Word-Ami Meaning – Friend

Amity - Friendly Relation (देशों के बीच मित्रवत संबंध)

Eg:- Amity among people is necessary to build a healthy society.

Amiable- Friendly (मिलनसार और प्यारा स्वभाव वाला)

Eg:- Roshan is the most amiable person I have ever met in my life.

Amicable - Friendly & Cooperative (शांतिपूर्ण और दोस्ताना समझौता)

Eg:- In spite of their disagreement they parted on amicable terms

Word-Ami Meaning - Friend

Amicide- Ami+cide [Cide - means Killing, Killing of friend or killer of friend (अपने ही दोस्त की हत्या)]

Eg:- Ramesh is in jail for the amicide he committed in 2005.

Amicus Curiae - Friend of Court /[Curiae means court]

(अदालत की मदद करने वाला)

Eg:- Parliament is amicus curiae of Indian supreme court.

Word - Ambi Meaning - Both side/Both

Ambidextrous — Ambi (both) + Dexterous (skillful) - Who can use both of his limbs at one time. (दोनों हाथों से काम करनेवाला)

Eg:- Boman Irani in the movie 'Three Idiots' was ambidextrous.

Ambiguous - Ambi shows both sense , 'Doubtful' uncertain, unclear.
(दो अर्थों वाला या अस्पष्ट)

Eg:- Rahul asked for help in such an ambiguous way that nobody helped him.

Word - Ambi Meaning - Both side/Both

Ambiguity - Uncertain, unclear and unclear situation (बात में स्पष्टता की कमी)

Eg:- Ambiguity was the main reason behind the situation occurred in office.

Introvert - intro+vert (turned inside Vert - someone who is shy, quiet, and prefers to spend time alone rather than often being with other people . (कम बोलने वाला अंतर्मुखी व्यक्ति)

Eg:- Aadarsh behaves like an introvert when we ask for for some help.

Word - Ambi Meaning - Both side/Both

Extrovert- (extro + vert) - an energetic person who enjoys being with other people: (मिलनसार और बाहरमुखी व्यक्ति)

Eg:- You have to be pretty extrovert and confident to do this job.

Ambivert (ambi + vert)- someone that possesses both extroverted and introverted qualities. (दोनों तरह के स्वभाव वाला)

Eg:- Jumman is an ambivert who likes to go to parties but also enjoys having his alone time.

Word - Ambi Meaning - Both side/Both

Ambilateral – (Ambi + lateral = Both Sides)- relating to or affecting both sides. (दोनों पक्षों से संबंधित चीज़)

Eg- The meeting of the leaders of the two countries has ambilateral effects on tourism.

Word – Acer Meaning - Bitter/ harsh (Acrid - Bitter / harsh)

Acrid - unpleasant / bitter- acrid smoke / taste. (तीखी और कड़वी गंध वाला)

Eg:-The pizza we bought from pizza hut was acrid in taste.

Acrimony - Bitterness/harshness /Acrimony in Behaviour.

(रिश्तों में कड़वाहट या खटास)

Eg:- Rajesh will show you acrimony whenever you will ask him for money.

Word – Acer Meaning - Bitter/ harsh (Acri - Bitter / harsh)

Acrimonious - bitter/harsh (six hair) Acrimonious behavior.
(बहुत कड़वाहट से भरा हुआ)

Eg:- His behaviour was acrimonious towards us because we did not help him.

Exacerbate - ex (beyond)+ acer(harsh) + bate- to make something worse, especially a disease or problem. (किसी बुरी स्थिति को बिगाड़ना)

Eg:- Sandy exacerbated the situation by abusing the security guard.

Word – Acer Meaning - Bitter/ harsh (Acri - Bitter / harsh)

Acerbic – (i) bitter / harsh (ii) Sour
(बोलने में तीखा या कड़वा)

Ex- 1. Acerbic Comments.

