

Hydrophobia:- Fear of water (पानी से लगने वाला डर)

root word:- hydro (water) + phobia (fear)

Eg:- People who have the symptoms of hydrophobia generally don't recover.

Calligraphy:- Beautiful handwriting that you do with a special pen/brush (सुंदर लिखावट लिखने की कला)

root word :- calli(beautiful) + graphy (writing)

Eg:- Ajay is well known for his calligraphy so he gets contracts from various publications.

Stoic:- a person who is indifferent to pain and pleasure of life, (दुख-सुख में समान रहने वाला)

mnemonics- stoic doesn't feel pain or emotions like stone



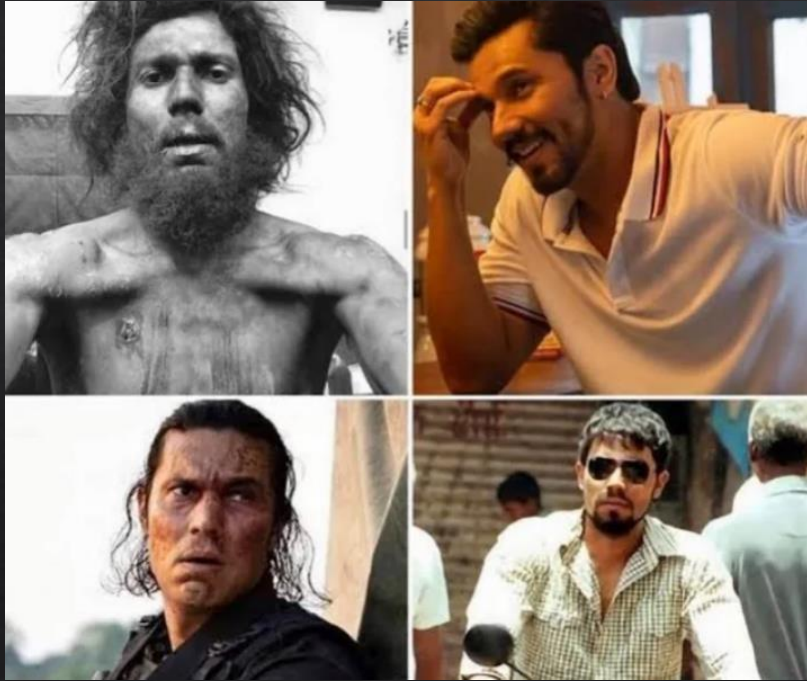
Eg:- The stoic man did not show any sign of joy when he won the biggest lottery in history.

Versatile:- someone having a many skills (कई कामों में माहिर व्यक्ति)

mnemonics:- various style me kaam kar sakta ho

Eg:- The SUV is a versatile vehicle that blends in easily on the city streets and can also handle the wilderness of the mountain trails.

Efficient:- working or operating quickly and effectively in an organised way (कार्यकुशल या पूरी तरह सक्षम)

mnemonics:- effective/ efficiency



Eg:- Solar panels are a highly efficient method of harnessing electricity without burning fossil fuels.

Utility:- The capacity for being useful for some purpose (किसी चीज़ की उपयोगिता)

Eg:- The utility vehicle was designed to carry loads more efficiently than other types of trucks.

Psychology:- The study of human mind (मानव मन का वैज्ञानिक अध्ययन)

root word :- psyche(mind) + logy (study)

Eg:- Studying psychology helped the teacher better understand the minds of her students.

Entomology:- study of science of insect (कीट-पतंगों का वैज्ञानिक अध्ययन)

root word:- entomon(insects) + logy(study)

Eg:- My brother is a student of entomology who collects cockroaches.

Curator:- a person in charge of a museum. (संग्रहालय का मुख्य संरक्षक)

mnemonics:- caretaker of museum

Eg:- The old curator was replaced with a new one after failing to maintain the museum's most treasured art exhibition.

Immigrant:- one who settled in other country (दूसरे देश में बसने वाला)

root word :- in + migrate



Eg:- Since my grandfather was an immigrant from Sweden, he brought his Swedish culture and traditions to the United States with him.

Refugee:- a person seeking protection in another country
(शरण लेने वाला शरणार्थी)

Eg:- The refugee hoped he would be granted citizenship so he would not have to return to his war-torn homeland.

