

1. Astronomy :- (तारों और ग्रहों का विज्ञान) Study of heavenly bodies

Root word :- astron (star) + omos (arranging)

Eg:- Astronomy is mentioned in ancient hindu Vedas.

2. Misogamist :- one who hates the institution of marriage

(शादी की संस्था से नफरत करने वाला)



Root word :- mis (hate) + gamy (marriage)

Eg :- As he is a misogynist, he has been avoiding getting married for the last 15 years.

3. Nephrologist :- A specialist of kidney (किडनी या गुर्दे का विशेषज्ञ डॉक्टर)

Root word :- nephrons + logy

Eg:- The condition of the patient's kidneys was a concern for the nephrologist.

4. Conscription :- compulsory enlistment for military service (देश के लिए अनिवार्य सैन्य सेवा)

Mnemonics:- koi script nhi hai ye tujhe conscription ke liye jana hoga

Eg :- Conscription exists as a means to ensure there are always men to protect and defend our nation.

5. Volunteer :- one who offers one's service

(बिना वेतन अपनी इच्छा से सेवा करने वाला)

Mnemonics:- voluntary



Eg:- As a volunteer on the childcare project, I really saw life.

6. Illiterate :- a person who does not read and write
(जिसे अक्षर ज्ञान न हो, अनपढ़)

Mnemonics :- ill+ literate

Eg:- Before slavery was abolished, most slaves were illiterate and could only sign their names with an X

7. Jockey :- A professional rider in horse race

(घुड़दौड़ में घोड़ा चलाने वाला पेशेवर)

Mnemonics :- jockey ke pajame pehente jockey

Eg:- A jockey may ride as many as 12 or 14 races a day.

8. Convalescent :- Recovering from an illness or medical treatment (बीमारी के बाद धीरे-धीरे ठीक होना)

Mnemonics:- colonel well हो रहा है sense वापस आ रहीं है.

Eg:- I treated him as a convalescent, not as a sick man.

9. Egoist :- a lover of oneself, of one's advancement
(सिर्फ अपने स्वार्थ के बारे में सोचने वाला)

Eg:- While playing a simple game of volleyball with the local kids, the egoist had to flaunt his spiking skills against the much younger boys.

10. Effeminate :- a man who is womanish in his habits
(ऐसा पुरुष जिसका स्वभाव स्त्रियों जैसा हो)

Mnemonics:- a female type

Eg:- The intolerant father got angry when he saw his effeminate son playing with dolls.

11. Fauna :- the animals of a particular region
(किसी खास क्षेत्र के जीव-जंतु)

Eg:- Camels and other desert fauna have learned to adapt to the hot climate and lack of water.

12. Malcontent :- A person who is never happy with what he has (मौजूदा व्यवस्था से असंतुष्ट व्यक्ति)

Root word :- mal + content

Eg:- The woman was such a malcontent that she complained about every dish served to her in the five-star restaurant.

13. Ophthalmologist :- One who cures eye disease
(आंखों की बीमारियों का विशेषज्ञ डॉक्टर)

Root word :- ophthalmos (eye)

Eg:- If this irritation in your eye persists you should consult an ophthalmologist .

14. General :- Affecting all or most people, places, things, etc. (सभी या ज़्यादातर लोगों को प्रभावित करना)

Mnemonics:- related to janta

Eg:- It is the general rule, that all the wealth owned by parents is inherited by their children.

15. Pedantic :- Overly concerned with minute details or formalisms (नियमों और छोटी गलतियों पर अधिक टोकने वाला)

Mnemonics:- pedantic mam choti galtio pe danti hai Aman Sir English



Eg:- The pedantic teacher often corrects his students for their grammatical mistakes.

16. Invulnerable :- One that cannot be harmed /wounded
(जिसे चोट पहुँचाना या जीतना नामुमकिन हो)

Mnemonics:- in + vulnerable

Eg:- The dangerous drivers are those who think they're invulnerable.

17. Algaecide :- A substance for killing algae
(काई या शैवाल को नष्ट करने वाली दवा)

Root word:- algae + cide



Eg:- Copper is a popular algaecide in commercial and residential pools.

18. Almanac :- an annual calendar with position of stars
(खगोलीय जानकारी वाली वार्षिक पंचांग)

Eg:- This almanac can tell when a full moon is going to be every month this year.

19. Philistine :- one who does not care about art and culture
(कला और साहित्य की समझ न रखने वाला)

Eg:- When the philistine was questioned about his opinion of the school's art program, he stated it was a waste of taxpayers' dollars.

