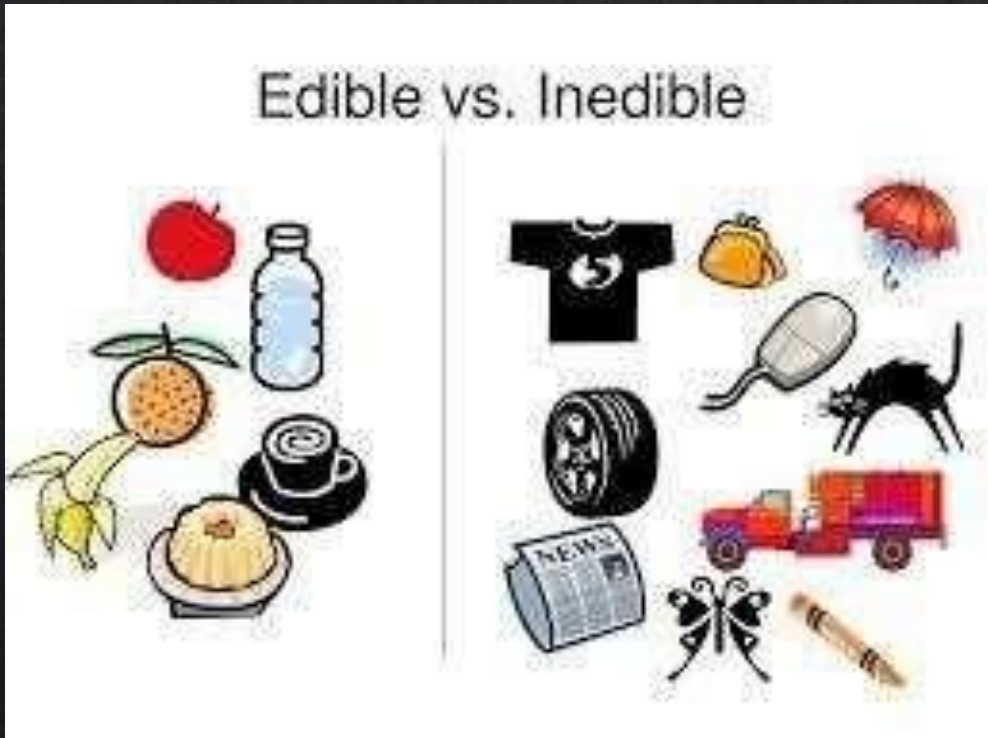


1.Edible :- Fit to be eaten. (जो चीज़ खाने योग्य हो)

Mnemonic :-Eatable



Eg:- My sisters's dinner was barely edible so I ordered takeout instead

2. Anarchist :- A person who believes that law and governments are not necessary. (अराजकता फैलाने वाला व्यक्ति)

Root Word :- an + archy

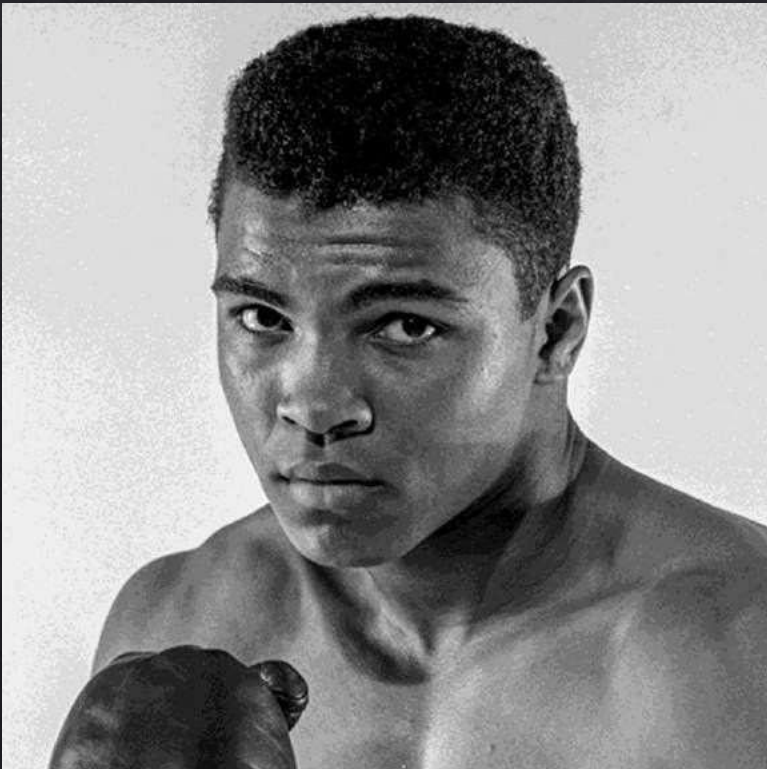
Eg:- After he was arrested on false charges he became an anarchist.

3. Apostate:- a person who renounces a religious or political belief or principle. (अपना धर्म त्यागने वाला)

Mnemonics:- agar apostate banoge to state chhodna padega

Eg:- Rajat became an apostate and stopped going to church after his wife was murdered.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

4.Misanthrope:- A person who hates and avoids other people. (मानव जाति से नफरत करनेवाला)

Mnemonics:- mis + anthrope.

Eg:- The old man was a misanthrope who surrounded his entire yard with barbed wire to keep his neighbors at bay.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

5.Mint:- A place where coins, medals, or tokens are made.
(जहाँ सरकारी सिक्के बनते हैं)

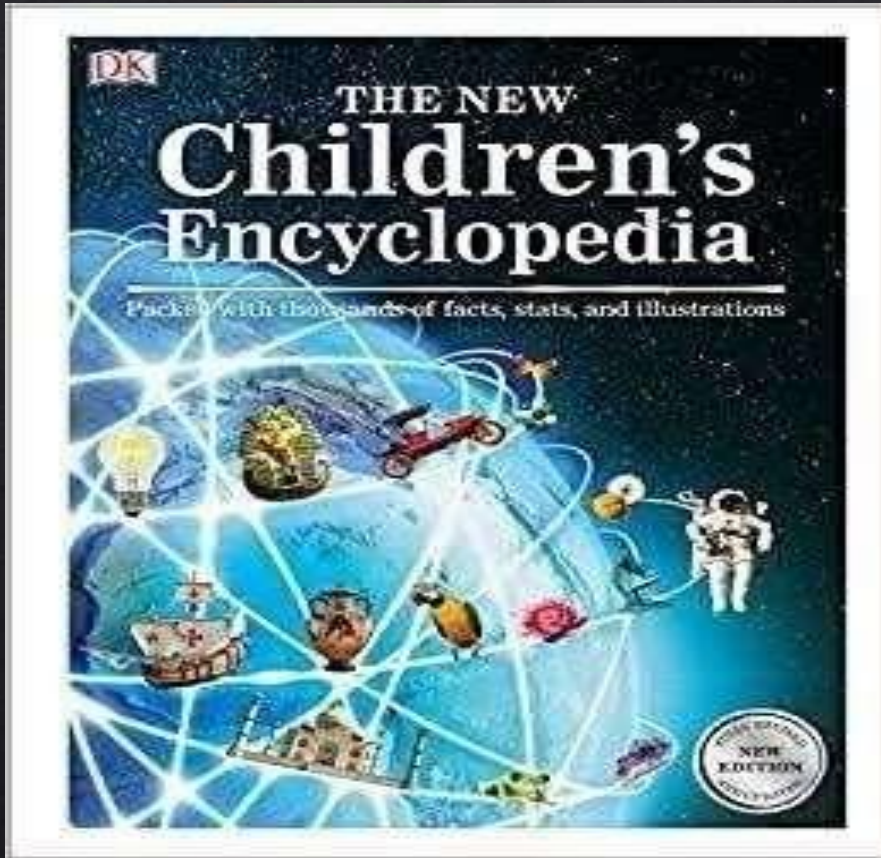

Eg:- No coins for the current year
have yet come from the mint.

