

**EXCLAMATORY → ASSERTIVE**

## What is an Exclamatory Sentence?

An exclamatory sentence shows **strong feeling** such as joy, sorrow, surprise, anger, etc.

It ends with an **exclamation mark (!)**.

**E.g.**

- What a beautiful day!
- How brave he is!

## What is an Assertive Sentence?

An assertive sentence is a **normal statement**.  
It ends with a **full stop (.)**.

**E.g.**

- It is a very beautiful day.
- He is very brave.

## **Rule 1:** Replace “What” or “How” with “very”

Most exclamatory sentences use **What** or **How**.  
In assertive form, replace them with **very**.

**E.g.**

What a beautiful flower!

It is a **very** beautiful flower.

How brave the soldier is!

The soldier is **very** brave.

## **Rule 2:** Use correct subject and verb

Sometimes you must add **It is / He is / She is.**

**E.g.**

What a terrible storm!

It is a very terrible storm.

It is a matter of praise that we have done well.(Assertive)  
Bravo ! We have done well. (Exclamatory)

It is a matter of contempt that you are a fraud.(Assertive)  
Fie ! You are a fraud. (Exclamatory)

It is extremely sad that he lost his brother.(Assertive)  
Alas ! He lost his brother. (Exclamatory)

## Rule 4 :

I wish I were a bird. (Assertive)

- a. Would that I were a bird ! (Exclamatory)
- b. O that / Oh that I were a bird ! (Exclamatory)
- c. If only I were a bird ! (Exclamatory)

I wish I could find my bag. (Assertive)

- a. Would that I could find my bag! (Exclamatory)
- b. O that / Oh that I could find my bag! (Exclamatory)
- b. If only I could find my bag! (Exclamatory)

# **SIMPLE, COMPOUND AND COMPLEX SENTENCES**

To understand the types of transformation of sentences we need to know the definition of THE Simple Sentence, Complex Sentence, and Compound Sentence.

## **Simple Sentence:**

A simple sentence is a sentence that consists of just one independent clause.

### **E.g.**

The value of exercise is great.

He confessed his fault.

I saw a wounded bird.



## Compound Sentence:

A sentence which is a combination of two simple sentences of equal rank is called a compound sentence.

**E.g.**

- Karan went to market **and** he bought some vegetables.
- We informed him about it **but** he failed to understand.
- You must not be late **or** you will be punished.

## **Complex Sentence:**

A complex sentence is a sentence that contains an independent clause and one or more dependent clauses.

**E.g.**

- He confessed **that he was guilty of his illegal act.**
- I found the book **which I had lost.**
- The reply **which you have made** is foolish.
- The man **who was caught by the police** was a thief.

## Transforming Simple Sentences into Complex Sentences:

Converting Simple Sentences into Complex Sentences can be done easily by simply expanding a word or a phrase into a clause. Moreover, we can do the same thing when we want to change the Complex Sentences into Simple Sentences. And this can be done by eliminating a clause into a word or a phrase.

- He confessed **his crime**. (Simple sentence)
- He confessed **that he was guilty**. (Complex sentence)

Here we expanded the noun 'his crime' into the noun clause 'that he was guilty'

- He bought his **uncle's factory**. (Simple sentence)
- He bought the factory **that belonged to his uncle**.

Here we expanded the noun phrase 'his uncle's factory' into the adjective clause 'that belonged to his uncle'.

## **Rule: 1:**

“**Present participle**” in a simple sentence, can be converted into complex sentence by adding “**when/as**” in the first half of the sentence.

- **Simple Sentence:** Closing the door, I went back to school.
- **Complex Sentence:** When I closed the door, I went back to school.

## **Rule: 2**

“**Being/ Verb+ing**” in a simple sentence, can be converted into a complex sentence by adding “**as/since**” at the first half of the sentence.

- **Simple Sentence:** After winning a beauty contest she cried.
- **Complex Sentence:** As she won the beauty contest, she cried.



### **Rule: 3**

“Too...to” in a simple sentence, can be converted into a complex sentence by adding “so...that (negative)”.

- **Simple Sentence:** He is too weak to carry the box.
- **Complex Sentence:** He is so weak that he cannot carry the box.

### **Rule: 4**

“To + vb (infinitive) ” in the simple sentence, can be converted into a complex sentence by adding “so that” in the sentence.

- **Simple sentence:** We eat to live.
- **Complex Sentence:** We eat so that we can live.



## **Rule: 5**

In the simple sentence “**in spite of/ despite**”, can be converted into the complex sentence by adding “**though/ although**” in the sentence.

**Simple Sentence:** In spite of being rich, she is hard working.

**Complex Sentence:** Though she is rich, she is hard working.

## **Rule: 6**

“**Because of**” in the simple sentence, can be converted to the complex sentence by adding “**since/as**” at the beginning of the sentence.

**Simple Sentence:** Because of his illness, he could not join the meeting.

**Complex Sentence:** Since he was ill, he could not join the meeting.

## **Rule: 7**

“**Subject + verb + object + present participle**” type of simple sentence, can be converted to the complex sentence by “**subject + verb + object + relative pronoun + be verb according to relative pronoun and tense + rest of the sentence**”.

**Simple Sentence:** I saw a bird flying.

**Complex Sentence:** I saw a bird which was flying.

## **Rule: 8**

If the simple sentence starts with “**without**”, can be converted into the complex sentence by adding “**if / in case + not or unless**”

**Simple Sentence:** Without adding the sugar the dish will taste bad.

**Complex Sentence:** If you do not add sugar the dish will taste bad.

## **Rule: 9**

“**at the time**” in the simple sentence will be converted into “**when**” in the complex sentence.

**Simple Sentence:** She woke up at the time of load shedding.

**Complex Sentence:** She woke up when it was load shedding.

## **Rule: 10:**

“**adjective**” in the simple sentence, will be converted into “**that/which +verb + adjective**” in the complex sentence.

**Simple Sentence:** It was a blue shirt.

**Complex Sentence:** It was a shirt which was blue.
