bathe, move, rest, hide etc.

They hid the stolen money under the mattress.

He bathed himself quickly and went to office.

He remained himself calm during the interrogation.

I kept calm during the class.

I keep my wallet in my left pocket.

Sorry, Guilt, Punishment :- 123 (1st person, 2nd person , 3rd person,)

Plural pronouns :- 123 (1st person, 2nd person , 3rd person,)
