonyms:-** Arid, Dry, Withered

**Antonyms:-** Moist, Wet, Damp

**Eg:-** After being stuck in the desert for two days, I was parched and in need of water.

**32.Lavish:-** Very generous (बहुत कीमती या खर्चीला ढंग)

**Mnemonics:-** lavish marriage in paris



**Synonyms:-** Profuse, Opulent, Excessive

**Antonyms:-** Austere, Barren, Destitute

**Eg:-** Every room in the five-star hotel was filled with lavish furnishings.

**33.Divulge:-** To make something known (कोई गुप्त बात उजागर करना)

**Mnemonics:-** diya valut ka code

**Synonyms:-** Reveal, Disclose, Leak

**Antonyms:-** Conceal, Protect, Hide

**Eg:-** Doctors must be careful to not divulge confidential information about their patients.

**34.Contentment:-** A feeling of being happy and satisfied (मन का संतोष या सुकून)

**Mnemonics:-** best content milne le baad aa gyi contentment

**35. Virtue:-** A moral and praiseworthy trait (अच्छे गुण या नेक काम)

**Mnemonics:-** very right choice



**Synonyms:-** Ethic, Character, Quality

**Antonyms:-** Disbelief, Wildness, Disregard

**Eg:-** Since Jason is such a mean man, I doubt if he has a single virtue.

**36.Deface:-** To damage or disfigure something (सूरत बिगाड़ना या खराब करना)

**Mnemonics:-** de + face / face bigaad dena



**Synonyms:-** Demolish, Obliterate, Vandalize

**Antonyms:-** Build, Construct, Adorn



**Eg:-** They used spray paint to deface the professor's portrait.

**37.Humility:-** The state in which one does not view himself as being better than others (सादगी और मन की विनम्रता)

**Mnemonics:-** sab human hi to hai/ humble hona

**Antonyms:-** Boldness, Arrogance, Egoism

**Eg:-** During her speech, Jennifer showed her humility by acknowledging her film crew as the team who deserved the trophy.

**38. Audacious:-** Disposed to venture or take risks (बहुत ही साहसी या निडर)

**Mnemonics:-** uda denge if they see us again



**Synonyms:-** Bold, Courageous, Dauntless

**Antonyms:-** Afraid, Cautious, Fearful

**Eg:-** Cooper was an audacious soldier who never ran from a battle.

**39. Inflate:-** To fill something up with air or gas (हवा भरकर फुलाना या बढ़ाना)

**Mnemonics:-** inme fill kardo gas / inhe fula do



**Synonyms:-** Bloat, Boost, Enlarge

**Antonyms:-** Abridge, Decrease, Diminish

**Eg:-** Before Julie could ride her bike to the beach, she had to inflate her flattened tire with air.

**40. Zenith:-** The strongest or most successful period of time  
(आसमान या सफलता का शिखर)

**Mnemonics:-** Jab player zenith pe hota hai zannat me hota hai



**Synonyms:-** Top, Apex, Pinnacle

**Antonyms:-** Bottom, Base, Nadir

**Eg:-** Since my energy is at its zenith in the morning, I prefer to get my larger tasks completed at the start of the day.

**41.Partition:-** A divider that breaks up an area (बंटवारा करना या अलग हिस्सा)

**Synonyms:-** Barrier, Distribution, Segregation

**Antonyms:-** Whole, Unity, Juncture



**Eg:-** We will use a partition to divide our living area into a living space and a workspace.

**42.Gloomy:-** Filled with dejection (अंधेरा या बहुत उदासी भरा)

**Mnemonics:-** goom soom / glow nhi



**Synonyms:-** Depressed, Dismal, Sullen

**Antonyms:-** Cheerful, Hopeful, Vivacious

**Eg:-** During the funeral, the widow had a gloomy expression on her face.