2. Acerbic Lemon Juice.

Acerbity - bitterness/harshness +ity - roughness or harshness, as in language or temperament. (स्वभाव या वाणी की कड़वाहट)

Eg:- Acerbity in your views was the main reason behind your rejection.

Word - (Sophos) Meaning - wisdom

Sophic - full of wisdom; Intellectual. (बहुत ही बुद्धिमान या ज्ञानी)

Eg:- The lectures of Aman sir are always sophic.

Sophical - related to wisdom. (बुद्धि और ज्ञान से संबंधित)

Eg:- Sophical conversation is the key to get ideas which can help us in bad situations.

Philosopher - Philosopher one who loves wisdom. (जीवन के सत्य खोजने वाला)

Eg:- Swami Vivekanand is a very famous philosopher of India.

Word - (Sophos) Meaning - wisdom

Sophisticated - worldly wise. (सुलझा हुआ और बहुत आधुनिक)

Eg:-The environment is very sophisticated in our office.

Un-sophisticated- Not Worldly wise. (बिल्कुल सीधा-साधा या साधारण)

Eg: The environment in my college was unsophisticated because of the bad staff.

Word - Arch Meaning- Ruler Archy - Rule/government

Panarchy- Pan(all)+ archy(gov)- A government by all
(हर किसी का शासन होना)

Eg:-Everybody wants panarchy in their country.

Anarchy – An (not) + Archy(gov) - A state without government.
(देश में कोई शासन न होना)

Eg:- One of the responsibilities of the police is to preserve order so that anarchy will not come into play.

Biarchy – Bi (two)+archy (gov) Government by two people.
(दो लोगों द्वारा किया शासन)

Word - Arch Meaning- Ruler Archy - Rule/government

Monarch - mono+arch - A single/ruler/king (किसी देश का राजा या सम्राट)

Monarchy - A system by a single king (राजा का शासन या राजतंत्र)

Eg:- In ancient times monarchy system was in tradition in India.

Matriarch - A female ruler (specially by mother in a family)

(घर की मुखिया कोई महिला)

Eg:- Aarohi is like a matriarch for her family after death of her husband.

Word - Arch Meaning- Ruler Archy - Rule/government

Matriarchy - rule/system by female head specially by mother in a family. (महिलाओं का शासन या समाज)

Eg:- Matriarchy should also be introduced in Indian society as it will help the society to grow.

Patriarch - a male ruler specially by Father in a family.
(घर का मुखिया कोई पुरुष)

Eg:- Kim Jong-Un is a patriarch of North

Word - Gamy Meaning - Marriage

Polygamy - Poly (More than one) + gamy (Marriage) - A custom of more than one marriage. (एक से अधिक पत्नियाँ रखना)

Eg:- In hindu culture polygamy is not allowed.

Polygamist - Poly + gamist - one who does many marriages.
(बहु-विवाह करने वाला व्यक्ति)

Eg:- Harshit is a polygamist as he has two wives.

Bigamy - Bi + gamy - A custom of two marriages.
(दो शादी करने का अपराध)

Eg:- Bigamy is considered a crime in Indian society.

Word - Specto Meaning - to look / Examine

Spectacular – Awesome. (बहुत ही शानदार और भव्य)

Eg:- The spectacular fireworks display drew thunderous applause from the audience.

Introspect - Intro(inside) + Spect (to look) [to examine]- self analysis
(खुद के विचारों को परखना)

Eg:- We should introspect ourselves for our doings.

Word - Specto Meaning - to look / Examine

Extrospect - Extro (outside) + Spect (to look) – examination or observation of what is outside oneself. (बाहरी दुनिया का अवलोकन करना)

Eg: Don't be a introvert everyone extrospect themselves.

Retrospect- Retro (back) + spect- to look back.
(बीती हुई बातों पर सोचना)

Eg:-I was doing retrospection when you called me.

Word - Specto Meaning - to look / Examine

Circumspect - cirum (R/Around) + spect (To look) - to look around.
(सावधान और चौकन्ना रहने वाला)

Eg:- In this day and age, you need to be circumspect about giving out too much personal information on the internet.