20. Monopoly :- Exclusive command or possession
(मार्केट में किसी एक का पूरा अधिकार)

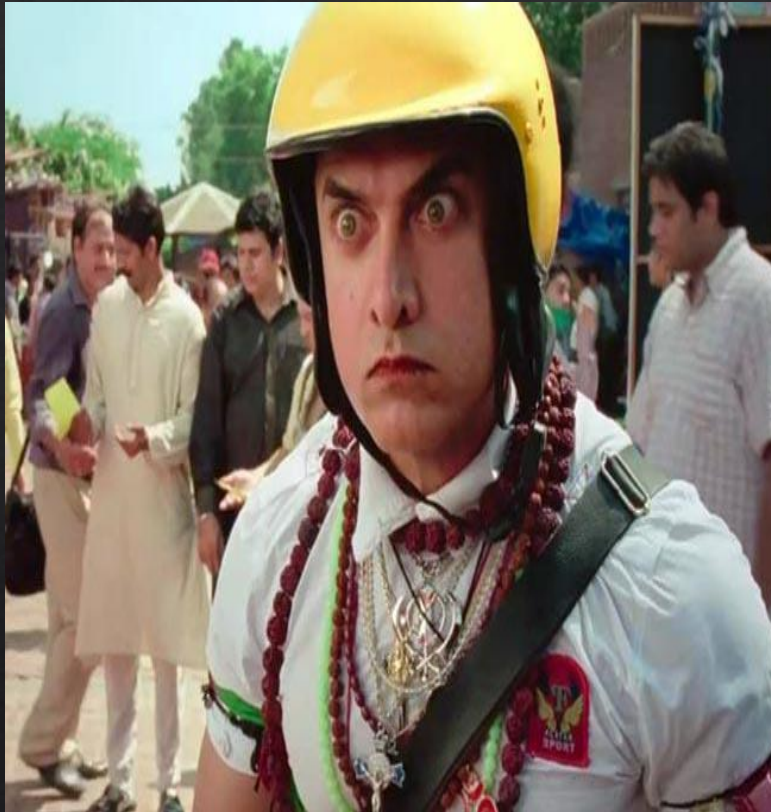

Eg:- In many countries tobacco is a government monopoly.

21. Heretic :- one who is against religion (धर्म या स्थापित मान्यताओं का विरोधी)

Mnemonics:- heretic ki harakate religion ke against hoti hai

Eg:- When the heretic denied some of the basic Christian doctrines and beliefs of the church, the pastor would not let her enter the church.

22. Effervescent :- Give off gas bubbles (उत्साह से भरा या बुलबुले छोड़ने वाला)

Mnemonics:- ee farr se vapour bnaegi

Eg:- He was having some effervescent drink.

23. Venial :- A slight fault that can be forgiven (ऐसी छोटी गलती जिसे माफ किया जा सके)

Mnemonics:- when you are ill apki galti venial lgati hai

Eg:- It was a venial sin,
so I don't think that he
should be punished.

24. Crusade :- a religious war (किसी बड़े बदलाव के लिए धर्मयुद्ध या आंदोलन)

Mnemonics:- Kurukshetra me hua tha crusade

Eg :-They have long been involved in a crusade for racial equality.

25. Plausible :- An argument or statement seeming reasonable or probable (ऐसी बात जो सुनने में सच और सही लगे)

Mnemonics:- jo lage possible

Eg:- There was no way in which that story could be considered plausible.

26. Pedestrian :- one who goes on foot (सड़क पर पैदल चलने वाला व्यक्ति)

Mnemonics:- paidal chalne wale



Eg :- There is grief and anger in us that he was driven over at the pedestrian crossing by a delivery van.

27. Apiary :- a place where bees are kept (वह स्थान जहाँ मधुमक्खियां पाली जाती हैं)

Eg:- We went to an apiary and got real honey.

28. Leonine :- Lion like characteristics (शेर जैसा या शेर से संबंधित)

Mnemonics:- like a lion

Eg:- The angry man's leonine roar caused the worker's to question if they were in an office or a jungle.

29. Sacrilege :- The violation or profanation of anything sacred or held sacred (पवित्र वस्तु या स्थान का अपमान)

Mnemonics:- sacred thing ko leg lgana sacrilege

Eg:- The actions of that man were considered sacrilege .

30. Cynosure :- one who is centre of attraction (आकर्षण का मुख्य केंद्र बिंदु)

Mnemonics:- Wo dinosaur skeleton museum ka cynosure hai

31. Itinerant :- Travelling from place to place (एक जगह से दूसरी जगह घूमने वाला)

Mnemonics:- itna rent afford nhi kar sakta isliye itinerant

Eg:- The use of itinerant magistrates gradually increased, making prosecutions more convenient.

