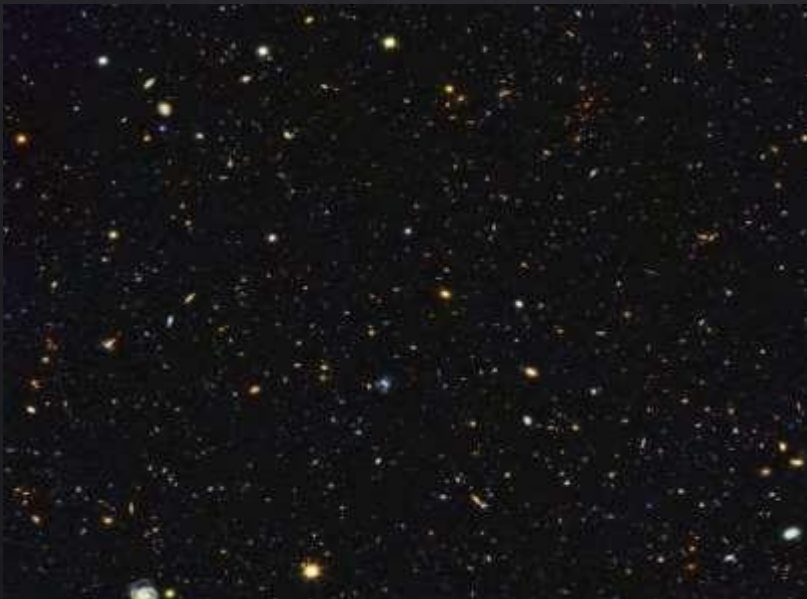

11.Cautious:- Someone who is cautious avoids risks (खतरे के प्रति बहुत सावधान)

Mnemonics:- Pre + caution

Synonyms:- Circumspect, Considerate, Guarded

Antonyms:- Incautious, Reckless, Careless



Eg.:- The burglar was very cautious, so he avoided the security perfectly as they didn't find any proof.