Epicurean:- pursuing pleasure, especially in reference to food or comfort (अच्छे खान-पान का शौकीन)

mnemonics:- epicurean ne kha apne kadi bhut achi
bnai hai

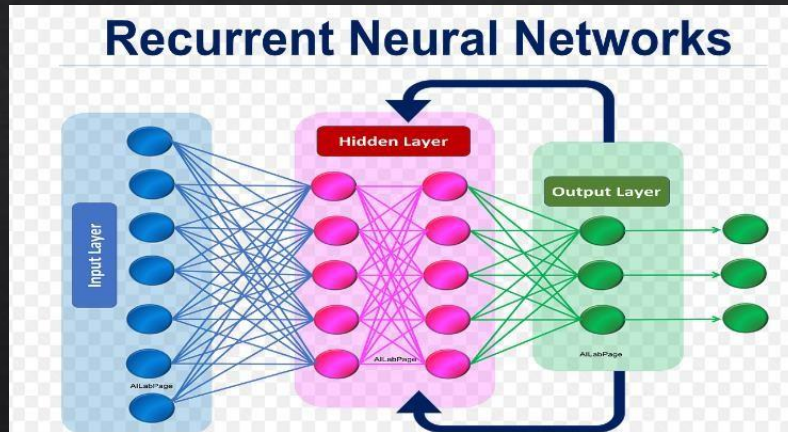
Aman Sir English



Eg:- The epicurean billionaire lives in a mansion ten stories high, with a team of cooks slaving in his kitchen.

Recurrent:- happening or recurring time after time (बार-बार होने वाली घटना)
mnemonics :- re(again) + occur

Eg:- Being late to work was a recurrent issue for him, so they had to terminate his employment.

Chastise:- to criticize someone severely (कड़ी सजा या दंड देना)

mnemonics:- child ko aksar chastise kiya jata hai

Aman Sir English



Eg:- If you bully someone in Mrs. Marshall's class, she will chastise you and keep you after school.

Scoff:- to sneer or laugh with scorn (मजाक उड़ाना या ठट्टा मारना)

mnemonics:- cough to make fun of someone

Aman Sir English



Eg:- The rude little rich girl thought it was fun to scoff at the poor children at her school.

Purr:- a low vibrating sound, usually made by a cat or a vehicle (बिल्ली की संतोषभरी आवाज़)

mnemonics- pyari sound by cat

Eg:- Cats aren't the only animals that purr, gorillas also release a low vibrating sound when they're happy.



Quorum:- minimum people needed for a meeting (सभा हेतु न्यूनतम सदस्य संख्या)

mnemonics- kam se kam number

- maximum strength - 550+2 (anglo-India)
- from states - 530, from UTs - 20
- minimum age - 25 years
- Resignation - speaker
- Chairman - speaker
- Quorum - 1/10th of members
- speaker gives resignation to - vice speaker

Eg:- When they met to discuss the issue at hand, they realized that they would postpone the session until a quorum was met.

Obsolete:- no longer of use (पुराना या अब अप्रचलित चीज़)

Invoice:- Detail list of goods dispatched with quantity and price to the purchaser. (सामान का बिल या रसीद)



Eg:- The owner of LawnPros sent an invoice to the business owner as a reminder that payment for mowing was due.

Maiden-speech:- The first public speech delivered by a person (किसी का पहला सार्वजनिक भाषण)

mnemonics:- maiden = virgin

Eg:- I am delighted to be called to make my maiden speech in this important debate.

Behemoth:- Something of Monstrous size or power
(अत्यधिक विशालकाय चीज़ या जीव)

mnemonics:- bada like mammoth

Eg:- The monster truck rally showcased a behemoth whose tires were twice as tall as I am.