32. Polyglot :- one who speaks many languages

(कई भाषाओं को जानने और बोलने वाला)

Root word:- poly + glot

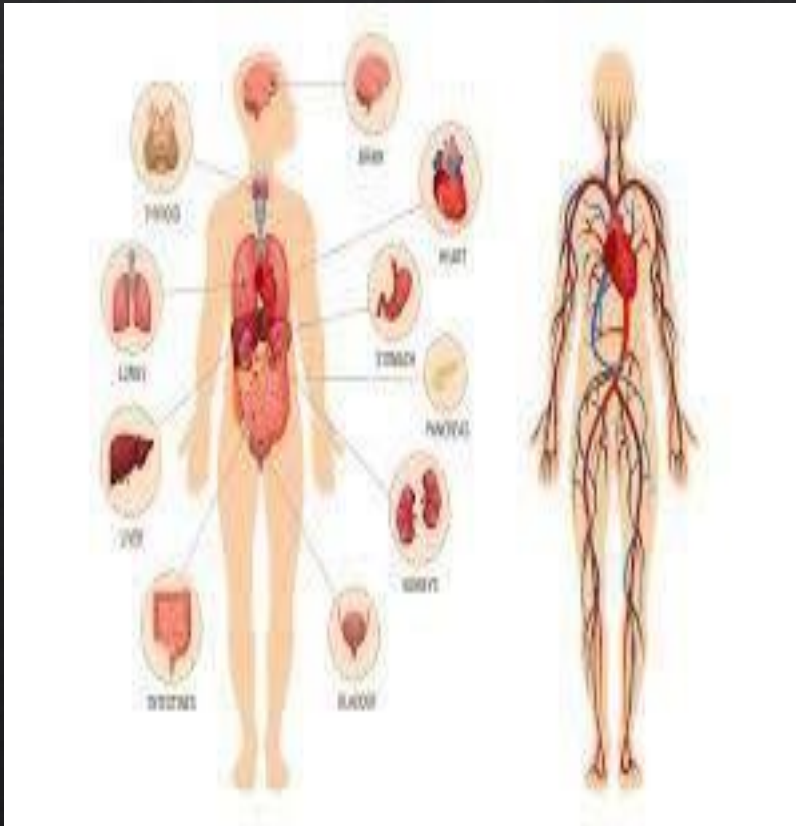

33. Physiology :- Study of body functions (शरीर के अंगों की कार्यविधि का विज्ञान)

Root word :- physio + logy

Eg:- This is valuable research that casts new light on how human physiology is influenced by hormones in the womb.

34. Demagogue :- a leader who sways his followers by his oratory (भड़काऊ भाषण देकर जनता को रिझाने वाला)

Root word :- demos (people)

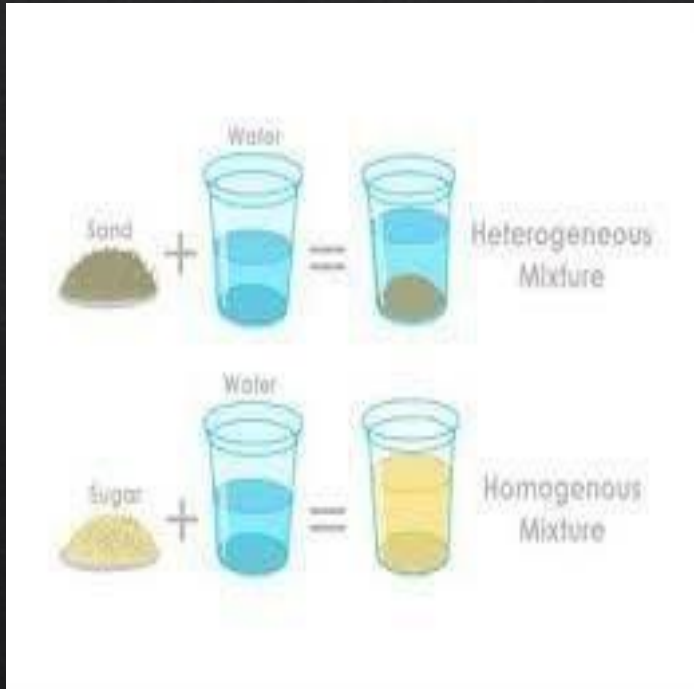
Eg :- Only a demagogue could persuade so many people to rebel against authority.

35. Homogeneous :- Belonging to the same kind

(एक ही तरह की चीज़ों से मिलकर बना)

Root word :- homo(same) + genos (type)

Eg:- homogeneous elements mix easily.