6. Encyclopedia :- A book that contains information on various subjects. (ज्ञान का विशाल शब्दकोश)

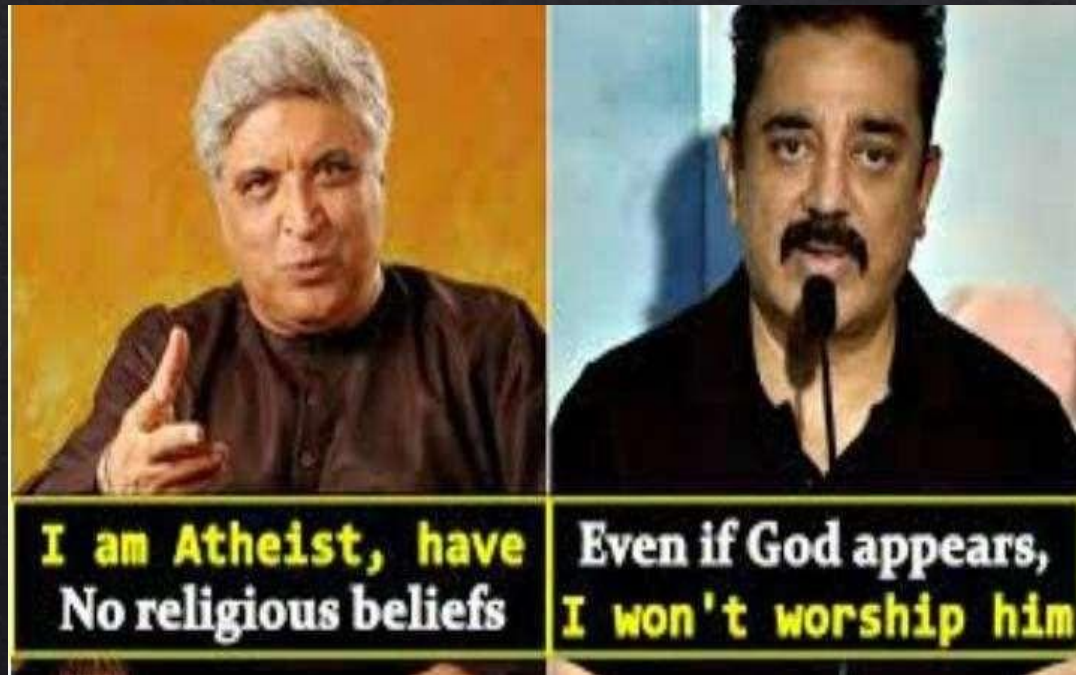
Eg:- The travelling salesman tried to convince the librarian to buy an encyclopedia set with hundreds of different topics inside.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

7. Atheist:- One who doesn't believe in God . (भगवान को न मानने वाला)

Root word :- a + theist

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- Because he is an atheist, he has no interest in marrying a church-going woman.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

8. Bonfire :- a large fire that is made outside to burn unwanted things, or for pleasure. (खुले में जलाई गई होली)

Eg:- After the football game, celebrating fans got together and built a massive outdoor bonfire using old boards to set the blaze.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

9.Casino:- A place for gambling. (जहाँ जुआ खेला जाता है)



AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Eg:- The casino was built so that people in the area would have a nice place to play poker and shoot craps for cash when in town.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

10.Monotonous:- Never changing and therefore boring.
(एक जैसा और उबाऊ काम)

Mnemonics:- mono + tune

Eg:- Everyone complains about the science teacher's uninteresting and monotonous lectures.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

11.Mammal:- any animal in which the female gives birth to babies, not eggs, and feeds them on milk from her own body.
(अपने बच्चे को दूध पिलानेवाला)



AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Eg:- Humans, dogs, elephants, and dolphins are all mammals, but birds, fish, and crocodiles are not.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

12. Alimony:- The money paid to the former wife, husband, or partner when the marriage is ended.
(तलाक के बाद मिलने वाला खर्च)

Mnemonic :- pati se alag hone par milne wali money **AMAN SIR ENGLISH**



Eg:- He is said to have paid \$300,000 alimony to his first wife.

13. Caravan:- a group of travelers, animals, or vehicles traveling together. (यात्रियों या गाड़ियों का काफिला)

Mnemonic :- cars ka kafila

Eg:- When the band tours, there is quite a caravan of vehicles that accompany them.

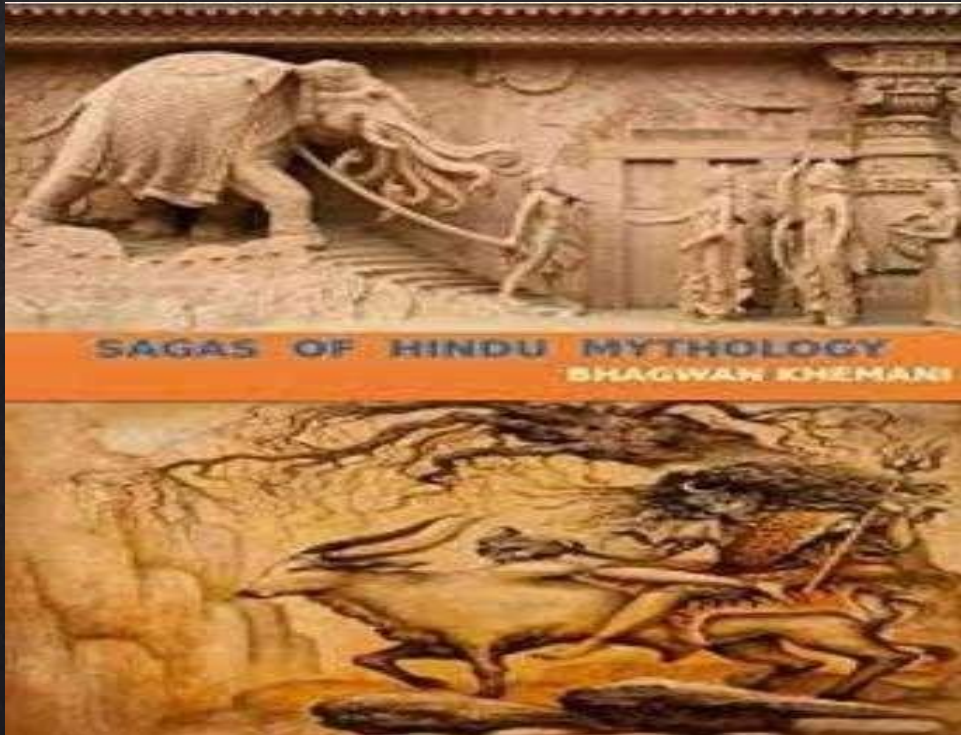

14.Saga:- a long story about past events over a long period of time. (वीरता की एक लंबी कहानी)