12. Intriguing:- to make somebody very interested and wanting to know more (उत्सुकता जगाने वाला या दिलचस्प)

Mnemonics:- antriksh se ayi things badi intriguing hoti hai

Synonyms:- Fascinate, Absorbing, Stirring

Antonyms:- Boring, Unexciting, Unstimulating

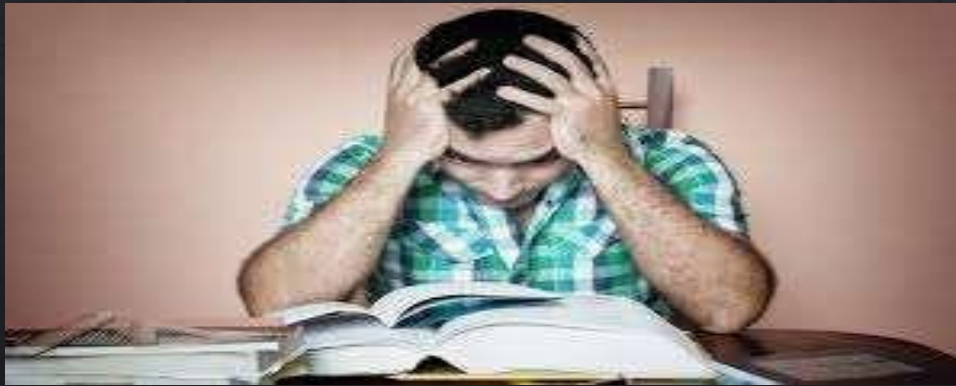

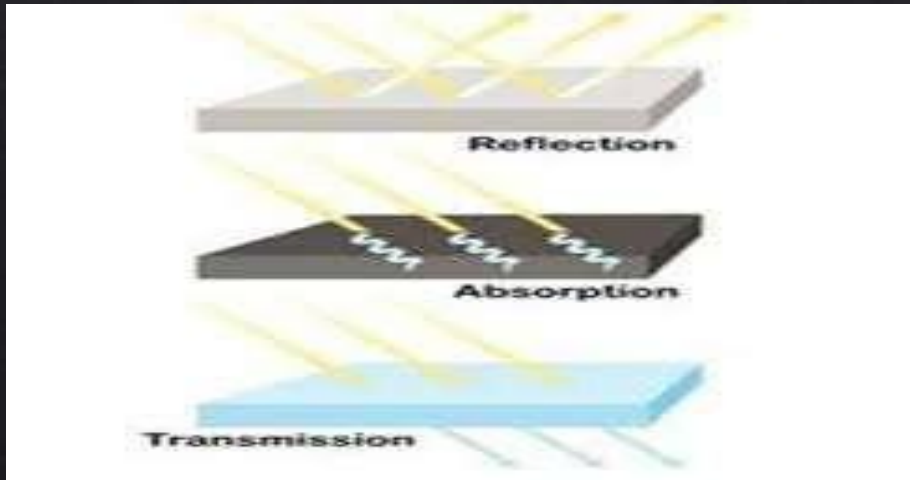

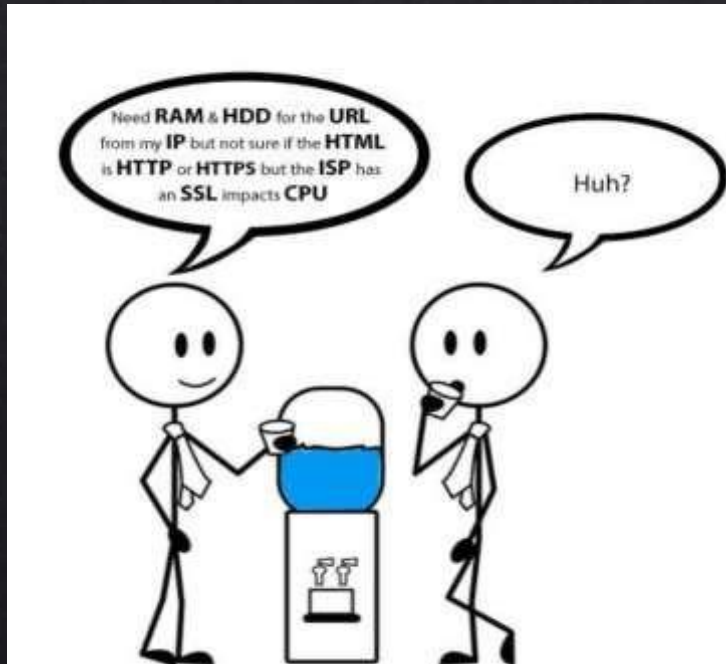

E.g. Who is supposed to have committed these transgressions?

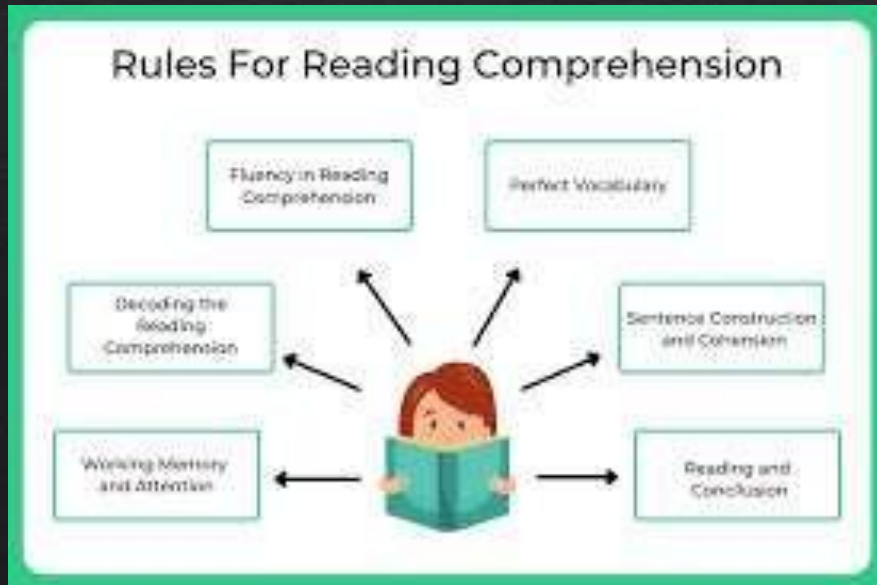
43. Comprehensive:- complete and including everything that is necessary (विस्तृत जिसमें सब कुछ शामिल हो)

Mnemonics :- reading comprehension karne ke liye English ki comprehensive knowledge honi chahiye

Synonyms:- complete, encyclopedia, extensive, widespread, etc.

Antonyms:- partial, restricted, narrow, exclusive, particular, etc.

