

Servile:- too eager to praise or obey someone (जी-हुजूरी करने वाला या गुलाम जैसा)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- servant jesa attitude

Synonyms:- obsequious, sycophantic, subservient,

Antonyms:- aggressive, dominant,



E.g.:- He is so servile that other people take advantage of him.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Optimistic:- hoping for believing that good things will happen in the future (हमेशा अच्छा होने की उम्मीद रखने वाला)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- opportunity aayegi mast

Synonyms: - assured, bright, buoyant,

Antonyms:- dejected, gloomy, pessimistic,



E.g.:- Rajni is optimistic and hopes for the best even when things look bleak.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Adage:- a wise saying or proverb (पुरानी कहावत या मुहावरा)

Mnemonics :- Adage (old age), old age ke log bahut adage use karte hai

Synonyms: - axiom, maxim, precept,

Antonyms:- absurdity, ambiguity, foolishness,



E.g.:- He gets tired of all the same old sayings, so he is always trying to come

up with a new adage.

Compelled:- having to do something, because you are forced to or feel it is necessary (मजबूर या विवश किया गया) **AMAN SIR ENGLISH**

Mnemonics :- company vale compel karte hai overtime ke liye

Synonyms: - amenable, liable, obligated, obliged, bound,

Antonyms:- irresponsible, irrefutable, unprovable,



E.g.:- He was compelled by everyone to join the group.

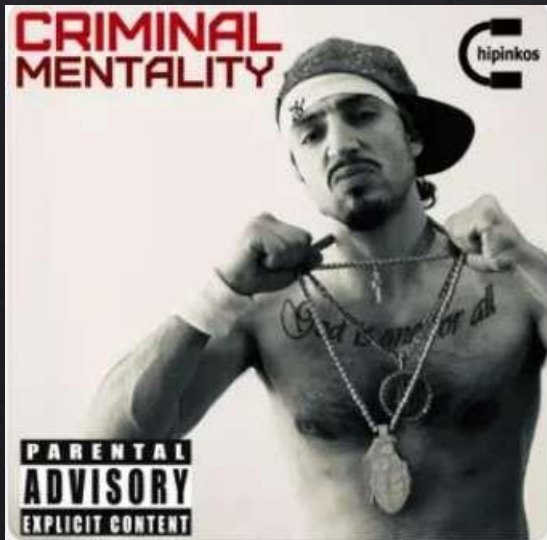
Callous:- showing or having an insensitive and cruel disregard for others (दूसरों के प्रति बेरहम और कठोर)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- callous = criminal mentality

Synonyms: - apathetic, careless, cold-blooded, heartless

Antonyms:- compassionate, merciful, sympathetic



E.g.:- Because the judge was upset about Rita's callous disregard for others, he sentenced her to ten years for drunk driving.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

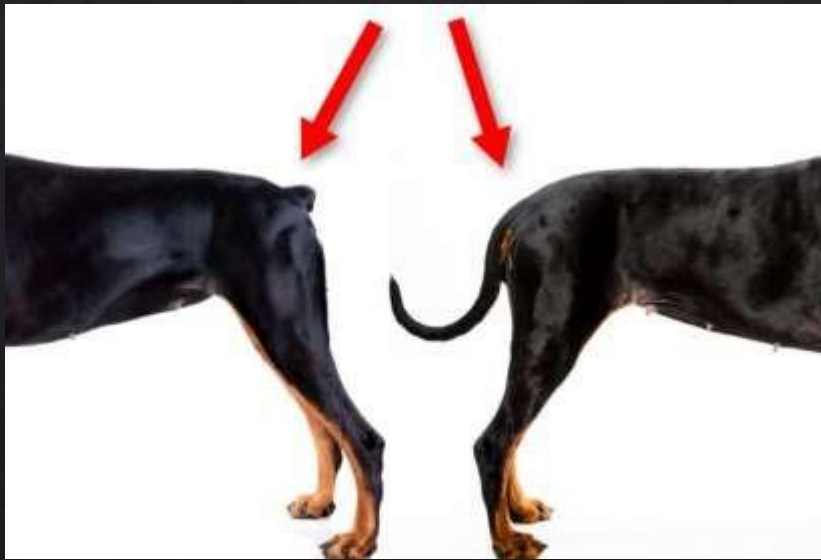
Curtail:- to reduce or limit something (खर्च या समय में कटौती करना)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- cut + tail