Mnemonic :- sadhu sunate saga

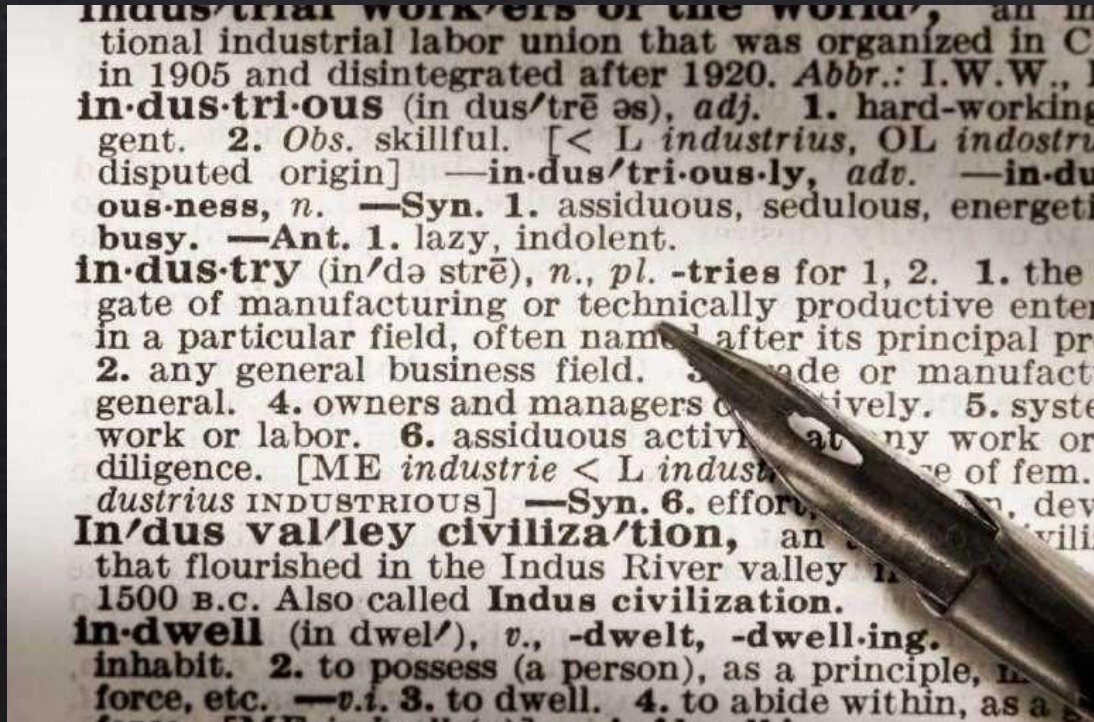
Eg:- The saga about the vampire family was spread into five separate novels.

15.lexicographer:- A person who compiles a dictionary.
(शब्दकोश बनाने या लिखने वाला)

Root word - lexicon(wordbook) + grapher(to write)

Eg:- A lexicographer
worked as a teacher
there for some time.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

16. Shoal:- A large number of fish swimming together.
(मछलियों का एक बड़ा झुंड)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- Getting lost from the shoal can be dangerous for fish since they are protected in groups.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

17.Nostalgia :- a feeling of pleasure and also slight sadness when you think about things that happened in the past:

(पुरानी यादों की मीठी चाहत)

Mnemonic :- hostel me jo time vitaaya

Eg:- If my brother sees the family pictures and videos, nostalgia may help him regain his memory.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

18. Conspiracy:- A secret plan, made to do something (usually wrong) (किसी के खिलाफ गुप्त साजिश)

Mnemonic :- cons + piracy

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- The Army suspects the bomb blasts to be the conspiracy of ISI.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

19.Procrastinate :- To put off doing something, especially outof habitual carelessness or laziness. (आज का काम कल टालना)

Mnemonic :- parso ka bolkar teen din late

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- The counselor urged the students to not procrastinate in filling out their college applications.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

20.Samaritan :- A person who gives help and sympathy to people who need it. (मुसीबत में मदद करने वाला)

Mnemonic :- samaj ki bhalai ke liye jatan

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- I'd left my bag in the reception and a good Samaritan came running down the street to give it to me.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

21. Fastidious:- one who is hard to please.

(जिसे खुश करना बहुत मुश्किल हो)

Mnemonic :- uski fastidious girlfriend ne fast to Rakha hai

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- Arrogant and fastidious, the Diva made no friends on her music tour.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

22. Cartographer:- someone who makes or draws map
(मानचित्र या नक्शा बनाने वाला)



AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Eg:- With the assistance of a cartographer, the detectives were able to pinpoint the location of the cave on the map.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

23. Amphibian:- Animal that lives both on land and water
(जल और थल दोनों का जीव)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- Frogs are amphibian animals that can swim in the water and walk on land, and breathe in both scenarios.

24.Relic:- Something belonging to or surviving from an earlier period (प्राचीन काल का पवित्र अवशेष)