Multitasking:- an ability to do several things at the same time (एक साथ कई काम करना)

mnemonics- multi + task

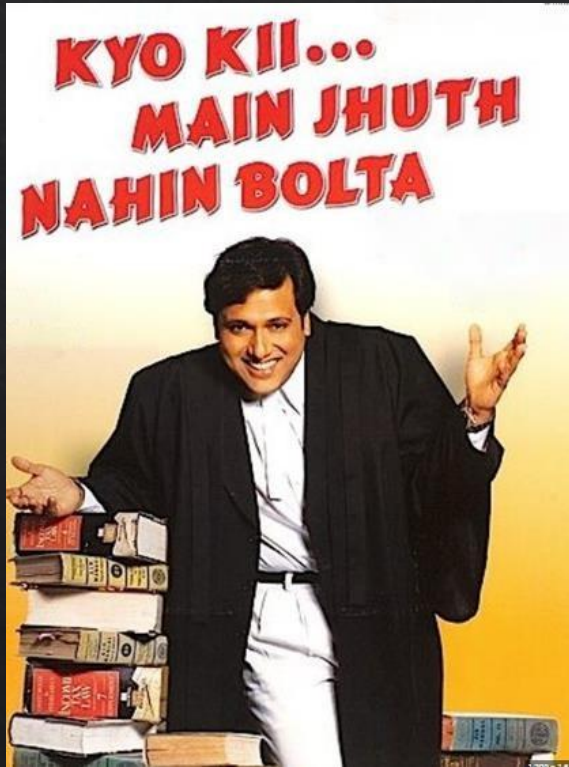


Eg:- The secretary is a pro at multi-tasking and is able to handle several different office duties at one time.

Mythomania:- The compulsion to tell lies (झूठ बोलने की मानसिक बीमारी)

root word :- myth + mania

Hypocrite:- a person who puts on a false appearance of virtue or religion. पाखुंडी

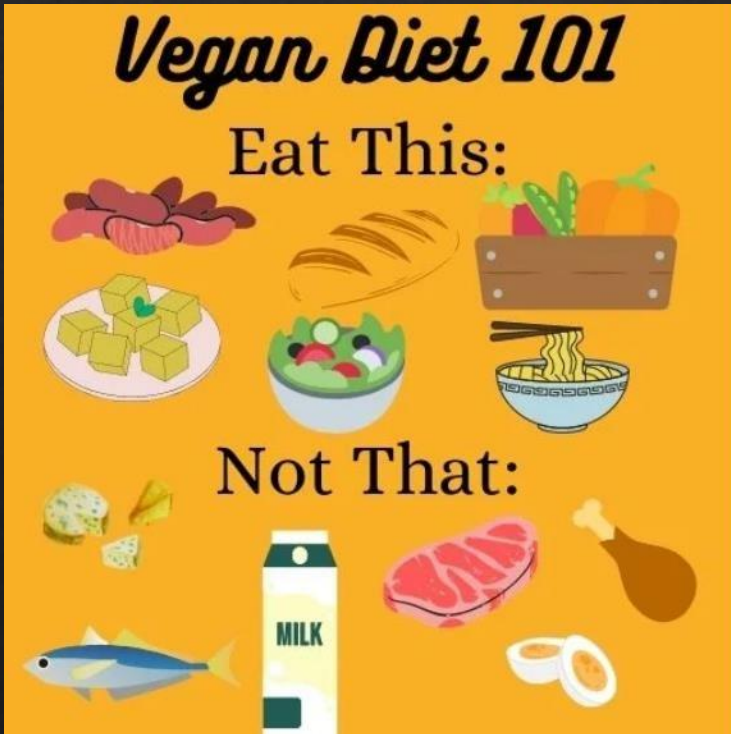
mnemonics:- hypocrisy ki bhi seema hoti hai



Eg:- A judge at the trial branded him a hypocrite and liar.

Vegan:- a person who does not eat or use animal products (पशु उत्पादों से दूर रहनेवाला)