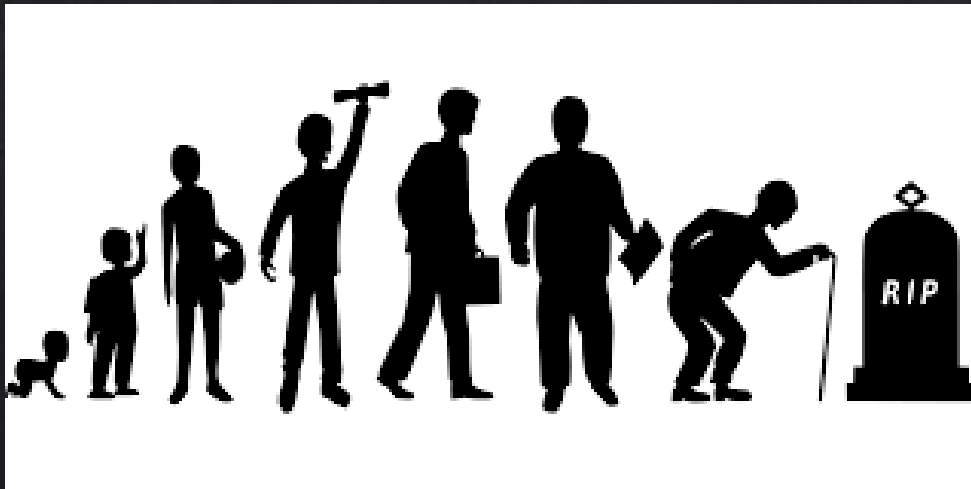

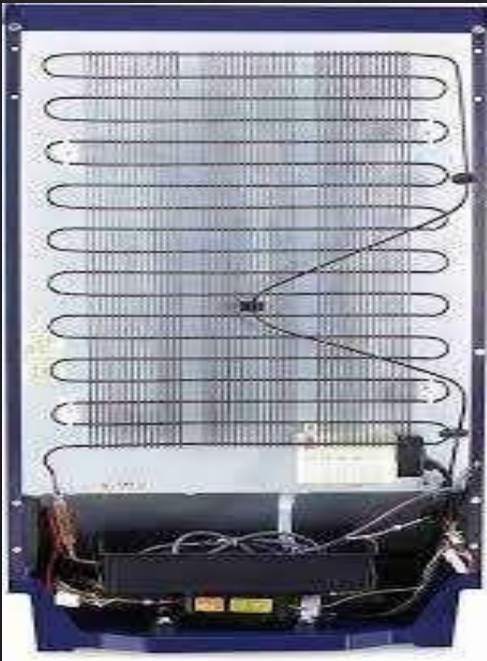

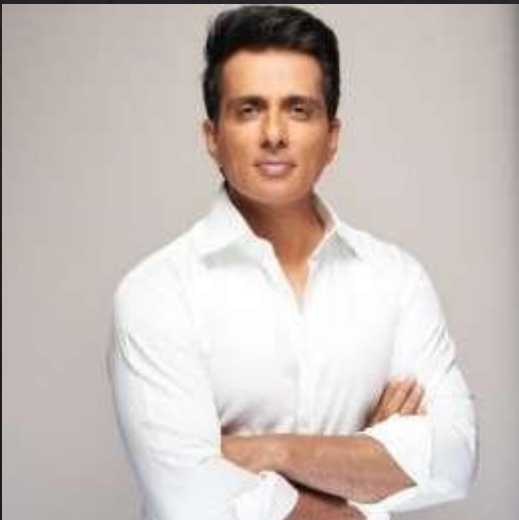
61. Credible:- able to be believed or trusted: (भरोसेमंद या विश्वास करने योग्य)

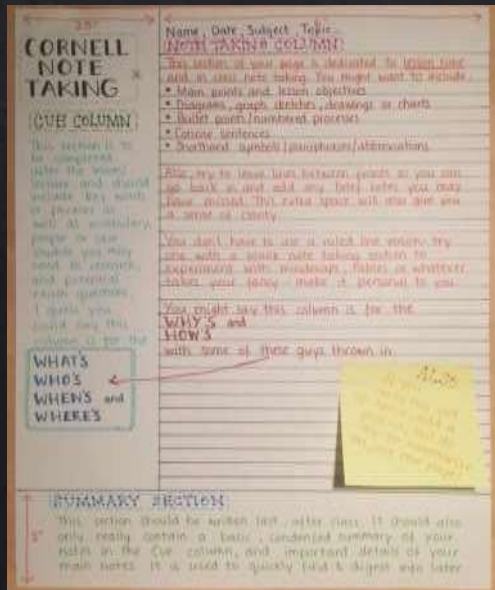