Mnemonic :- raja maharaja ke time ka

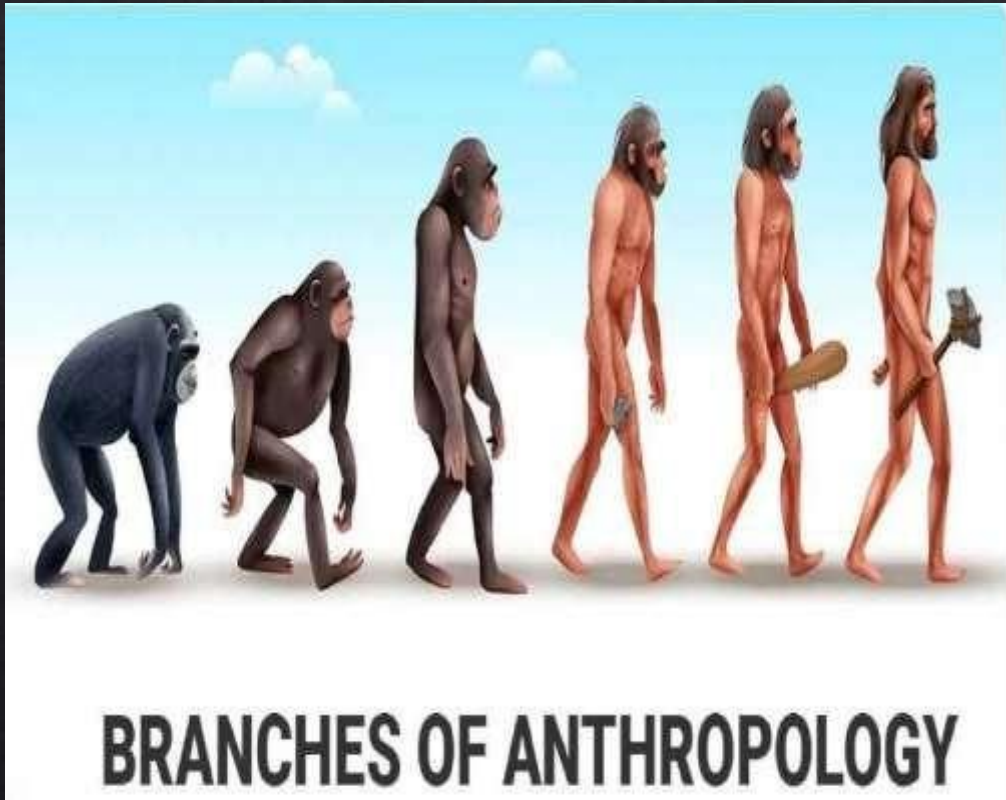

Eg:- They are the last relics of what is now a completely forgotten civilization.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

25. Anthropology:- The study of evolution of mankind.
(मानव विकास का वैज्ञानिक अध्ययन)

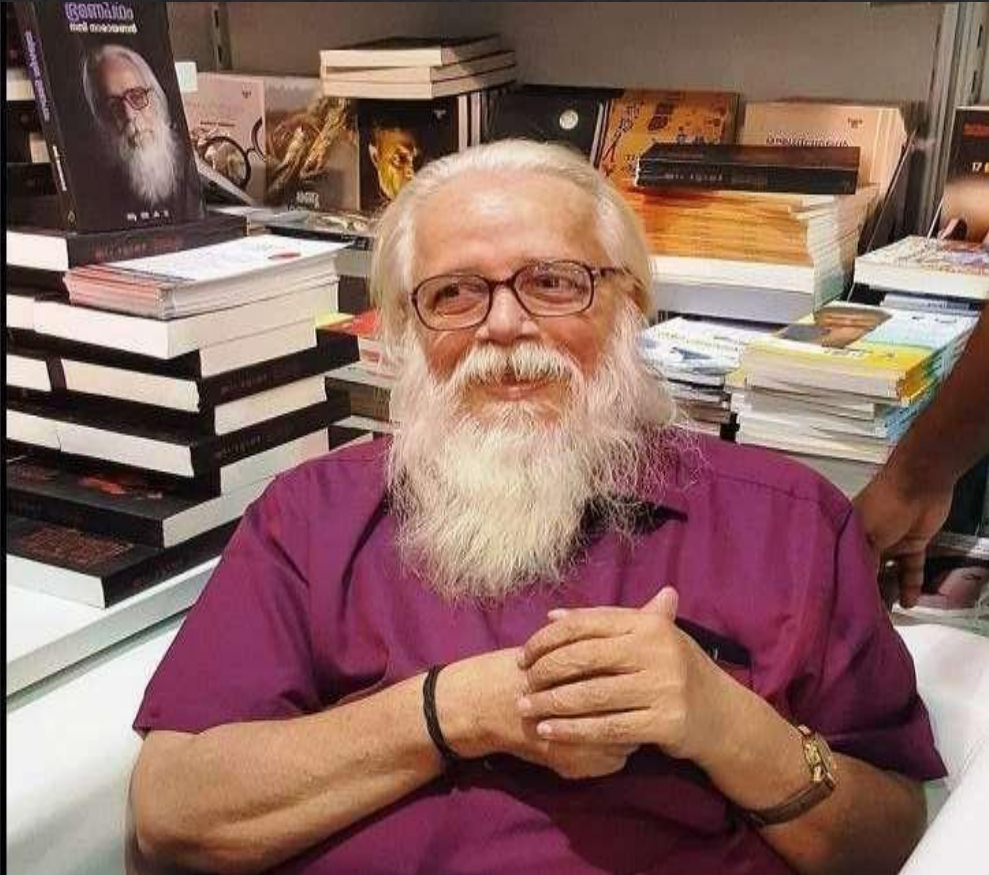


AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Eg:- In addition to reviewing cultures, the field of anthropology also examines the societal and physical attributes that comprise communities.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

26.Firm:- not soft but not completely hard. (मज़बूत इरादा या कोई कंपनी)



AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Eg:- The firm steel-rod could not be broken except under intense pressure.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

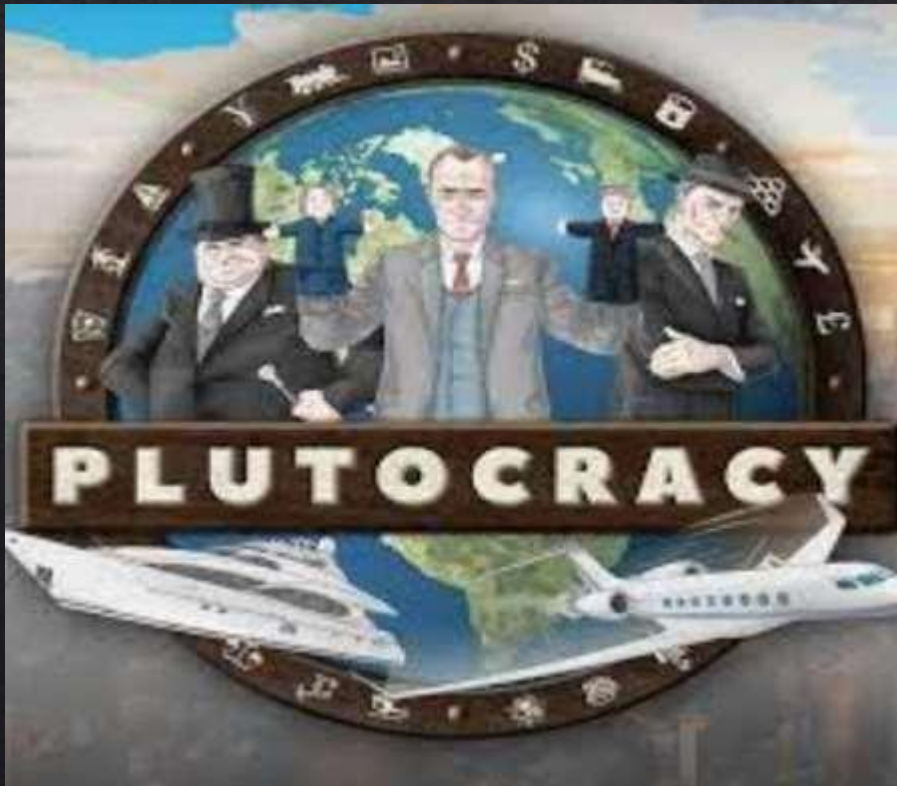
27.Orphan:- One who has lost one's parents.
(जिसके माता-पिता न हों, अनाथ)



Eg:- It was difficult for the couple to go to the orphanage to adopt an orphan because all of the boys and girls wanted parents.

