

Drove :- a large number of people or animals, often moving or doing something as a group
(जानवरों या लोगों का समूह)

Aman Sir English

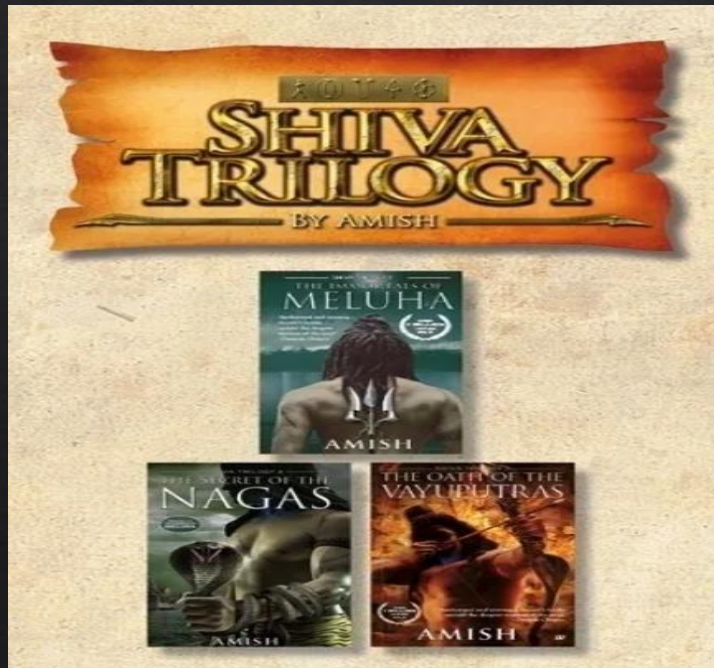
Mnemonics:-bhut sare logo ka drove gadia drive karke aya



Eg:- Drove of people came to the hill station on the weekend.

Trilogy:- a group of three novels, plays, etc. that form a set
(तीन फिल्मों या किताबों की कड़ी)

Mnemonics:- tri (three) + logy



Eg:- The shiva trilogy written by Amish is very famous among the readers.

Autonomy:- the quality or state of being self-governing
(खुद का शासन या स्वायत्तता)

Mnemonics:- auto (self) + nomos (rule)



Eg:- A good boss provides his workers with the autonomy necessary to create their own ideal working conditions.

Astronaut:- A person who is trained to travel in a spacecraft
(अंतरिक्ष में यात्रा करने वाला यात्री)

Eg:- There is not enough air in the space capsule to keep the three astronauts alive.

Eavesdropper:- a person who listens to someone's private conversation without them knowing (चुपके से दूसरों की बातें सुनने वाला) Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- ears + drop in someone's conversation



Eg:- He didn't mean to eavesdrop, but the conversation on other side of the wall was too loud to ignore.

Infirmary:- A place in a large institution, for the care of those who are ill (अस्पताल या छोटा चिकित्सा केंद्र)

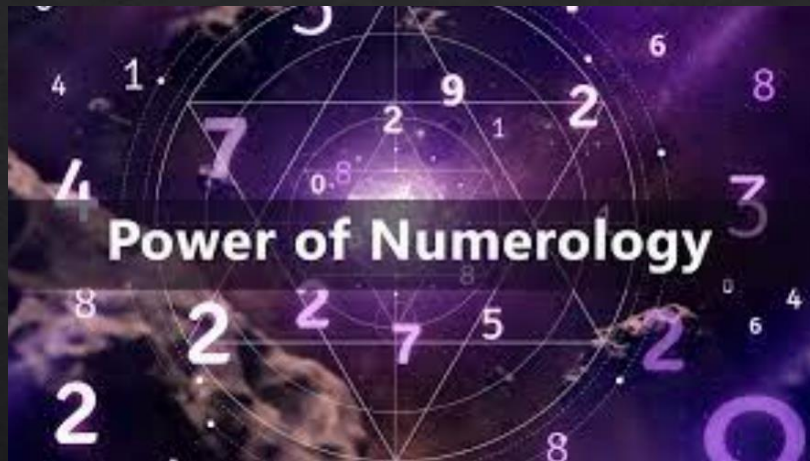

Eg:- While on the ship, an sailor who falls sick will be treated by a medic inside the vessel's infirmary.