Synonyms:- diminish, downsize, halt

Antonyms:- expand, extend, grow



E.g.:- I had to curtail my answer as I was running out of time.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Staunch:- always loyal in supporting a person, organization, or set of beliefs or opinions (बहुत ही वफादार और पक्का समर्थक)

Mnemonics :- stay with you in uncha or nicha situation

Synonyms: - ardent, loyal, reliable,

Antonyms:- disloyal, flexible, indefinite



E.g.:- Since the two countries are staunch allies it is not surprising they will work together in the war to defeat their shared enemy.

Wicked:- morally wrong and bad (बहुत ही बुरा या दुष्ट इंसान)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- bo wicked hai wicket utha ke mar deta hai

Synonyms: - devilish, evil, impish, mischievous,

Antonyms:- moral, nice, obedient,



E.g.:- Because he had no morals, the wicked man went around trying to hurt everyone he met.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Derision:- to mock at someone (किसी का मज़ाक उड़ाना या उपहास)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- uski dry skin thi isliye sabko derision karte the

Synonyms: - contempt, disdain, mockery

Antonyms:- admiration, approval, flattery



E.g.:- The kids erupted in derision when a handicapped man entered in the classroom.

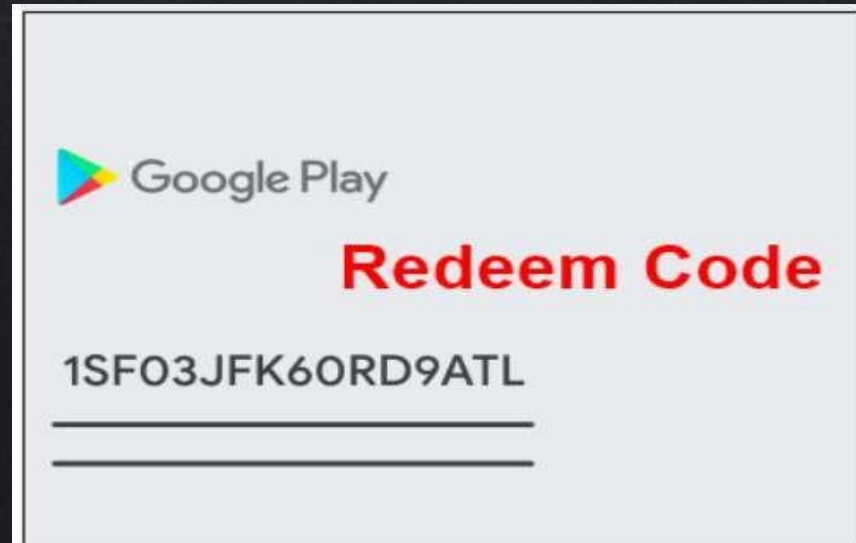
AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Redeem:- to buy back something, or to exchange something for money or for goods or services (अपनी गलती सुधारना या सम्मान वापस पाना)

Mnemonics :- re (again) + dena

Synonyms: - pay off, reclaim

Antonyms:- forfeit, lose, keep



E.g.:- I save my coupons so that I can redeem them at the supermarket.

Gullible:- believing and trusting people too easily, and therefore easily tricked (सीधा-साधा जो आसानी से धोखे में आ जाए) **AMAN SIR ENGLISH**

Mnemonics :- jisko koi bhi gali de sakta hai

Synonyms: - foolish, unsuspecting, credulous

Antonyms:- astute, discerning, perceptive, suspicious



E.g.:- Unfortunately, the elderly woman was gullible enough to provide the con man with all of her financial information.