28.Plutocracy :- Government governed by wealth.
(अमीर लोगों का सरकारी शासन)

Eg:- This auspicious plutocracy helped to establish the first roadways in the area inaugurated in 1882.

29. Plagiarism:- Copying someone else's work and trying to submit it as your own (दूसरे के विचारों की चोरी)

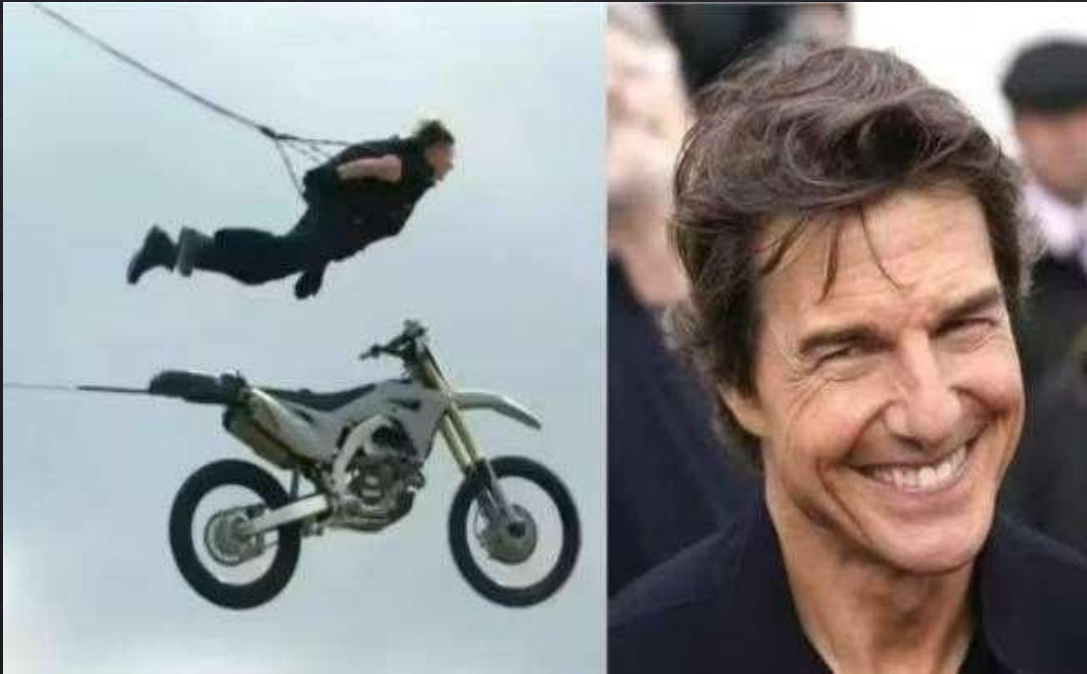
Mnemonic :- play karte hi pata chal raha tune plagiarism Karli hai

Ex:- Students are deemed guilty of plagiarism when they claim to be the author of somebody else's work.

30.Daredevil:-A person who enjoys doing dangerous things, in a way that other people may think is stupid. (बेखौफ जोखिम उठाने वाला व्यक्ति)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- The actor performed his own daredevil stunts in the action movie.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

31. Waif :- Forsaken or neglected child who has no home and spends most of his/her time on the streets.
(बेघर और लावारिस छोटा बच्चा)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Eg:- After noticing the female waif begging for food on the streets, it became apparent to the tourists that it had been a long time since she had a proper meal.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



32.Convalescence:- Gradual recovery of health and strength.

(बीमारी के बाद सुधार का समय)

Mnemonic :- colonel well ho raha hai sense vapas aa rahi hai

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- The first step towards his convalescence is a reduction in the amount of stimulant or alcohol.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

33.Aviary :- A place where birds are kept. (पक्षियों को रखने का स्थान)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

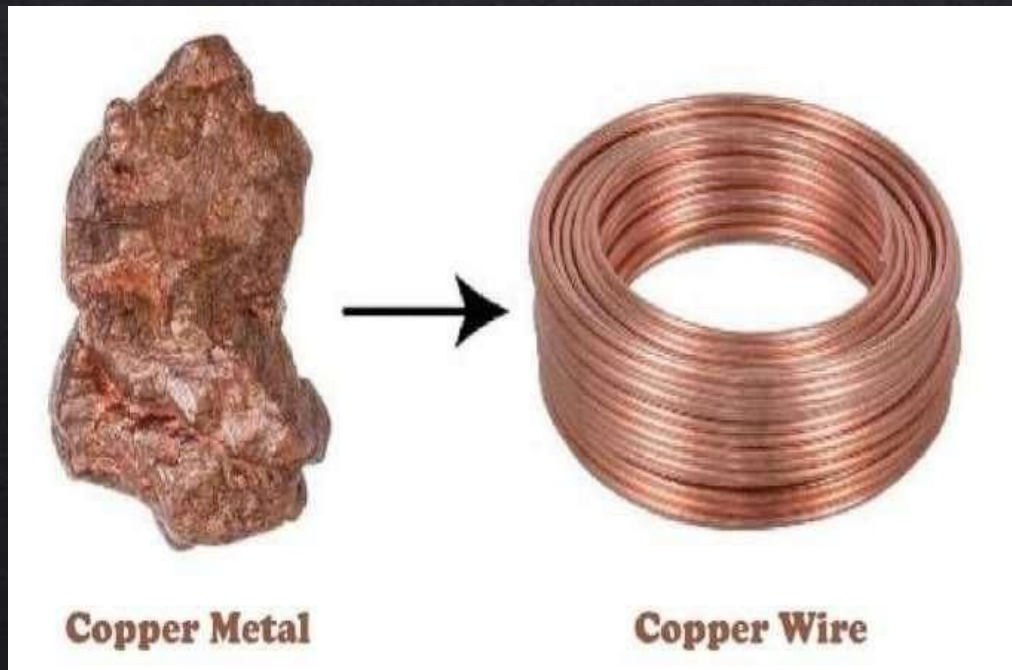


Eg:- Keeping different types of birds in one aviary requires knowledge of both habitats and needs.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

34.Ductile:- capable of being bent or pulled into different shapes. (जिसे खींचकर तार बनाया जा सके)

