

Figure out :- to understand (समझ पाना)



Eg:- I am unable to figure out the meaning of his ambiguous statement.

Fizzle out :- to weaken gradually (क्रमश कमजोर पड़ना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- The game started well but it fizzled out in the second half.

Gain on :- to come close to (प्रतियोगिता में नजदीक होना)



Eg:- The red bull racer is gaining on his opponent in the race.

Get along (with someone) :- to have a friendly relationship (दोस्ताना व्यवहार होना)

Eg:- Why don't you two get along? You are always arguing.

Get away with :- to do something illegal without being punished (गलत काम करके बिना सजा के बच निकल जाना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- He got away with cheating because the invigilator was not very active.

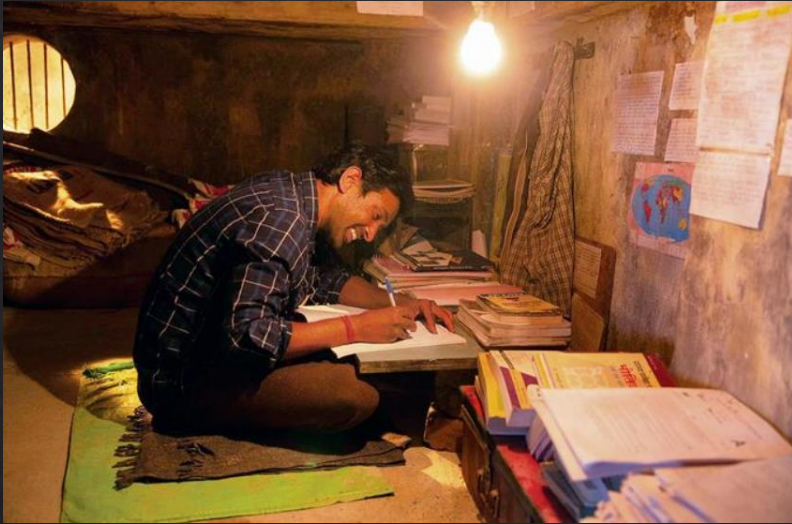
Get over :- overcome a difficulty/ recover from
illness of bad experience
(उबर पाना / निपटना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- He has finally got over his
fear of water.

Get on :- to make progress (प्रगति करना)



Eg:- Everyone can get on, if he/she works hard.

Get rid of :- to leave, to dispose of, to throw away

(छुटकारा पाना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- I want to get rid of my bad habits.

Get through with :- to complete a task
(किसी कार्य को पूरा करना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- The Survey team has got through with its assignment.

Give away :- to reveal the secret (रहस्य उजागर करना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- She gave away all my secrets to her best friend.

Give in :- to surrender (समरपण करना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- The suspect finally gave in to the police.

Give up :- surrender/ quit something because you think that you can't succeed (हार मान लेना)

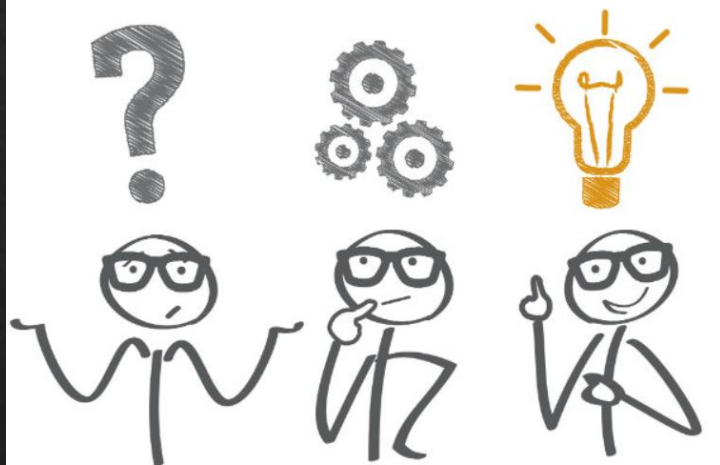
Aman Sir English

Go about : to begin to do something or deal with something (कुछ करना या किसी चीज़ से निपटना शुरू करना)

Eg:- How can we go about solving this problem?

Go along with :- to agree (सहमत होना)

PAYMENT AGREEMENT

PARTIES

- This Payment Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") is entered into on _____ (the "Effective Date"), by and between _____ with an address of _____ (hereinafter referred to as the "Debtor"), and _____ with an address of _____ (hereinafter referred to as the "Creditor") (collectively referred to as the "Parties").

AGREEMENT

- The Parties agree that the Debtor is to pay the Creditor an amount of _____.

- The Parties agree to secure the amount of debt by entering into a new agreement where the amount of _____ mentioned above is to be set into a structured payment agreement according to the terms and conditions provided below.

DEBTOR REPRESENTATION

- The Debtor warrants as well as represents that the Parties have agreed upon a payment plan to secure the deficiency in a scheduled manner as set forth in this Agreement.