mnemonics :- veg minus dairy

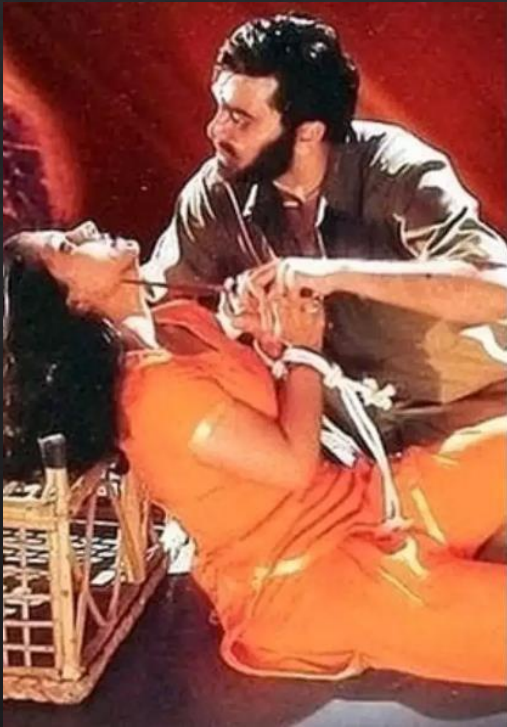


Eg:- Although the restaurant had a few vegan options, most of the dishes were made from animal products.

Sinner:- a person who does things that are wrong or immoral according to religious law (पाप करने वाला पापी व्यक्ति)

mnemonics:- sin karne wala sinner

Eg:- The holy book calls for any sinner who commits adultery to be stoned to death.

Laudable:- deserving to be praised or admired (प्रशंसा के योग्य नेक काम)

mnemonics:- applaud / loudly praise karna

Eg:- Through his laudable and courageous actions, the fireman saved five people from a burning building.

Epidemic:- a disease that is widespread and affects many people in a specific area (बड़े क्षेत्र में फैली महामारी)

mnemonics:- epi(on) + demos(people)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- If the epidemic continues to spread, it will soon be on two continents and will pose a risk to billions of people.

Ephemeral:- lasting for a very short time. (बहुत कम समय रहने वाला)

mnemonics:- abhi mar jayenge

Aman Sir English



Eg:- An ephemeral storm moved through the city, only staying briefly but leaving much destruction behind.

Overwhelm:- to have a strong emotional effect on. (अत्यधिक भावना से भर जाना)

mnemonics:- over will / over work

Aman Sir English



Eg:- Five children under the age of 5 years old would overwhelm any mother with many diaper changes, yelling, screaming, and fighting among the children.

Reluctant:- unwilling; not wanting to take some action
(किसी काम में अनिच्छुक होना)

mnemonics:- wo tent me sone ko lekar reluctant tha

Eg:- The doctor was reluctant to release his patient from the care of the hospital.

Herbivore:- an animal that eats only plants (सिर्फ शाक-सब्जी खाने वाला जीव)

root word :- herb + vore (eat)

Eg:- As an herbivore, the giraffe has teeth that are broad and capable of chewing tough plants.

Magnificent:- Extremely beautiful, elaborate or impressive
(बहुत ही शानदार और भव्य)

mnemonics:- magnum (big/ great)

Eg:- With a beautiful bride,
delicious cake and fun reception,
the guests commented about
what a magnificent wedding this
was.

Pergola:- an arch or a structure with a roof over which climbing plants can be grown. (लताओं से ढका हुआ रास्ता)



Eg:- The old shed, boundary wall and pergola create a sheltered corner exposed to the afternoon sun where herbs can thrive.

Omnipotent:- having virtually unlimited power or influence (सबसे शक्तिशाली या सर्वशक्तिमान)

root word :- omni (all) + potent(powerful)

Eg:- If the superhero can fight off twenty men at one time, then he must be omnipotent.

Archives:- the place where public, government or historical records are kept (पुराने ऐतिहासिक दस्तावेजों का संग्रह)

Eg:- Students took a trip to the historical archives to find primary documents for their research papers.

Posthumous Publication:- A book published after author's death (लेखक की मृत्यु बाद प्रकाशन)

root word :- post (after) + humus(soil/ grave)



Eg:- The posthumous publication of his diaries is awaited with trepidation by some and eager anticipation by those who knew him best.

Diagnosis:- the identification of an illness or other problem by examination of the symptoms (रोग के लक्षणों की पहचान)

Eg:- In each of the patients' charts, the doctor jotted down a diagnosis and a short description of the mental problem he or she was struggling with.