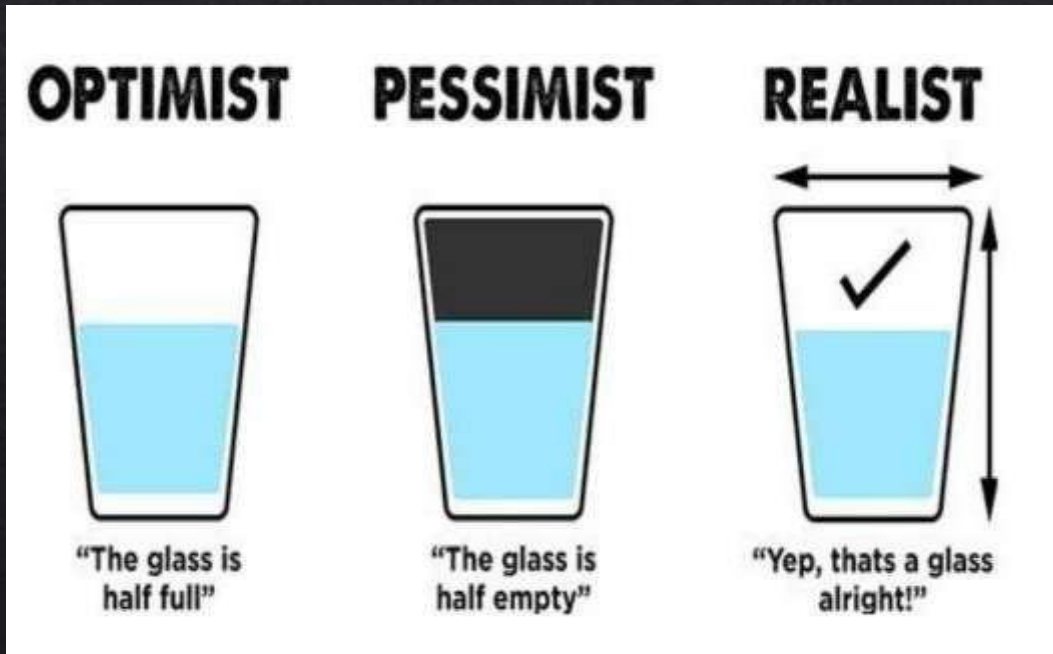

Eg:- Copper is often used to make wire because it is ductile and bends easily but doesn't break.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

35. Pessimist:- One who looks at the negative side of everything. (निराशावादी सोच रखने वाला व्यक्ति)

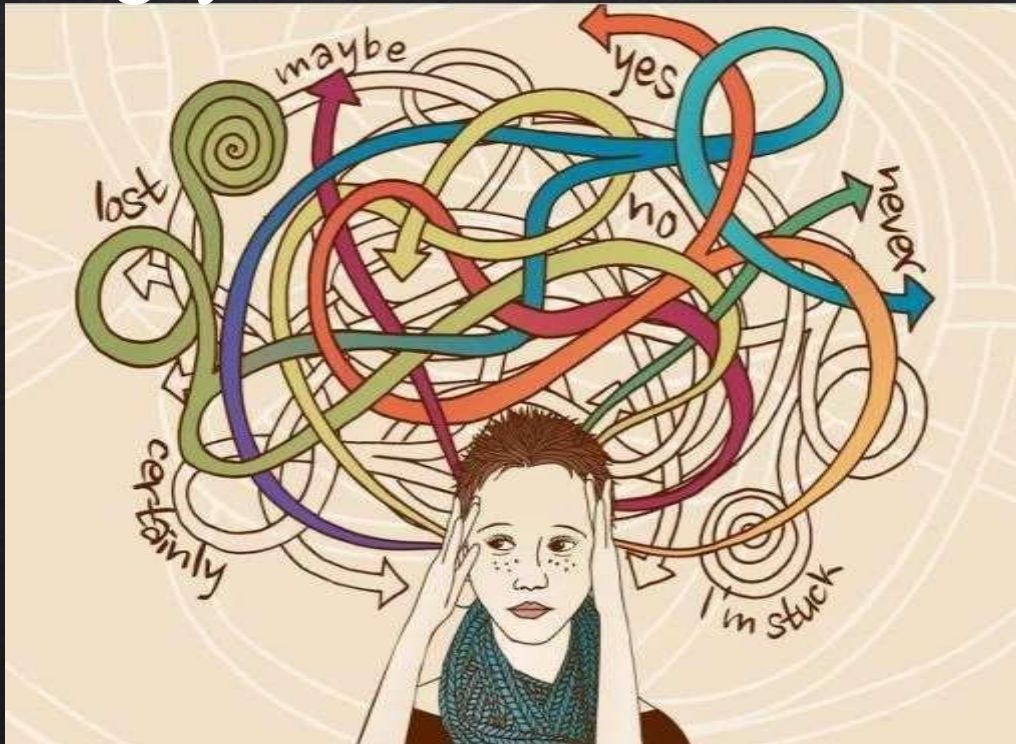


Eg:- Because Heena has a pessimistic attitude, she never believes anything good will happen to her.

36. Vacillate:- Waver between different opinions or actions (निर्णय लेने में हिचकिचाना)

Mnemonic :- tere car ya bus mein vacillate ki bajah se bese hi late ho gaya

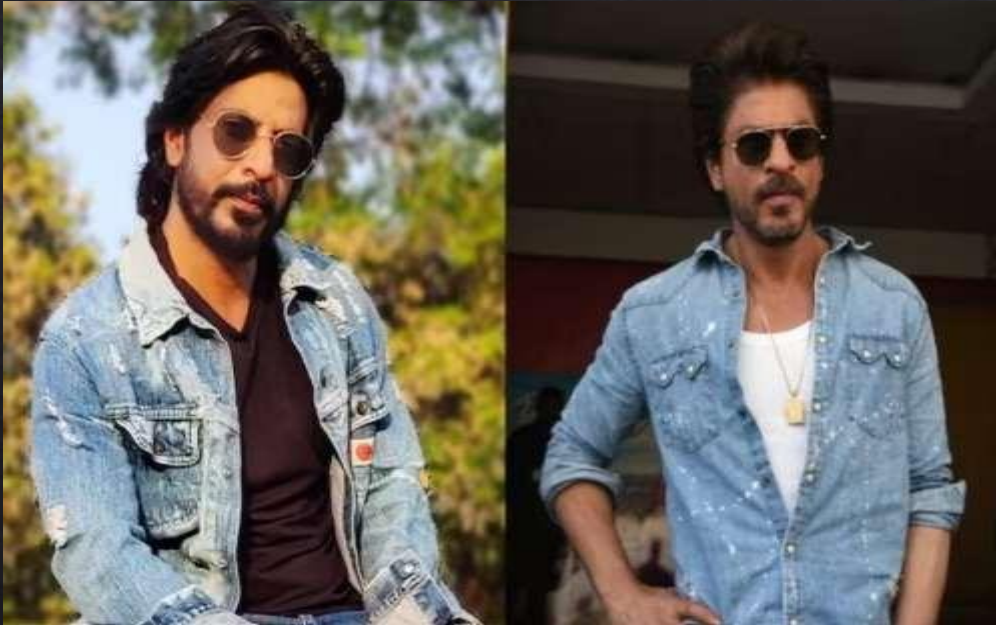
Eg:- It is common for people to vacillate when it comes to choosing lottery numbers.

37. Imposter:- One who pretends to be somebody else.
(भेष बदलकर धोखा देने वाला)

Mnemonic :- I am on this this poster

Eg:- Gajju is an imposter who deceives others by claiming to be one of their relatives.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

38. Assassin:- A person who kills somebody, especially for political reasons. (राजनीतिक कारणों से हत्या करनेवाला)

Eg:- She hired an assassin to eliminate her rival.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

39.Congregation:- A group of worshippers (धार्मिक सभा में जुटे लोग)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- The congregation had no place to worship after their church was burned to the ground.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

40.Domicile:- The place that a person treats as his permanent home, or lives in and has a substantial connection with. (स्थायी निवास का कानूनी घर)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

41.Granary:- A storehouse for threshed grain.
(अनाज रखने का बड़ा गोदाम)

Eg:- The truck driver was sent to the local granary to pick up several pounds of wheat from the storeroom.

