DON'T USE PREPOSITIONS AFTER THESE VERBS:-

(because these verbs are transitive they must have an object):-

These verbs are generally followed by a preposition “to” in errors.

Omit that “to”

Meet, join, obey, violate, ask, bid, tell, Inform, remind, warn, thank, advise

Reach, resist, resemble, attack, afford, demand, comprise, investigate, enter,

flee, explain, describe, discuss, disobey, order, stress, emphasize, await,

despite (preposition) etc.

 Mohan resembles **with** his father a lot.

If you come late, I will inform **to** your parents.

Einstein explained about the theory of relativity.

S V ^X Obj prep Cx(Po) obj of N
He entered into the office without making any sound.

enter into → get involved in something

Sheetal entered into an argument with her boss.

S HV Adv MV ^X Obj
Police haven't controlled over the mob even after 7 hours.

S MV Adj Obj (N) prep PO
They have no control over their children that is why their children keep on doing such activities. NE

S V X Obj
Some unknown men attacked on the travelers as soon as they entered the jungle.

Some terrorists were arrested yesterday who were planning an attack on the Lal Quila. NE

MV Adj. Obj (N) P ← PO

R.P (Sub + Comp)

S V X obj
 All the members stressed on the implementation of the new policy.

Conj S V inf(obj) D Adj obj/inf. verb on Adj obj(N) prep PO NE
 If you want to bend this rod, lay some stress on it.

S HV MV X obj
 I will demand for more money from my father in law.

S HV Adv MV P Adj obj(N) prep on Adj PO NE
 I can't fulfill his demand for more money.

S HV MV ^{Obj} for a cup of tea as I am really tired. Adj (Past Pr).

S V ^{Obj (N)} ^{Prep} 30 minutes ago. ^{PO} ✓ NE

D Adj Sub V ^{Obj} of 300 old coins from various countries.

D Adj Sub LV ^(SC) Past Pr (Adj) ^{Prep} 11 players from various countries. ^{PO} ✓ NE

HV MV (Passive)



I met with my friend when I went to Delhi.

meet with → phrasal verb → accident / tragedy

He met with an accident last year. NE

(using same words) → word for word ✓

He repeated their conversation with Rohan word to word to me.

word after word

translation

← word by word

his or her / his / their ^{(weak(er))}

Sub_x p ← po_x
Speakers_x after speakers_x went to the podium to deliver their speech.

* Noun(sing) prep Noun(sing) eg. day by day
same

Prep
on + last / next / this + Noun (Time)

She is not here as she went to Delhi with her husband on last Monday.
Adv.

You needn't worry at all as I will come there on Monday next. NE