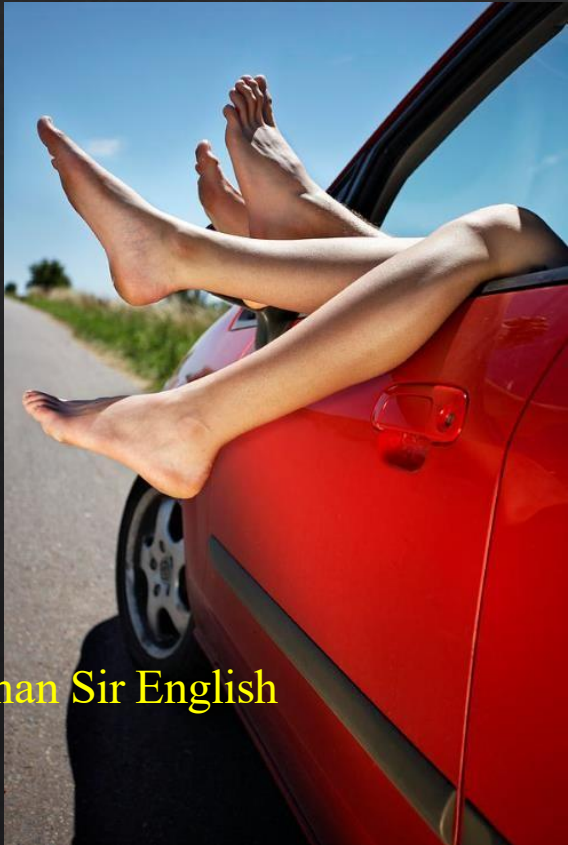

36. Precarious :- Dependent on chance or uncertainty

(अनिश्चित और खतरे से भरी स्थिति)

Mnemonics:- paer car se bahar karna precarious

37. Senile :- showing poor mental ability because of old age, especially being unable to think clearly and make decisions (बुढ़ापे के कारण कमज़ोर याददाश्त वाला)

Mnemonics:- senior citizen sathia jate hai

Eg:- I'm always losing my keys these days. I think I must be going senile.

38. Laurel :- Honour given for some achievement
(जीत पर मिलने वाला सम्मान या यश)

Eg:- Each winner was presented with a wreath of laurel.

39. Zoology :- The scientific study of the behaviour, structure, physiology, classification and distribution of animals (जीव-जंतुओं के जीवन का वैज्ञानिक अध्ययन)

Eg:- In second year, the zoology course reviews some of the major animal groups, their behaviour and ecology.

40. Torrent :- a large amount of water that is moving quickly
(पानी की बहुत तेज़ और भारी धारा)

Mnemonics:- pani with fast current



Eg:- Heavy rainfall turned the river into a rushing torrent.

41. Homicide :- Killing of a person by another (एक मनुष्य द्वारा दूसरे की हत्या)

Root word:- human + cide (kill)

Eg:- The woman, who gave police a description of the killer, is the only known eyewitness to the unsolved homicide.

42. Lucrative :- Profitable, yielding financial gain (जिस काम में बहुत अधिक मुनाफा हो)

Mnemonics:- lakho croro ka offer

Eg:- She advised us to look abroad for more lucrative business ventures.

43. Shrewd :- Showing astute powers of judgement; clever and judicious (बहुत चालाक और दिमाग वाला व्यक्ति)

Mnemonics:- she wedded a shrewd person

Eg:- She is a shrewd politician who wants to avoid offending the electorate unnecessarily.

44. Poignant :- Evoking a keen sense of sadness or regret (दिल को छू लेने वाला या मर्मस्पर्शी)

Mnemonics:- pregnant lady ke liye miscarriage is poignant

Eg:- The presence of the rest of the family made John's absence even more poignant.

45. Arsenal :- a place of ammunition and weapons (हथियारों और गोला-बारूद का भंडार)

Mnemonics:- asla barood rakhne ki jagah

Eg :- I inherited my grandfather's arsenal of weapons after he passed away.

46. Integrity :- The quality of being honest and having strong moral principles (ईमानदारी और नैतिक सिद्धांतों की मज़बूती)

Mnemonics:- dignity/ mai itna nhi gir sakta meri integrity

Eg:- He showed integrity and rejected the offer.

47. Maintain :- Cause to continue; keep up; preserve (a state of affairs, an activity etc) (किसी चीज़ को सही हालत में बनाए रखना)

Eg:- She has managed to maintain her youthful appearance.

48. Mindful :- Taking heed or care; being conscious
(किसी चीज़ के प्रति सचेत और जागरूक)

Eg:- We had to be mindful of every step we took on slippery sidewalk.

49. Compere :- A person who introduces the performers or contestants in a variety show (कार्यक्रम का संचालन करने

वाला एंकर)

Mnemonics:- anchor / come here

Eg:- She comperes that awful game show on Saturday night.

50. Seize :- Take hold of forcibly or suddenly (जबरदस्ती पकड़ना या कानूनी रूप से जब्त करना)

Mnemonics:- saza ke taur par bike seize kar li

Eg:- His bike was seized by police yesterday .

51. Gerontocracy :- a group governed by old people

(बुजुर्गों या वृद्ध लोगों का शासन)

Root word:- geron (old) + cracy (rule)



Eg:- Old politicians will obviously favour gerontocracy.