42.Slouch:- to stand, sit, or walk with the shoulders hanging forward and the head bent slightly over so that you look tired and bored: (झुककर बैठने या चलने वाला)

Mnemonic :- don't slouch on the couch

Eg:- Be aware of your body language, do not slouch in the chair.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

43.Deaf:- One who cannot hear. (जिसे सुनाई न दे, बहरा)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- She is deaf, but refuses to let her disability prevent her from doing what she wants to do.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

44. Malevolent:- Causing or wanting to cause harm or evil to someone. (दूसरों का बुरा चाहने वाला)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- I can't believe she dated him for so long without discovering his cruel, malevolent nature.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

45.Fatal:- Causing or ending in death. (जानलेवा या घातक साबित होना)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- The police are investigating a fatal car crash that occurred last night.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

46.Fatalist:- One who believes in fate. (भाग्य के भरोसे रहने वाला)



AMAN SIR ENGLISH

Eg:- The fatalist was not upset when she was fired because she believed all situations are predetermined by God.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

47.Pact:-A formal agreement between two or more nations or persons. (दो पक्षों के बीच समझौता)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

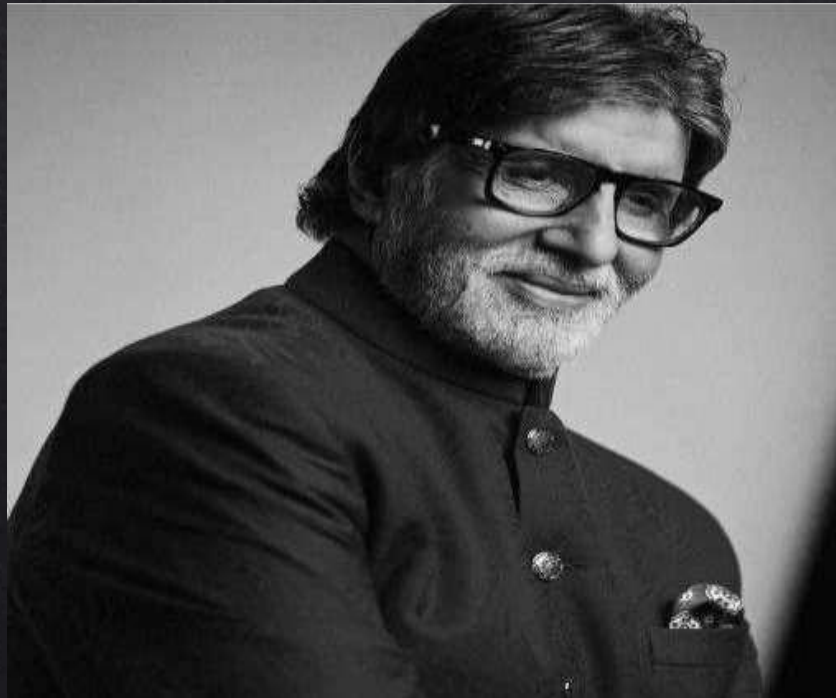


Eg:- He made a pact with her daughter that she would call every night while away on her business trip

48. Septuagenarian:- A person whose age is between 70 and 79 years. (70 से 79 वर्ष का व्यक्ति)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- It is a great relief when you are a septuagenarian and have retired.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

49. Adventurous:-Willing to take risks and try new ideas.
(साहस और जोखिम से भरा)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- Exploring dark caves in his spare time, the adventurous risk-taker enjoyed a good quest.

50.Shuttle:- A shuttle is a plane, bus, or train which makes frequent journeys between two places. (दो जगहों के बीच आवागमन)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- A shuttle runs between the city center and the theme park.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

51. Philanthropist:- One who loves mankind. (परोपकार करने वाला व्यक्ति)

Eg:- The money was left by a philanthropist to build a hospital ward.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

52.Bark:- Outer protective layer of a tree. (पेड़ की छाल)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- The sparrow sat on the bark of the tree.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

53.Lexicography:- The practice of writing dictionaries.
(शब्दकोश लिखने की कला)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- The early nineteenth century saw a dramatic rise in the lexicography of music analysis.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

54.Decoding:- Changing secret and coded messages in a readable form. (गुप्त भाषा को सामान्य बनाना)

Eg:- Decoding the paintings is not difficult once you know what the component parts symbolize.

55.Snug:- (of a person) feeling warm, comfortable, and protected, or (of a place, especially a small place) giving feelings of warmth, comfort, and protection: (आरामदायक और गर्म जगह)

Mnemonic :- comfortable like a hug

Eg:- We curled up in bed, all snug and warm, and listened to the storm outside.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

56. Magnanimous:- kind, generous and forgiving (especially towards an enemy or a competitor that you have beaten)
(बहुत बड़े और उदार दिलवाला)

Root word - magnus(big)- animus(soul)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



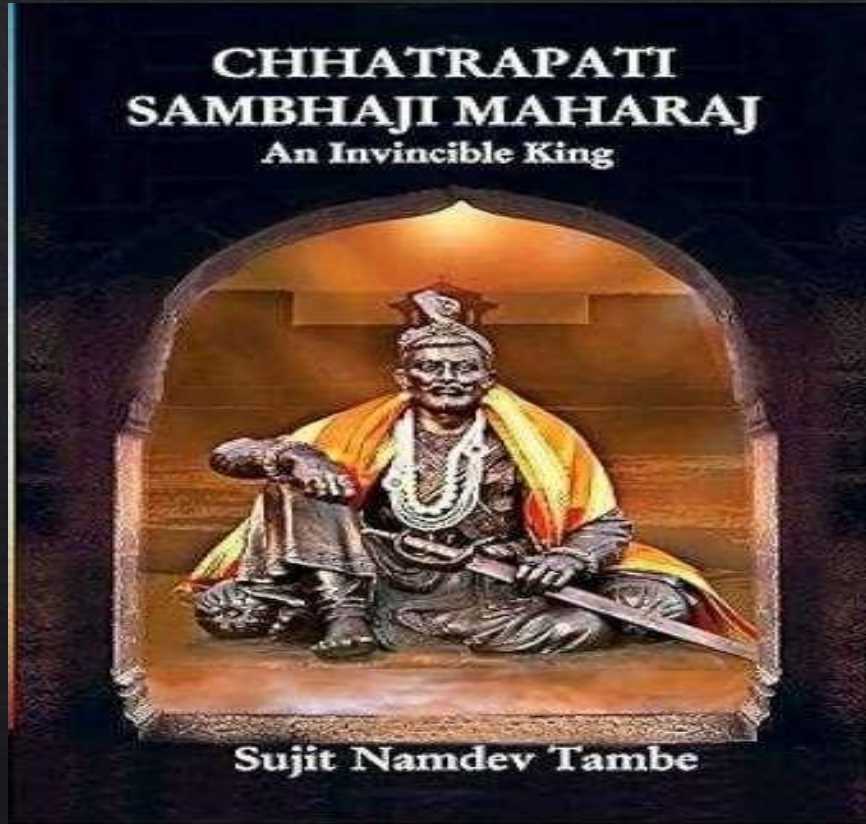
Eg:- Despite the slurs made against him by his opponent, the boxer was magnanimous enough to praise his competitor.