Word - Male/melli/mol/molly Meaning - Soft

Mollycoddle - Molly (Soft) + Coddle (to protect / to care)- to show excessive love. (किसी को बहुत ज्यादा लाड़-प्यार)

Eg:- Every mother treats her child in a mollycoddle way.

Mollify - to appease someone. (किसी के गुस्से को शांत करना)

Eg:- Ramesh is upset right now, I need to mollify him.

Emollient - Softening agent like a cream. (त्वचा को नरम करने वाली क्रीम)

Eg:- You should apply an emollient on your hand to reduce the pain.

Word - Male/melli/mol/molly Meaning - Soft

Mellifluous- Melli (Soft) + fluous (flow)- Pleasant.

(कानों को प्यारी शहद-जैसी आवाज़)

Eg:- Shreya Ghoshal has a very mellifluous voice.

Molten – melt. (गर्मी से पिघला हुआ पदार्थ)

Eg:- The moulds were filled with molten gold to make gold biscuits.

Melodious - Soft music. (सुरों से भरा और मधुर)

Eg:- I am a die hard fan of Arijit Singh and his melodious voice.

Word - Male/melli/mol/molly Meaning - Soft

Mellow - ripe fruits. (पके फल)

Eg:-I asked my uncle to bring some mellow mangoes as I like mangoes very much.

Ameliorate – to make something better or more manageable.
(किसी खराब स्थिति को सुधारना)

Eg:- Scientists are trying to ameliorate the texture of the new face wash.

Word - Necro: death / Dead body

Necrophile - Lover of dead body. (शवों के प्रति आकर्षण वाला)

Eg:-Vultures are the real necrophiles of the forest.

Necromania - Mania for dead bodies.

(मौत या लाशों का पागलपन)

Eg:- Sunil is suffering from necromania.

Necromaniac- (necro+mania) A person who suffers from Necromania.

(लाशों का जुनून रखने वाला)

Eg: The mental hospital of Agra is full of necromaniacs.

Word - Necro: death / Dead body

Necrophobia - (Necrophobia)-Phobia of dead bodies. (लाश या मृत्यु से डर)

Eg:- Anita was not going near the dead body because she has necrophobia.

Necrophobic - A person who suffers from necrophobia (necrophobia)
(शवों से डरने वाला व्यक्ति)

Eg:- Sandeep is not allowed in mortuary because he is a necrophobic.

Word - Necro: death / Dead body

Necropolis - Necro (Dead body) + polis (city) - A big area like a city where dead bodies are buried. (बहुत बड़ा और पुराना कब्रिस्तान)

Eg:- The dead bodies of soldiers after world war 2nd were taken to necropolis to burry.

Necromancer - one who talks to spirit of dead bodies (मरे हुएओं से बात करने वाला)

Eg:- Ganesh went to a necromancer to solve the issues related to his haunted house.

Word - Necro: death / Dead body

Necromancy - The practice of talking to spirit of dead bodies.
(काले जादू से लाश जगाना)

Eg:- Farhan is a master of necromancy.

Word-Acro Meaning-height

Acrophobia - Fear of height. (ऊंचाई से लगने वाला डर)

Eg:-I will not climb the tower because I have acrophobia.

Acrobat - A high walker. (हवा में करतब दिखाने वाला)

Eg:- Neeraj is a fantastic acrobat, he can climb the heights.

Acrophyte -A plant growing at a high altitude. (ऊंचाई पर उगने वाले पौधे)

Eg:- Acrophytes are growing very fast in the mountains and we need to control it.

Word-Acro Meaning-height

Acropolis - A city at a high altitude. (पहाड़ी पर बना सुरक्षित शहर)

Eg:- The cities that are at high altitude are called acropolis.