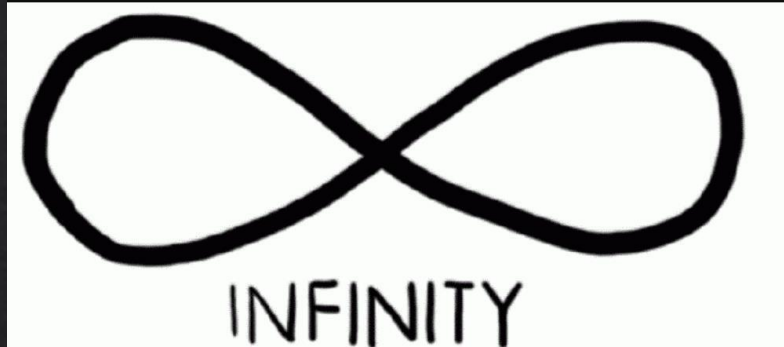
Numerologist:- One who studies the occult meanings of numbers and their supposed influence on human life (अंकों से भविष्य बताने वाला)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- He is numerologist so he does all his important tasks on particular dates.

Infinite:- an amount that is so endless it's impossible to calculate (जिसका कोई अंत न हो, अनंत)



Eg:- The list of prime numbers is infinite and keeps going on and on forever with no end.

Fortuitous:- something that is to your advantage but happened by chance (अचानक और अच्छी किस्मत से हुआ)

Mnemonics:- good fortune

You won the Lottery.*



Eg:- Shivam proved to be fortuitous by selecting all six winning lotto numbers.

Disrupt:- interrupt (an event, activity, or process) by causing a disturbance or problem (काम में बाधा या खलल डालना)

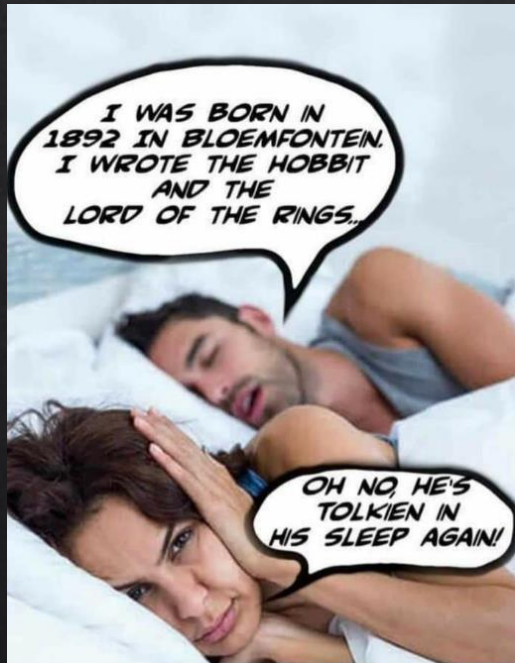
Mnemonics:- interrupt/ disturb



Eg:- The loud tones of machinery were the only things to disrupt the otherwise quiet calm of the forest.

Somniloquy :- The act or habit of talking in one's sleep
(नींद में बोलने की बीमारी)

Mnemonics:- somni (sleep) + loquy(to speak)



Eg:- Sleep talking , sometimes called somniloquy , might wake up the person next to you, but it's harmless.

Bouquet :- a creative arrangement of flowers (फूलों का सुंदर गुलदस्ता)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- Our local florist created a lovely bridal bouquet of red and white flowers for my daughter's wedding.

Arbitrator :- A person appointed by two parties to solve a dispute
(झगड़ा सुलझाने वाला मध्यस्थ)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- To solve their bitter dispute they hired an arbitrator.

Mortality :- The state of being subject to death (मृत्यु दर या मरणशीलता)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- The mortality rate continues to rise in areas where adequate medical care is scarce.

Medley:- a collection of songs or other musical items performed as a continuous piece. (अलग-अलग गानों या चीजों का मिश्रण)

Mnemonics:- medley should be melodious

Eg:- He played a medley of popular songs on the piano.