Lucid:- clear and easy to understand (बिल्कुल साफ और समझने में आसान)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- as clear as this liquid

Synonyms:- luminous, unambiguous, apprehensible, etc

Antonyms:- gloomy, vague, shadowy, obscure, murky, etc.



E.g.:- The directions for assembling the complex table were not very lucid.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Patriot:- a person who loves their country and, if necessary, will fight for it (अपने देश से प्यार करने वाला देशभक्त) **AMAN SIR ENGLISH**

Mnemonics :- itna pitne ke bad bhi ratt laga rakhi hai kuch nhi bataunga

Synonyms: - loyalist, nationalist, patrioteer, statesperson, etc.

Antonyms:- expatriate, traitor, rebel, etc.



E.g.:- Without thinking twice, the patriot gathered up his weapons and sought out after the terrorists.

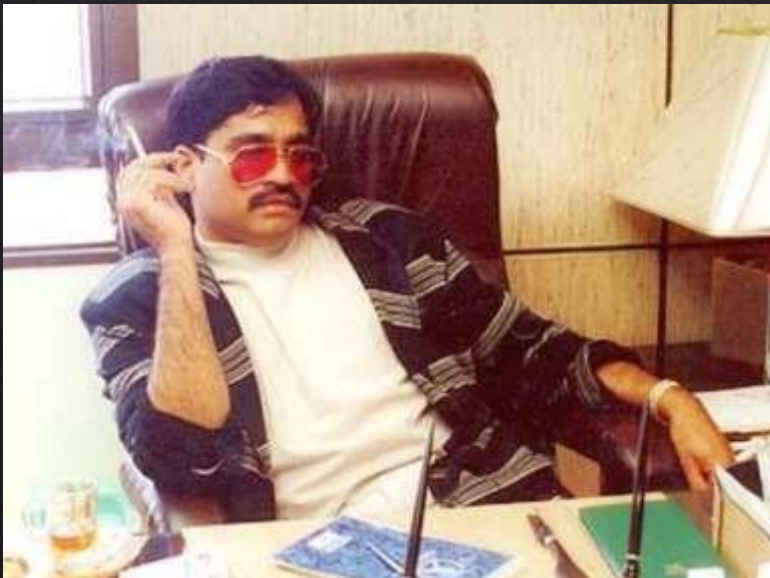
Traitor:- a person who is not loyal to his/her country, friends, etc.
(अपने देश या दल को धोखा देने वाला)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- jo desh ka trade (sauda) kar de

Synonyms:- conspirator, hypocrite, impostor, informer, spy, etc.

Antonyms:- loyalist, patriot, defender, proponent, chauvinist, etc.



E.g.:- Anna turned traitor when he sold important government secrets to the highest bidder.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Indolent:- wanting to avoid activity or exertion; lazy (कामचोर या बहुत आलसी व्यक्ति)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- in(not) + dolna (chalna firna)

Synonyms:- easygoing, idle, inactive, lax, lazy, lethargic, etc.

Antonyms:- diligent, energetic, industrious, intent, etc.



E.g.:- Because I enjoy being indolent, there is nothing I find more pleasant than relaxing in bed.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Wax:- to increase in size, numbers, strength, prosperity, or intensity (आकार या शक्ति में धीरे-धीरे बढ़ना)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Synonyms:- boost, development, escalation, expansion, gain, etc.

Antonyms:- decline, decrease, drop, shrinkage, abridgment, etc.



E.g.:- When the population began to wax, there were fewer jobs and much more pollution in the city.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Obtuse:- slow to or not wanting to understand something (नासमझ या बात को देर से समझने वाला)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics abe tujhse nhi hoga tum obtuse ho

Synonyms: - stupid, dull, unintelligent, lumpish, etc.

Antonyms:- bright, intelligent, pointed, quick, sharp, smart, etc.



E.g.:- Are you so obtuse that you will give away all your money to a fake charity?

