<b>Resentment</b>	A feeling of anger or unhappiness about something that you think is unfair.
<b>Pompous</b>	Showing that you think you are more important than other people especially by using long and formal words.
<b>Keen</b>	Wanting to do something very much
<b>Heckle</b>	To interrupt discussion by asking difficult questions or rude comments
<b>Compel</b>	To force someone to do something
<b>Deride</b>	To laugh at someone in a way that shows you think they are stupid or of no value.
<b>Colossal</b>	Extremely Large
<b>Exaltation</b>	A feeling or state of extreme happiness.
<b>Rotate</b>	To move something in a circle
<b>Scrutiny</b>	Careful and detailed examination of something in order to get information about it.
<b>Competent</b>	Able to do something skillfully
<b>Perpetual</b>	continuing forever, never-ending
<b>Pervasive</b>	Existing in all parts of a place or thing
<b>Asphyxiation</b>	To cause someone to be unable to breathe usually resulting into death.
<b>Bizarre</b>	Very strange
<b>Tranquil</b>	Relaxed; Peaceful
<b>Discreet</b>	Being careful about what one says or does to avoid embarrassing or upsetting others.
<b>Void</b>	Not legal
<b>Obligatory</b>	that you must do
<b>Exhaling</b>	To emit air
<b>Diminutive</b>	Very small
<b>Brazen</b>	Bold and without shame
<b>Defunct</b>	No longer existing

<b>Conspicuous</b>	Easy to see or notice
<b>Antiquated</b>	From the past, old fashioned
<b>Adulterated</b>	To make a substance impure by adding something else to it
<b>Worn</b>	Damaged from too much use
<b>Deteriorate</b>	To lessen in value or ability
<b>Enchanting</b>	Captivating or charming
<b>Callous</b>	showing or having an insensitive and cruel disregard for others
<b>Retgression</b>	The act or an instance of going back to an earlier and lower level especially of intelligence or behavior.
<b>Specify</b>	To state something clearly and accurately
<b>Frivolous</b>	Of no real worth
<b>Conspire</b>	To plan to do something bad or illegal with a group of people
<b>Erudite</b>	Having or showing profound knowledge
<b>Bewitching</b>	Charming and attractive in a seductive way
<b>Efface</b>	To wipeout something
<b>Comprehend</b>	To mentally grasp the meaning or reason behind something
<b>Itemize</b>	To produce a detailed list of something
<b>Assuagement</b>	To ease, To lessen
<b>Dignity</b>	The state of being honoured
<b>Perilous</b>	Full of danger
<b>Ponder</b>	To think about something carefully or for a long time
<b>Mitigate</b>	Make less severe or painful
<b>Erroneous</b>	Not correct, based on wrong Information
<b>Abominable</b>	As in disgusting
<b>Makeshift</b>	A temporary substitute
<b>Eager</b>	Strongly wanting to do or have something.
<b>Destitute</b>	lacking money or material possessions
<b>Forgery</b>	A fabricated replication of something meant to appear like the real thing