Cypher/Cipher:- A secret or disguised way of writing (गुप्त भाषा या शून्य)

Mnemonics:- cyber police cypher codes ko decypher karti hai

Eg:- The embassy was ordered to destroy its cipher equipment and remaining codes.

Cacophony :- an unpleasant mixture of loud sounds (कानों को चुभने वाला शोर)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- caco (bad) + phony (sound)



Eg:- The cacophony in the crowded classroom was unbearable for the teacher.

Brood :- a group of young birds all born at the same time
(चिड़ियों के बच्चों का समूह)

Mnemonics:- brothers



Eg:- My neighbor's brood consists of eight children.

Siesta :- A short rest or sleep taken after lunch (दोपहर की छोटी सी नींद)

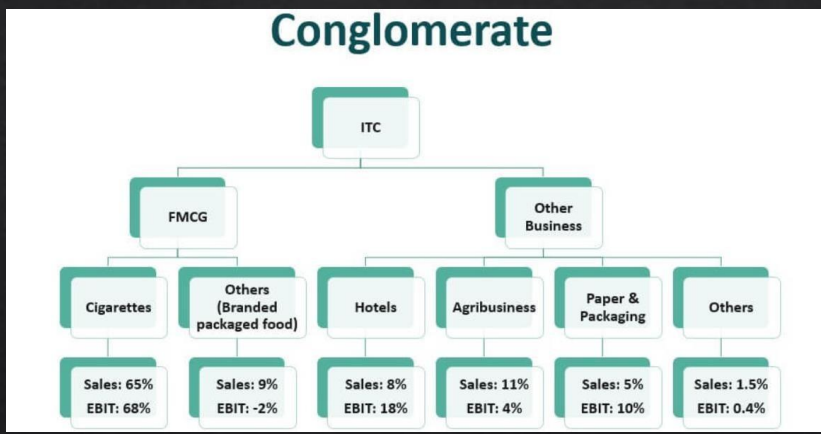
Mnemonics:- heavy nashta khake lete siesta



Eg:- After eating a heavy lunch, the only thing on the sluggish worker's mind was taking a siesta under a tree.

Conglomerate :- a big corporation composed of several small firms that operate as a single business (कई कंपनियों का बड़ा समूह)

Mnemonics:- combination / merging



Eg:- The billionaire's conglomerate includes restaurants, convenience stores, and a chain of hotels.

Anchor :- A person who presents a radio/television programme
(वह व्यक्ति जो रेडियो/टेलीविजन कार्यक्रम प्रस्तुत करता है)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- She works as an anchor for a news channel.

Escort :- to go with someone or something as a companion or guard (सुरक्षा के लिए साथ चलने वाला)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- police court tak escort karke leke gyi



Eg:- The guard was assigned to escort the inmate to court and then back to the jail.

Rhetoric :- The art of effective or persuasive speaking or writing
(प्रभावशाली ढंग से बोलने की कला)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- historic speech/ ache writer rhetoric speech date hain



Eg:- If someone does not stop the political rhetoric in that country, a civil war is likely to break out soon.

Creche :- A nursery where children of working parents are cared for while their parents are at work (शिशु गृह जहाँ छोटे बच्चे पलते हैं)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- His son was in the crèche while he worked.

Troop :- soldiers on duty in a large group (सैनिकों या लोगों की टोली)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- Traditionally, United Nations troops have been deployed only in a peacekeeping role.

Prophet :- a person who speaks for God, or someone who can predict what will happen in the future (ईश्वर का संदेश पहुँचाने वाला)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- In the bible, Jonah was a prophet who warned the people of Nineveh to repent before it was too late.

Mutiny :- an organized revolt against those in power
(सैनिकों द्वारा किया गया विद्रोह)



Eg:- The sepoy mutiny is considered the spark for 1857 revolt by the Indians against the British rule.

Cynic :- a person who believes that humans are only motivated by selfishness and their own interests (दूसरों की नीयत पर शक करने वाला)

Mnemonics:- sanki

Aman Sir English



Eg:- Being a cynic, the husband had a hard time believing his wife was faithful to him.