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Notion:- something that you have in your mind; an idea

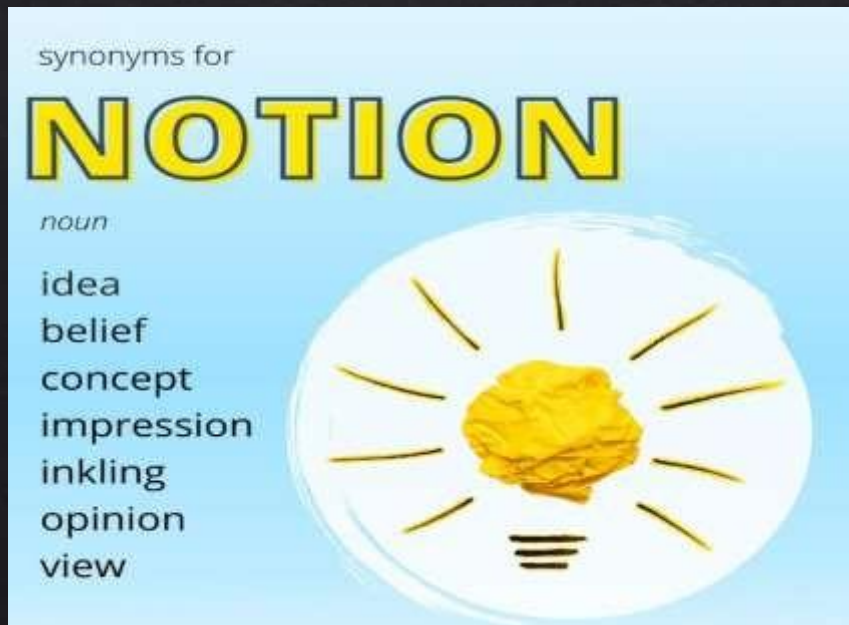
(मन में आने वाला कोई विचार या धारणा)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- according to my notion this is the correct option

Synonyms: - approach, assumption, perception, sentiment, etc.

Antonyms:- being, concrete, ignorance, stupidity, need, etc.



E.g.:- When the girl saw how much her friends liked her sugar cookies, she had the notion to open an online bakery.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Triumph:- to have a very great success or victory
(शानदार जीत या बड़ी सफलता)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- try karte hai hum triumph ke liye

Synonyms:- celebration, joy, pride, elation, exultance, etc.

Antonyms:- sadness, sorrow, unhappiness, etc.



E.g.:- Earning a high school diploma was a huge triumph for the young man with a learning disability.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Scattered:- spread over a large area (इधर-उधर बिखरा हुआ या फैला हुआ)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- ye tune hi scatter kiya hai ab isko ikattha kar

Synonyms:- dispersed, diffuse, strewed, disorderly, messy etc.

Antonyms:- assembled, condensed, gathered, organized, etc.



E.g.:- The light is scattered as it strikes particles suspended in the air.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Sophisticated:- appealing in an intellectual way
(बहुत ही आधुनिक और सुलझा हुआ)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- sophia ke communicate karne ke tatic se pata
chalta hai ki bo badi sophisticated hai

Synonyms:- mature, suave, mondain, stagy, worldly, etc.

Antonyms:- enchanted, encouraged, enthusiastic, excited, etc.



E.g.:- I think a more sophisticated
approach is needed to solve this
problem.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Filthy:- extremely or unpleasantly dirty (बहुत ही गंदा या घटिया)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- jab wall par lag jati hai fafundi to bo lagti hai filthy

Synonyms: - grimy, grubby, muddy, nasty, soiled, squalid, etc.

Antonyms:- clean, pure, sterile, unpolluted, etc.



E.g.:- His house was filthy with papers and eatables strewn everywhere.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Eloquent:- having or showing the ability to use language clearly and effectively (अपनी बात बहुत प्रभावशाली ढंग से कहने वाला) **AMAN SIR ENGLISH**

Root words :- loqui - to speak

Synonyms:- affecting, articulate, fervent, outspoken, etc.

