Zealous	(काम के प्रति बहुत उत्साही) Using great energy and Enthusiasm
Feeble	(शारीरिक रूप से बहुत कमजोर) With no energy or power, Weak
Hostile	(दुश्मनी भरा या विरोधी व्यवहार) Having very strong feelings against somebody/something
Insidious	(छल कपट से नुकसान पहुँचाने वाला) Something unpleasant or Dangerous, Something gradually and secretly causing harm
Abound	(बड़ी संख्या या मात्रा में होना) To exist in large numbers
Peruse	(ध्यानपूर्वक बारीकी से पढ़ना) To read through something, especially in order to find the part you are interested in
Yield	(हार मान लेना या पैदावार देना) To give up under pressure; surrender.
Consent	(अपनी मंजूरी या सहमति देना) To agree to something
Vain	(बेकार की कोशिश या घमंडी) too proud of appearance , abilities or achievements etc
Vain	(व्यर्थ) Not producing a desired result
Interlinked	(आपस में जुड़ना) joined or connected together, with the parts that are joined often having an effect on each other
Cautious	(खतरे के प्रति बहुत सावधान) Someone who is cautious avoids risks
Intriguing	(उत्सुकता जगाने वाला या दिलचस्प)

	to make somebody very interested and wanting to know more
Spurious	(दिखने में असली पर असल में नकली) Based on false reasoning or information, and therefore not to be trusted
Verbose	(ज़रूरत से ज्यादा शब्दों का प्रयोग) Using or containing more words than necessary
Consequence	(किसी कार्य का नतीजा या परिणाम) A result of a particular action or situation, often one that is bad or not convenient
Unbiased	(बिना किसी पक्षपात के निष्पक्ष) Able to judge fairly
Utilitarian	(केवल उपयोगिता या काम पर केंद्रित) Designed to be useful rather than decorative
Inevitable	(जिसे टाला न जा सके, निश्चित) Certain to happen; Unavoidable
Degradation	(सम्मान या स्तर में भारी गिरावट) The situation in which people are made to feel they have no value
Certain	(पूरी तरह पक्का या सुनिश्चित) Having no doubt or knowing Exactly that something is true
Tedious	(बहुत थकाऊ और उबाऊ काम) Boring and rather frustrating
Benevolent	(दयालु और परोपकारी स्वभाव वाला) Giving money or help to people or organizations that need it
Incredible	(अविश्वसनीय या बहुत ही शानदार) Impossible, or very difficult to believe, Extremely good
Vendetta	(पुरानी पुश्तैनी दुश्मनी या बदला)

	A long and violent argument between people or families
Adamant	(अपनी बात पर अड़ा रहने वाला) Determined in character, action, or ideas
Treacherous	(धोखेबाज़ या बहुत खतरनाक रास्ता) A person who deceives someone who trusts them, or has no loyalty
Sever	(काटकर बिल्कुल अलग कर देना) To break or separate, especially by cutting
Apathy	(उत्साह या दिलचस्पी की कमी) A feeling of listlessness and dissatisfaction arising from a lack of occupation or Excitement.
Diligent	(मेहनती और अपने काम में पक्का) Careful and using a lot of effort
Temerity	(दुस्साहस या बेबाक ढिठाई) Extremely confident behavior that shows a lack of respect and is considered rude
Vulnerable	(आसानी से चोट खाने योग्य) Able to be easily physically or Mentally hurt, Influenced, or Attacked
Immerse	(पूरी तरह डुबोना या मग्न होना) To put something or someone completely under the surface of a liquid
Resplendent	(चमकदार और अत्यंत प्रभावशाली) Having a very bright or beautiful appearance
Delight	(बहुत गहरी खुशी या आनंद) The pleasures of something
Absorbed	(लीन) Giving all your attention to something
Genial	(बहुत मिलनसार और खुशमिजाज़) Extremely nice and happy

Jargon	(किसी खास क्षेत्र की तकनीकी भाषा) special words and phrases that are used by particular groups of people, especially in their work
Fierce	(बहुत उग्र, डरावना या तीव्र) physically violent and frightening
Misanthropic	(मानव जाति से नफरत करने वाला) not liking other people
Cheered	(उत्साह बढ़ाना या जय-जयकार करना) to give a loud shout of approval or encouragement:
Mitigation	(नुकसान या तीव्रता को कम करना) the act of reducing how harmful, unpleasant, or bad something is
Transgression	(नियम या मर्यादा का उल्लंघन) an action that breaks a law or rule
Comprehensive	(विस्तृत जिसमें सब कुछ शामिल हो) complete and including everything that is necessary
Crooked	(टेढ़ा-मेढ़ा या बेईमान इंसान) not forming a straight line, or having many bends:
Earnestly	(पूरी गंभीरता और ईमानदारी से) in a serious and determined way, often without humour
Enervate	(कमज़ोर कर देना या ऊर्जा सोखना) to make someone feel weak and without energy
Exuberance	(बहुत अधिक जोश और उमंग) the quality of feeling energetic, or the behaviour of someone who feels this way
Judicious	(बुद्धिमानी और विवेक से भरा) having or showing reason and good judgment in making decisions
Extol	(किसी की बहुत प्रशंसा करना)

	to praise something or someone very much
Gentle	(स्वभाव से बहुत नरम और कोमल) calm, kind, or soft
Committed	(अपने लक्ष्य के प्रति समर्पित) loyal and willing to give your time and energy to something that you believe in
Predicament	(एक कठिन या अप्रिय स्थिति) an unpleasant situation that is difficult to get out of
Extinct	(जो अब दुनिया से खत्म हो चुका हो) not active or existing now
Audacity	(बड़ी ढिठाई या साहसी कदम) courage or confidence of a kind that other people find shocking or rude
Glorify	(बढ़ा-चढ़ाकर तारीफ या गौरव करना) to praise and honour God or a person
Mortal	(मरणशील जिसका अंत निश्चित हो) those who will die
Modest	(साधारण, विनम्र या मर्यादित)

	not large in size or amount, or not expensive
Sustainable	(लंबे समय तक टिकने योग्य) able to continue over a period of time
Predators	(दूसरे जीवों का शिकार करने वाले) an animal that hunts, kills, and eats other animals
Fragile	(नाजुक जो आसानी से टूट जाए) Breakable
Credible	(भरोसेमंद या विश्वास करने योग्य) able to be believed or trusted
Devastating	(सब कुछ तबाह कर देने वाला) causing a lot of damage or destruction
Connote	(इशारे में अतिरिक्त अर्थ बताना) If a word, object, or situation connotes something, it makes you think of a feeling or an idea that is more than its basic meaning