Outdo :- Be more successful than someone (दूसरे से बेहतर प्रदर्शन करना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- Mr. Kapoor loved Dennis since he was an overachiever and would outdo all the other students in class.

Agony:- extreme mental or physical suffering (अत्यधिक शारीरिक या मानसिक पीड़ा)

Mnemonics:- aag ne iski gf ko jla dia jis se isko bhut mental agony



Eg:- When his girlfriend died, he was in emotional agony for months.

Rapture :- a mood of great joy or love (अत्यधिक खुशी या आनंद की स्थिति)

Mnemonics:- rapper ki live performance se audience hui rapture Aman Sir English



Eg:- Audience was filled with rapture when he started singing his famous song.

Turncoat :- a traitor who sides with the conflicting side
(अपना दल बदलने वाला गद्दार)

Mnemonics:- turn + coat (dress) jo rival party ko support kare

Aman Sir English



Eg:- Sarah felt like a turncoat when she had to play Cricket against her former school's team.

Invader:- an army or country that uses force to enter and take control of another country (दूसरे क्षेत्र पर आक्रमण करने वाला)



Eg:- The foreign Invaders were finally defeated by allied forces.

Namesake :- a person having the same name as another
(एक ही नाम वाला दूसरा व्यक्ति)

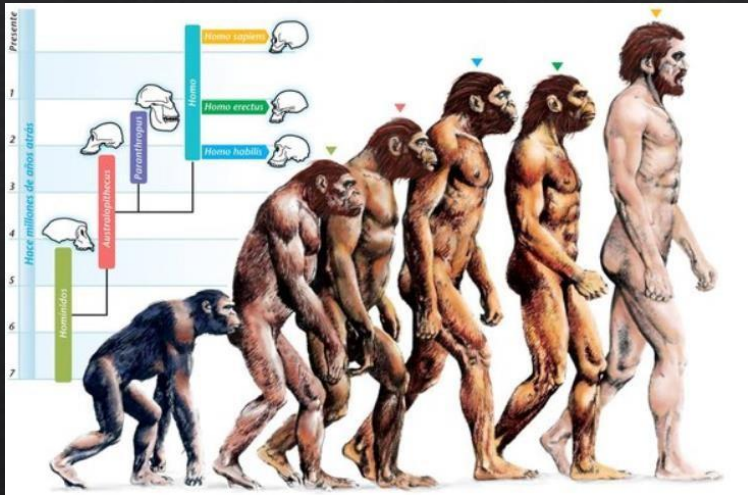
Mnemonics:- name + same



Eg:- All these actresses have Jennifer as their first name so they all are namesake.

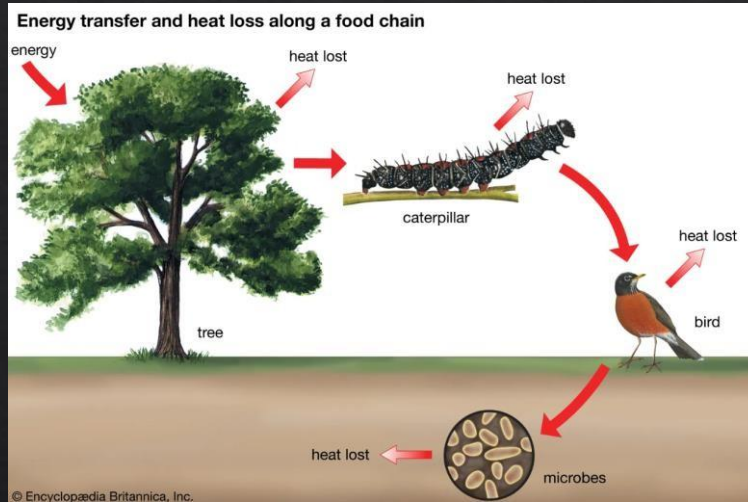
Ancestors :- a person related to you who lived a long time ago
(हमारे पूर्वज या बाप-दादा)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- Many ancient cultures have legends that their ancestors originated from gods.