PAYMENT PLAN

- The Parties agree to establish the payment plan as follows:

DEFAULT

- In case the Debtor fails to provide the payments as per the payment plans within a reasonable time, the Creditor becomes entitled to declare the remaining amount and the present interest, if any, immediately due and payable.

GOVERNING LAW

- This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of _____.

SEVERABILITY

Eg:- I went along with the decision to avoid conflict.

Go by :- to work accordingly (नियमानुसार कार्य करना)



Eg:- Everyone should go by the traffic rules.

Go down in history :- to get admitted in history
(इतिहास में नाम दर्ज होना)

Eg:- If you work for the welfare of others, your name will go down in history.

Go on :- to continue doing something
(किसी कार्य को जारी रखना)

Eg:- He went on working hard and finally succeeded.

Go through :- To read, to pass through a time
(किसी दौर से गुजरना/पढ़ना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- You are advised to go through this book in order to find the solution of your problem.

Go with :- to select or choose (चुनना)



Eg:- I cannot go with this brand.
It is out of fashion now.

Hear of :- to get the news about
(किसी के बारे में सूचना मिलना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- She was shocked when heard of his fatal accident.

Hit out :- to attack verbally (आलोचना करना)



Eg:- He hit out the opposition leaders for calling him corrupt.

Hold back :- to control expression (व्यक्त करने से रुकना)



Eg:- I struggled to hold back my tears.

Hold on :- to keep something in a position
(किसी चीज़ को स्थिति में रखना)

Aman Sir English

"Please hold, your call
is important to us."



Eg:- Please hold on while we
transfer your call to the
executive.

Jump at :- Accept eagerly (उत्सुकता से स्वीकार करना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- He jumped at the offer given by the HR.

Keep away :- to maintain distance (दूरी बनाए रखना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- Children were instructed to keep away from flowers while playing in the park.

Keep from :- to abstain from (बुरी संगत से दूर रहना)



Eg:- You should always keep from bad people.

Keep up:- to maintain in good condition/ to continue doing something
(अच्छी स्थिति में रखना /किसी कार्य को जारी रखना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- Indian team often fails to keep up their performance.

Knock down :- to thrust someone to the ground
(धक्का मार के गिरा देना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- In the game of Kabaddi,
Rohit knocked down his opponent.

Lay down :- to give up arms (हथियार डाल देना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- There is no alternative but to lay down your weapons.

Lay off :- to dismiss/ to fire (छटनी करना/ नौकरी से निकालना)



Eg:- Our company is going to lay off some workers.

Lie behind : to be the real reason (वास्तविक कारण होना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- I wonder what lay behind his decision to suicide.

Live by doing something :- to earn livelihood
(कोई काम करके गुजर बसर करना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- My father lives by furniture work.

Live off /on :- to live on particular food
(किसी खास भोजन पर रहना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- A lion usually lives off the flesh of the others animals.

Live through :- to survive in difficulty
(किसी अप्रिय अनुभव को झेलना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- We lived through the rainy days and this made us strong.

Live up to :- to reach an expected standard
(उम्मीद के अनुसार होना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- I couldn't live up to my
parents' expectations.

Look about :- to search (तलाश करना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- I am looking about my bike key.

Look for :- try to find (खोजना)



Eg:- My grandfather has looked for the spectacles, but didn't find it.

Look down on /upon :- to regard as inferior
(नीची निगाह से देखना)

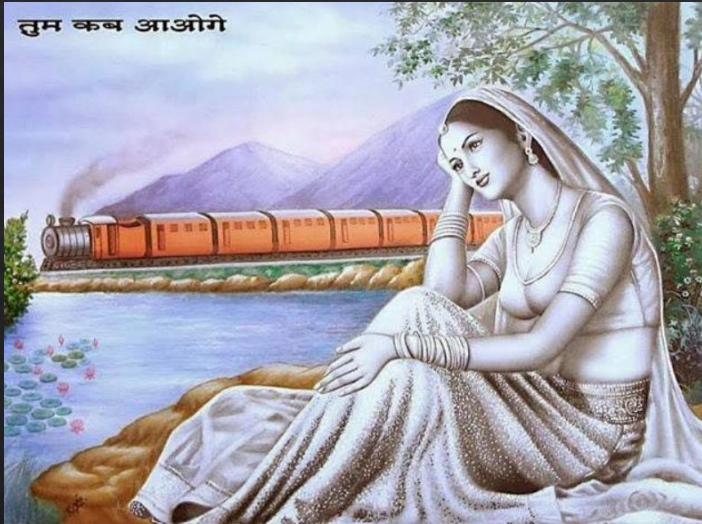
Aman Sir English



Eg:- The rich should not look down upon the poor.

Look forward to :- to anticipate pleasantly
(उत्सुकता से प्रतीक्षा करना)

Aman Sir English



Eg:- I am looking forward to meeting you.

Look into :- to investigate (जांच करना)



Eg:- Please look into this matter as soon as possible.