Antonyms:- apathetic, dispassionate, dull, frigid, etc.



E.g.:- When you listen to the eloquent politician speak, you always understand his message.

Recluse:- a person who lives alone and avoids other people; a hermit (दुनिया से कटकर अकेले रहने वाला)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- re bo kisi ko close nhi ane deta bo recluse hai

Synonyms: - hermit, anchorite, ascetic, cenobite, monk, etc.

Antonyms:- extrovert, socialite, mixer, extrovert, etc.



E.g.:- Despite her reputation as a recluse, Samantha held regular gatherings in her home to entertain close friends.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Sporadically:- not often; rarely (कभी-कभी या रुक-रुक कर होने वाला)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- stop + periodically

Synonyms:- occasionally, rarely, scarcely, sporadically, etc.

Antonyms:- frequently, regularly, often, usually, etc.



E.g.:- I watch television sporadically, but there aren't any shows I watch on a regular basis.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Divergence:- the situation in which two things become different
(एक बिंदु से अलग-अलग दिशा में जाना)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- divert

Synonyms:- separation, dividing, parting,

Antonyms:- sameness, accord, convergence,

E.g.:- The married couple is currently in a state of divergence, going through the divorce process so they can legally separate.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Disgrace:- behave in a way that belittles or degrades
(someone) (बेइज्जती या सम्मान खो देना)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- dis + grace

Synonyms:- contempt, degradation, dishonor, disrespect, etc.

Antonyms:- admiration, approval, credit, elevation, etc.



E.g.:- The soldier's decision to flee the battlefield made him the disgrace of his unit.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Plight:- an unpleasant condition, especially a serious, sad, or difficult one (किसी की बहुत दयनीय या बुरी हालत)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- plight after flight crash

Synonyms:- condition, predicament, quandary, trouble, etc.

Antonyms:- advantage, benefit, boon, good fortune, blessing etc.



E.g.:- My problems aren't much compared with the plight of the storm victims.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Blooming:- growing into a beautiful or final phase
(फूलों का खिलना या पूरी तरह निखरना)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- flower blooming

Synonyms: - budding, flourishing, blossoming, sprouting, etc.

Antonyms:- barren, declining, fading, sterile, unfruitful, etc.



E.g.:- The flowers were mere buds for most of the year, but now that they have enough sunlight, they are blooming.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Delegate (verb):- to give tasks or responsibilities to others
(अपना काम या ज़िम्मेदारी दूसरों को सौंपना)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- officers ne delhi gate ki security ka kam constables ko delegate kar diya

Synonyms:- appoint, elect, commission, designate, nominate, etc.

Antonyms:- deny, refuse, retract, keep, hold, retain etc.



E.g.:- The manager will delegate many of his duties to the new assistant manager.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Transient:- lasting for only a short time; temporary
(थोड़े समय के लिए रहने वाला)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics:- train will go in seconds it is transient not permanent

Synonyms:- ephemeral, fleeting, transitory, volatile, etc.

Antonyms:- enduring, permanent, perpetual, etc.



E.g.:- The snow is transient and will melt as soon as the sun appears.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Innate:- a quality or ability which you are born with, or which is present naturally (जो जन्म से ही अंदर मौजूद हो)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- in + it

Synonyms:- elemental, inborn, ingrained, inherent, essential, etc.

Antonyms:- acquired, extrinsic, incidental, meditated etc.



E.g.:- Penguins are born with the innate inclination to live together.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Preposterous:- contrary to nature, reason, or common sense (बिल्कुल बेतुका या हास्यास्पद)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- sirf pre clear hote hi poster chhapva dena preposterous hai

Synonyms: - foolish, goofy, silly, campy, absurd, etc.