Ecology :- study of environment (पर्यावरण और जीवों का संबंध)



Eg:- To understand the harmful effects of these chemicals , you have to study ecology of this area.

Valetudinarian :- a person who is unduly anxious about his/her health (बीमारी को लेकर बहुत चिंतित रहने वाला)

Mnemonics:- vela baitha tu aive hi darta rehta hai



Eg:- Whenever the valetudinarian got even the tiniest headache, he assumed he had a tumour in his brain and was about to die.

Dormitory :- A large bedroom for a number of people in a school or institution. (सोने के लिए बना बड़ा कमरा)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- dorm(sleep)



Eg:- The dormitory of our institution had all the basic facilities that a student needed.

Eclipse :- when the light of the Sun or Moon is blocked (सूर्य या चंद्र ग्रहण)

Aman Sir English



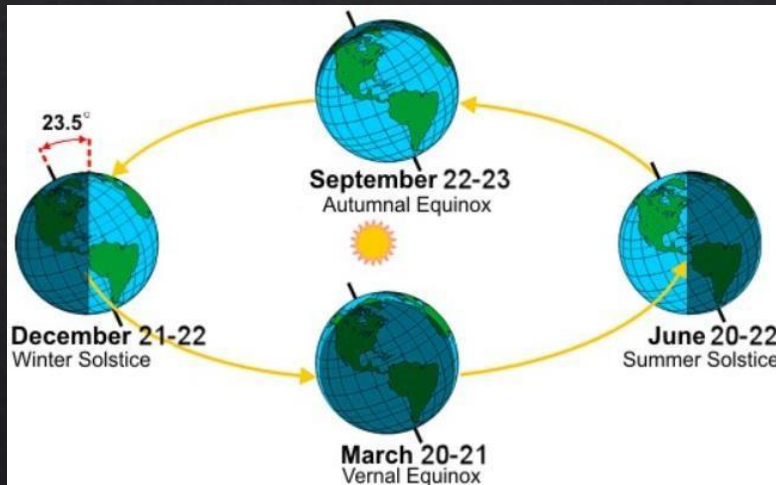
Eg:- A solar eclipse happens when the moon passes in front of the sun.

Stellar :- pertaining to the stars (सितारों से संबंधित या शानदार)



Eg:- David says that the zodiac is made up of constellations that are really just stellar patterns.

Solstice :- the time when the sun is furthest north or south of Earth's equator (साल का सबसे लंबा या छोटा दिन)



Eg:- The summer solstice occurs in June and is the longest day of the year.

Notorious :- a person of Evil reputation (बुरे कामों के लिए मशहूर)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- Unfortunately, one of the country's most notorious criminals is being paroled today.

Patrol :- to go around an area to keep a watch (सुरक्षा के लिए की जाने वाली गश्त)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- The police's daily patrol of the neighborhood stores included checking for any unlocked doors.

Honorary :- one who hold a post without salary (बिना वेतन के सम्मान में दिया गया)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- The post of treasurer is a purely honorary position.

Freelance :- working for different companies at different times, as opposed to being employed by one company
(किसी एक कंपनी से न जुड़कर काम करना)



Eg:- Rather than work a conventional job, I work freelance, simply taking up different kinds of work from different people willing to pay.

Souvenir :- an item of sentimental value, to remember an event or location (यादगार के तौर पर रखी गई चीज़)



Eg:- The more I look at my souvenir coffee mug, the more I want to go back to New York and relive those good times.

Impromptu :- done or said without earlier planning or preparation (बिना किसी तैयारी के दिया गया भाषण)

Mnemonics:- improper preparation



Eg:- The student was terrified when he was asked to deliver an impromptu speech.

Jaywalk :- to cross streets on foot carelessly
(नियम तोड़कर लापरवाही से सड़क पार करना)



Eg:- A child died yesterday after being struck by two cars while jaywalking across the busy street.

Winnow :- to separate Husk from the grain (अनाज को फटक कर साफ करना)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- wind ki help se no use chaff ko alag karna



Eg:- Harvester is used to winnow the chaff from the wheat.