57. Invincible:- that can not be defeated or changed.

(जिसे जीता न जा सके)

Mnemonic :- in (not) + win + able

Eg:- The team proved it was not invincible when it lost the last game of the season.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

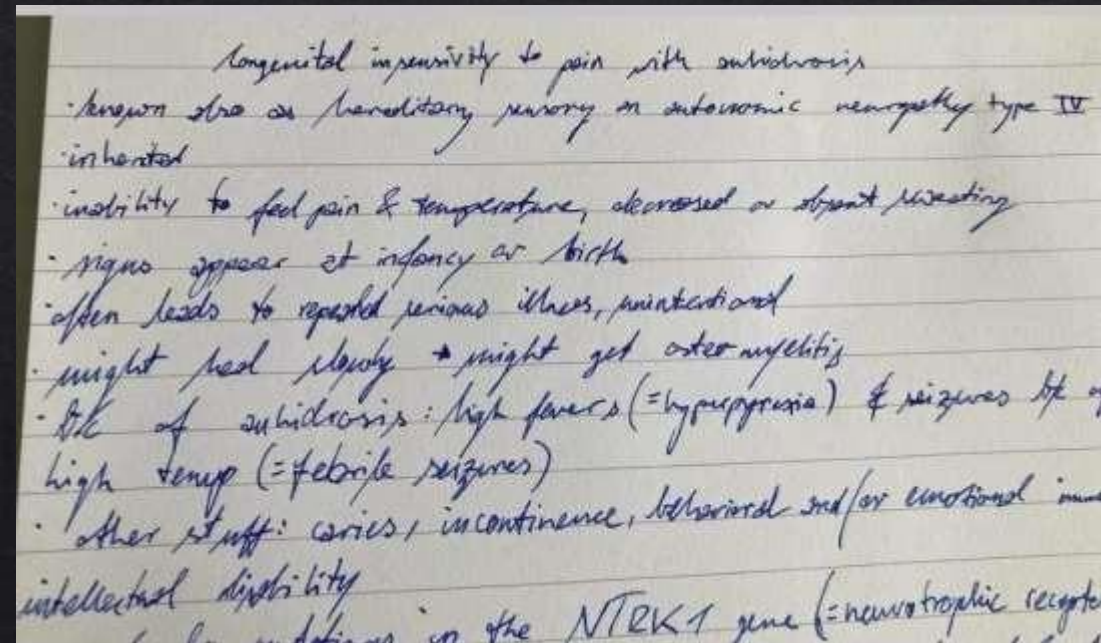
58. Illegible:- Which cannot be read. (जो पढ़ा न जा सके)

Mnemonic :- tumhari hand writing illegible hai isliye you are not eligible for this post.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

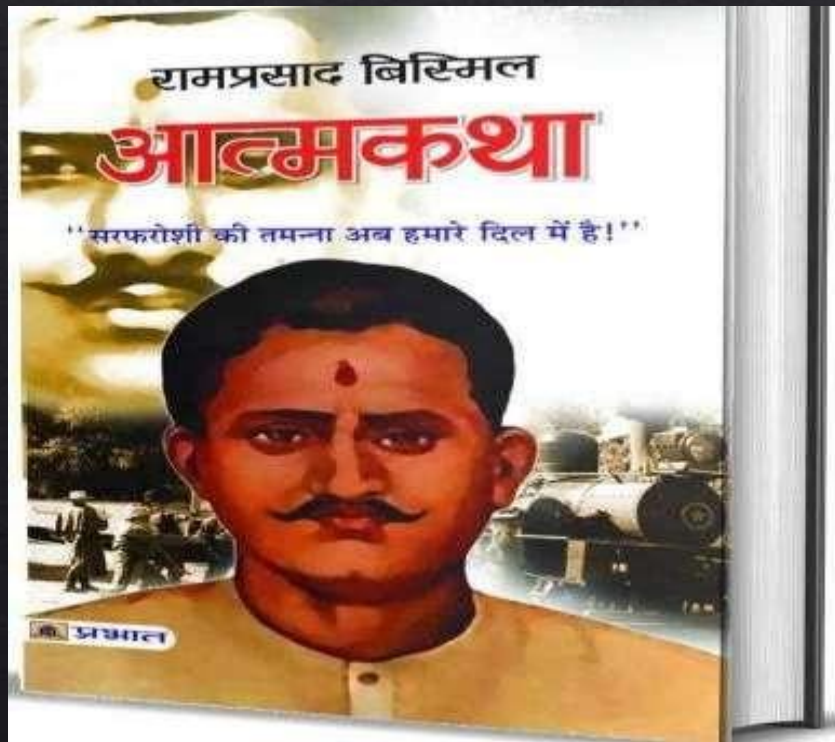
Eg:- The cashier refused to cash my check because she could not understand the check writer's illegible signature

59. Autobiography:- Life history written by oneself.
(खुद की लिखी जीवन कथा)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- He gives a vivid description of his childhood in his autobiography.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

60.Genocide:-The murder of a large number of people from a particular nation or ethnic group. (किसी जाति का सामूहिक संहार)

Root word :- genos(race) + cide(killing)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- Armed troops are being sent to end the dictator's genocide that has resulted in the deaths of over twenty thousand people.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

61. Wreath:- an arrangement of flowers and leaves in a circular shape, used as a decoration or as a sign of respect and remembrance for a person who has died. (फूलों का गोल हार/चक्र)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- Many front doors feature a wreath to welcome visitors.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

62. Teetotaller:- one who does not drink alcohol (नशे से दूर रहने वाला)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- Babulal is recently become a strict teetotaler.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

63.Hangar:- a place where aircraft are kept when not in use.
(विमान रखने का बड़ा घर)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- Because the hangar was damaged during the storm, we had to place the airplane in a local barn.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

64.Cemetery:- a graveyard where dead bodies are buried.
(शवों को दफनाने का कब्रिस्तान)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- When planning for her funeral, the dying woman chose the perfect cemetery plot to be buried beneath.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

65. Cosmopolitan:- Someone who regards the world as his country. (पूरी दुनिया को अपना माननेवाला)

Eg:- I love big cities and the rootless cosmopolitan culture that comes with them.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

66.Oblivious:- Not informed about or aware of something
(आसपास से बिल्कुल बेखबर होना)

AMAN SIR ENGLISH



Eg:- His eyes were closed and he was completely oblivious to what was happening around him.

AMAN SIR ENGLISH

67.Hysterical:- unable to control your feelings or behaviour because you are extremely frightened, angry, excited, etc.

(भावुक होकर बेकाबू होना)

Eg:- She became hysterical when she heard the news.