Word - Mal/(Bad)/ Evil

Maladroit Mal (bad) + Adroit (skilful) – Inexpert. (काम करने में बहुत अनाड़ी)

Eg:- We need skilful people here we don't want to ruin our company by hiring maladroits.

Malady - disease which is bad. (कोई गंभीर बीमारी या रोग)

Eg:- Cancer is considered to be the worst malady now a days.

Word - Mal/(Bad)/ Evil

Malicious - having bad feelings. (दूसरों का बुरा चाहने वाला)

Eg:- One should not have malicious feelings for one's other half after break up.

Malcontent - Mal + Content – discontent.

Eg:- A person who is not satisfied with a situation and who complains about it, or causes trouble in order to change it is consider to be a malcontent.

Word - Mal/(Bad)/ Evil

Malediction - mal + diction - curse (bad words). (किसी को दिया गया श्राप)

Eg:- One should avoid malediction while having a heated argument with someone.

Malefaction - an evil deed. (कोई बहुत बुरा या गलत काम)

Eg: He is getting punishment for his malefactions.

Word - Mal/(Bad)/ Evil

Malefactor - evil doer. (अपराध करने वाला बुरा व्यक्ति)

Eg:- We do not want to take a malefactor in our team because we want to complete the work on time.

Malpractice - Bad practice. (काम में लापरवाही या बेईमानी)

Eg:- SSC is trying to stop malpractices in exam but I don't think it's going to happen.

Word - Mal/(Bad)/ Evil

Malevolence - Ill-feeling/ill-will. (मन में भरी गहरी बुराई)

Eg:- The reason Rajesh attacked Sunil was the malevolence of Rajesh.

Word - Mor/mori - Death/die.

Mortal - those who will die. (जिसकी मृत्यु होना निश्चित हो)

Eg:-One should always remember that man is mortal.

Immortal -who can't die. (जो अमर हो, कभी न मरे)

Eg:- Some people waste their time as they are immortals and they have all the time to do things later.

Mortify - to cause someone to feel embarrassed.
(अत्यधिक शर्मिंदा या अपमानित करना)

Eg:- Sakshi left the job after she was mortified by her boss.

Word - Mor/mori - Death/die.

Moribund - dying stage. (बिल्कुल अंत के करीब या मरणासन्न)

Eg:- My company will have to face moribund effects because of the new policies of government.

Morbid - Related to death. (मौत जैसी डरावनी चीज़ों में रुचि)

Eg:-The trip was made all the worst by Rahul's morbid fear of flying.

Morting – killing. (मृत्यु से संबंधित कोई क्रिया)

Eg:-Lion in the jungle lives by morting other animals.

Word - Mor/mori - Death/die.

Morose - ill-tempered/sullen. (बहुत ही उदास और चिड़चिड़ा)

Eg:- Dhanush seems very morose and gloomy.

Mortuary/ Morgue- A place where dead bodies are kept for examining them. (शवों को रखने का स्थान)

Eg:- The dead bodies of the terrorists are kept in the mortuary so that they can be identified.

Word - Cata /Cad Meaning - Fall / Downward

Catastrophe (like tsunami, earthquake) - destruction. (अचानक आई बहुत बड़ी तबाही)

Eg:- The black sea is facing ecological catastrophe as a result of pollution.

Cataclysm -destruction. (विनाशकारी प्राकृतिक उथल-पुथल)

Eg:- The people of Japan are so strong because they always overcome every cataclysm which comes into Japan.

Word - Cata /Cad Meaning - Fall / Downward

Cadence - Fall of words in speech/singing. (आवाज़ का उतार और चढ़ाव)

Eg:- The cadence of my girlfriends's voice is very sweet that is why I always suggest her to pursue her career in singing.

Cascade- water fall. (सीढ़ीदार छोटा पानी का झरना)

Eg:-Her hair fell over her shoulders in a cascade of curls.

Cataract - a large water fall. (आंखों का मोतियाबिंद या झरना)

Eg:- In the rainy season you can see the cataracts in the mountains.