Mendicant:- one who goes from palace to place,
begging (भिक्षा मांगकर जीने वाला साधु)

mnemonics:- money ki dikkat

Aman Sir English

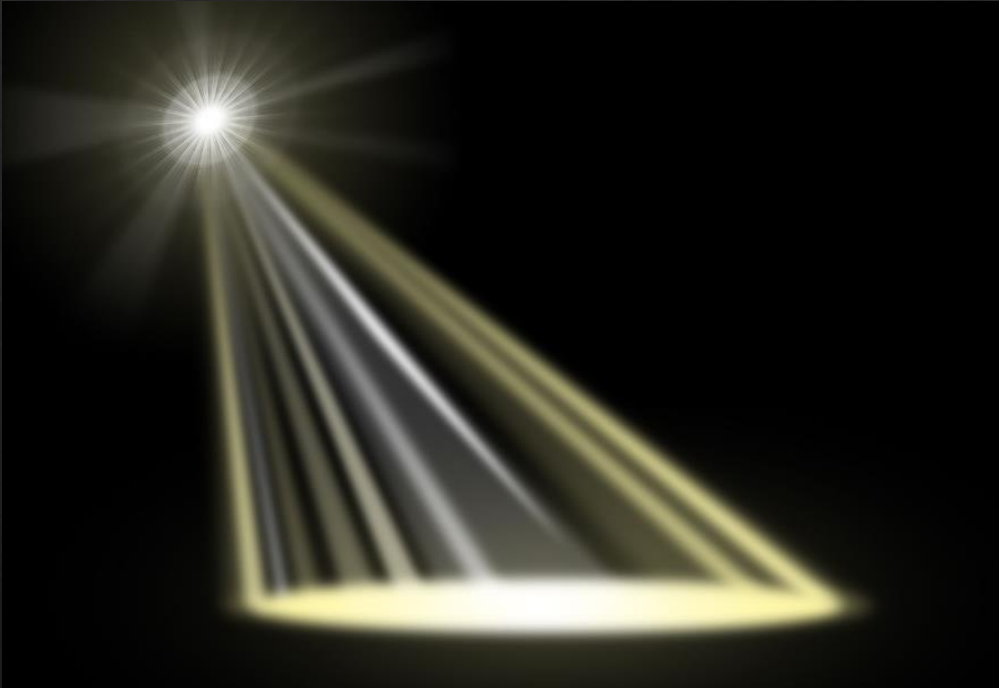


Eg:- We gave money to the mendicant who was begging on the side of the road.

Limelight:- center of public attention (चर्चा या आकर्षण का केंद्र)

mnemonics:- light

Eg:- The celebrity never liked the limelight, so he kept his personal business to himself and out of the tabloids.

Glutton:- A person who eats to much (बहुत ज्यादा खाने वाला पेटू)

mnemonics:- golu / jada mutton kha kha ke glutton



Eg:- This lazy glutton ordered a big fat meal for dinner.

Kleptomania:- the psychological urge to steal, not for gain or profit (चोरी करने की मानसिक बीमारी)

root word :- klepto (to steal) + mania (mad desire)

Eg:- George outright suffers from Kleptomania, often stealing things in arm's reach just because he feels the impulse to.

Coerce:- to persuade someone forcefully to do something that they are unwilling to do (जबरदस्ती या बल प्रयोग करना)

mnemonics:- pati to coerce karke lia nya purse



Eg:- The bully tried to coerce the small kids into giving him their lunch money.

Tricky:- to be complicated or complex (कठिन या चालाकी भरा काम)

mnemonics:- trick



Eg:- The chess player was surprised at the tricky move during the game when his opponent then said, “Checkmate!”

Trousseau:- the clothes collected by a bride for her marriage (दुल्हन के कपड़ों का संग्रह)

mnemonics:- ladke ko mili bas nyi trousers ladki ne liya pura trousseau

Eg:- The trousseau my wife brought to our marriage was far too small, so I bought her a dress as a honeymoon gift.

Garrulous:- overly talkative and chatty, mostly about unimportant things (बहुत ज्यादा बातें करने वाला)

mnemonics:- girls bhut garrulous hoti hai

Eg:- The garrulous gentleman held up the checkout line as he rambled on to the cashier about his pet squirrel.

Voracious:- having a large appetite; greedy (बहुत लालची या बहुत भूखा)
root word :- vore (to eat)

Eg:- The football player was a voracious eater who easily consumed two chickens during one meal.

Curious:- eager to learn information (कुछ जानने के लिए उत्सुक)

mnemonics:- kyu?

Eg:- Because of his curious nature, the eager student learned lots of interesting information at the library.