Antonyms:- logical, realistic



Eg. Although you are a fast runner, it is preposterous to think you can catch that car on foot.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Clandestine:- planned or done in secret (चुपके से किया गया गुप्त काम)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- candle light mein teen log planning kar rhe the

Synonyms: - covert, fraudulent, furtive, hidden, illicit, etc.

Antonyms:- aboveboard, authorized, honest, known, legal,



E.g.:- He has been having a clandestine affair with his secretary for three years.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

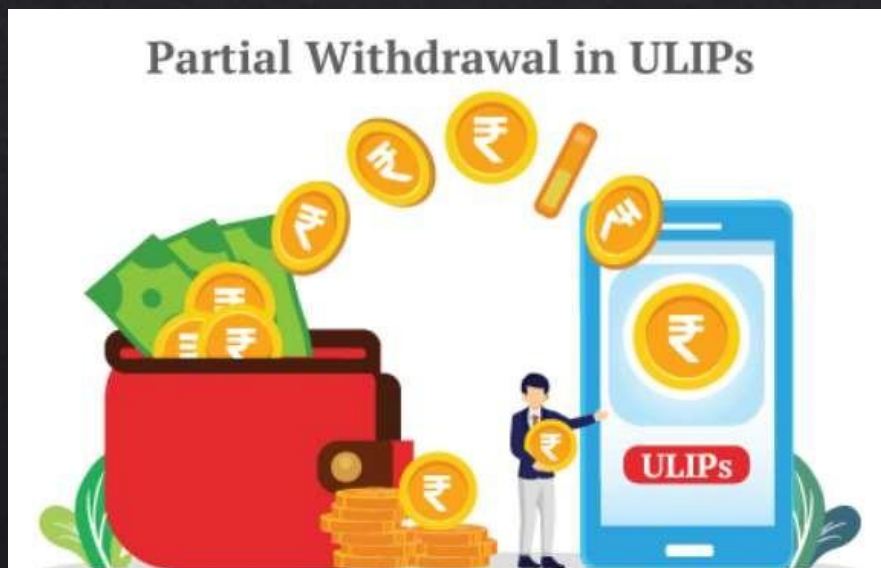
Partial:- part of the whole; incomplete (पक्षपाती या जो पूरा न हो)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- only a part not full

Synonyms:- imperfect, sectional, fractional, fragmentary etc.

Antonyms:- complete, entire, fair, just, total, unbiased, etc.



E.g.:- Our boss rejected the proposed plan because he claimed that it was only a partial solution to the problem.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Trivial:- having little value or importance (बहुत ही छोटी या मामूली बात)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- tere jese vele log trivial baat hi kar sakte hai

Synonyms: - frivolous, minor, paltry, evanescent, meager, etc.

Antonyms:- essential, major, necessary, pertinent, relevant, etc.



E.g.:- Someone needs to tell Anamika that no human being is trivial, and she should be nicer to the people that work under her.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Abate:- to become less strong (तीव्रता या गुस्से में कमी आना)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- tamatar ke rate ab honge abate

Synonyms:- diminish, dull, dwindle, ebb, recede, Slacken, etc.

Antonyms:- develop, enlarge, expand, extend, incite, etc.



E.g.:- The mayor plans to abate air pollution in the city by limiting traffic.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Abandoned:- left in a particular place or condition, usually forever (त्यागा हुआ या जिसे छोड़ दिया गया हो)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- ab band hogayi uski factory to abandon karni padi

Synonyms:- forsaken, jilted, vacant, discarded, forgotten, etc.

Antonyms:- moral, virtuous, innocent, cherished, etc.



