Indispensable	As in necessary, Too important
Transient	Continuing for only a short time
Prolific	Highly productive
Conceit	The fact of being too proud of yourself and what you do
Tolerance	The quality of being willing to accept or capacity to endure pain.
Precise	Clear and accurate
Compassionate	Displaying concern or understanding towards other people
Predicament	Difficult, unpleasant situation
Promptly	In a quick manner
Flung	To throw or push something with force especially because you are angry
Decipher	To succeed in finding meaning of something that is difficult to understand.
Adjourn	To suspend or conclude an event
Hesitate	To be slow to speak or act because you feel nervous
Catastrophe	A disaster of huge proportions
Demarcation	A dividing line
Tantalise	To make you want something that you cannot have
Corpulent	Having a large bulky body
Dynamic	Always active or changing

Frantic	In a state of panic, worry, frenzy or rush
Soothe	To make somebody who is anxious, upset, feel calmer
Fervour	Great intensity of feeling or belief
Astonished	Greatly surprised
Counterfeit	A fake version of an original item
Feasibility	The possibility, capability, or likelihood of something being done or accomplished
Elaborate	To explain in detail
Paragon	A person who is perfect example of a particular good quality.
Essence	The key element of something
Procrastination	The act of delaying something that must be done
Intervene	To interfere in an incident for a specific purpose
Implies	Suggest that something is true that you feel without saying it directly
Quell	To calm or reduce
Repercussion	An indirect and usually a bad action or result
Hideous	Very ugly or unpleasant
Bleak	Devoid of enthusiasm or life
Ravishing	Extremely beautiful
Detest	To hate something very much
Timid	Lacking in courage or confidence