E.g.:- Many abandoned warehouses are being converted into fashionable shops.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

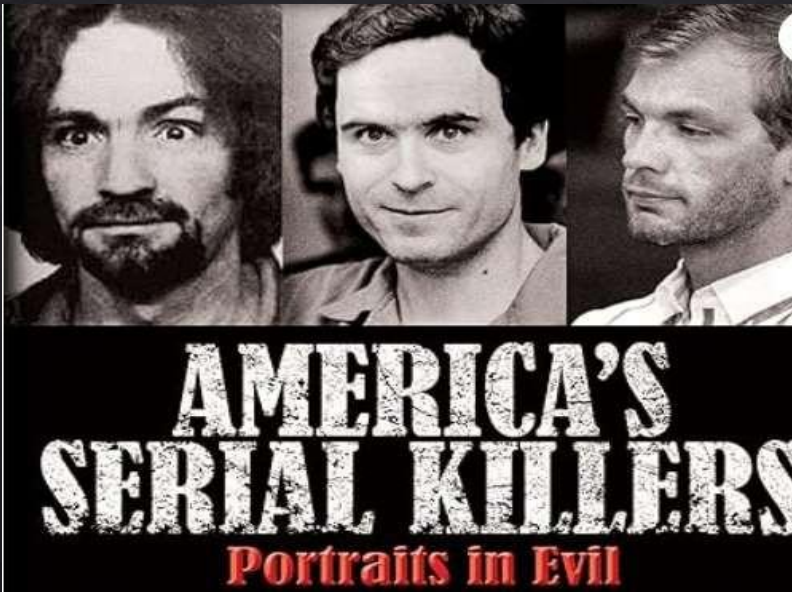
Nefarious:- very evil and wicked (बहुत ही अधर्मी या दुष्टता भरा)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- nefarious kam karne balo se sab nafrat krte hai

Synonyms: - heinous, horrible, odious, outrageous, shameful, etc.

Antonyms:- delightful, magnificent, honorable, virtuous, etc.



E.g.:- One man employed his nefarious scheme to hack into people's computers and steal bank account information.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Meticulous:- very careful and with great attention to every detail
(हर छोटी बारीकी का ध्यान रखने वाला)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- chhoti moti chize bhi calculate karke karta hai

Synonyms: - accurate, cautious, conscientious, fastidious, etc.

Antonyms:- messy, negligent, imprecise, etc.



E.g.:- Because of his meticulous skill, Mr. Gupta is considered to be one of the best surgeons in the country.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Encouraged:- raised one's spirits; gave confidence
(जिसका उत्साह बढ़ाया गया हो)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- in + courage

Synonyms: - optimistic, roused, fearless, enthusiastic, etc.

Antonyms:- discouraged, disheartened, dispirited, etc.



E.g.:- A recruiter went to the school and encouraged students to join the military instead of going straight to work after graduation.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Homicidal:- characterized by or likely to commit murder
(हत्या करने की इच्छा रखने वाला)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- homi (human) + cide (kill)

Synonyms:- brutal, cruel, fierce, violent, passionate, etc.

Antonyms:- calm, impotent, tame, pleasant, mild, etc.



E.g.:- Homicidal thoughts caused the deranged woman to plot a way to kill her estranged husband.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Sluggish:- slow-moving and lacking in energy
(काम करने में बहुत धीमा या सुस्त)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics:- slow + leg

Synonyms:- lethargic, listless, slack, stagnant, apathetic etc.

Antonyms:- alert, energetic, lively, moving, spirited, etc.



E.g.:- A heavy lunch makes me sluggish in the afternoon.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Evident:- easily seen or understood (जो बिल्कुल साफ और ज़ाहिर हो)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- evidence milne se sara case evident ho gya

Synonyms:- conspicuous, noticeable, obvious, palpable, etc.

Antonyms:- concealed, dubious, inconspicuous, obscure, etc.



E.g.:- It was evident to everyone who looked at the burnt casserole that Janavhi was not a good cook.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Hinder:- to hold back or to make difficult to accomplish

(काम में बाधा या रुकावट पैदा करना)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Mnemonics :- hamare anda ka dar hmari progress ko hinder karta hai

Synonyms: - burden, frustrate, hamper, prevent, obstruct, etc.

Antonyms:- assist, expedite, loosen, permit, etc.

E.g.:- With her quick wits, she was able to hinder the computer hackers and prevent them from accessing her system
