

CADAVEROUS:- very thin, especially because of sickness or hunger (बीमारी या भूख से अत्यंत दुबला)

Mnemonics:- Kaidi virus disease se ho gya cadaverous

Aman sir English



Syn:- corpse-like, deathly, pallid

Ant:- lively, healthy, vibrant

Eg:- Hunger and exhaustion gave the prisoners a cadaverous look.

Quixotic :- Extremely idealistic and unrealistic in a way that ignores practical reality. (अत्यधिक आदर्शवादी और अव्यावहारिक)

Mnemonics:- quickly exotic location pahunchne ke sapne dekhna quixotic hai

Aman sir English

Syn:- idealistic, unrealistic, impractical

Ant:- practical, realistic, sensible

Eg:- Many admired her quixotic dream, even though it had little chance of success.



Piquant:- having a pleasantly strong or spicy taste (तीखा और स्वादिष्ट)

Mnemonics:- picke jo aunty ne bnaye wo piquant hain

Aman sir English

Syn:- spicy, tangy, stimulating

Ant:- bland, dull, tasteless

Eg:- The sauce was mildly piquant,
awakening the taste buds instantly.



Torpor :- A state of extreme physical or mental inactivity.
(शारीरिक या मानसिक सुस्ती)

Mnemonics:- padhai me rahoge torpor to kabhi nhi ban paoge topper Aman sir English



Syn:- lethargy, inertia, sluggishness

Ant:- energy, alertness, activity

Eg:- Mental torpor made it difficult for him to focus on even simple tasks.

Vindicate :- To prove someone right or clear them from blame.
(दोषमुक्त साबित करना)

Mnemonics:- case win kiya dikkat ke bawjood isliye Vindicate ho gya Aman sir English



Syn:- justify, defend, clear

Ant:- accuse, blame, condemn

Eg:- New evidence finally vindicated him and proved that he was innocent.

Prosaic :- Ordinary and dull without imagination. (साधारण और नीरस)

Mnemonics:- Proses padhne me prosaic hi lagti hain

Aman sir English



Syn:- dull, ordinary, mundane

Ant:- imaginative, exciting, poetic

Eg:- His prosaic lifestyle lacked adventure and creativity.

Turpitude :- Serious moral corruption wicked behavior and lack of integrity. (नैतिक पतन और दुष्टता)

Mnemonics:- Trump jaisa immoral attitude

Aman sir English



Syn:- immorality, depravity, corruption

Ant:- virtue, integrity, morality

Eg:- The politician's involvement in the scandal revealed a shocking level of moral turpitude that eroded the public's trust.

Palliate :- To reduce pain or seriousness temporarily without solving the real problem. (अस्थायी राहत देना)

Mnemonics:- Pill ate karke pain ko kiya palliate

Aman sir English



Syn:- relieve, ease, mitigate

Ant:- worsen, aggravate, intensify

Eg:- The doctor prescribed medication to palliate the patient's symptoms, but a cure would require surgery.

Dissemble :- To hide the truth or real feelings by pretending or misleading behavior. (सच्चाई छिपाना)

Mnemonics:- Minister log akasar assembly me dissemble karte hain

Aman sir English



Syn:- pretend, conceal, feign

Ant:- reveal, confess, disclose

Eg:- Her plan was to dissemble her intentions from her husband so she could successfully plan him a surprise party.

Oppugn :- To attack strongly or openly challenge an idea belief or action. (खुलकर विरोध करना)

Mnemonics:- Opposition

Aman sir English



Syn:- oppose, attack, challenge

Ant:- support, defend, uphold

Eg:- He oppugned his opponent to a debate, challenging him to defend his stance on the issue.

Munificent :- Showing great generosity especially with money or help. (बहुत उदार और दानी)

Mnemonics:- jo money baanta ho fist bhar ke

Aman sir English



Syn:- generous, lavish, liberal

Ant:- stingy, miserly, mean

Eg:- She was renowned for her munificent charity, donating generously to various causes.

Lassitude :- A state of physical mental or emotional tiredness and lack of energy. (थकान और ऊर्जा की कमी)

Mnemonics:- Lassi pee ke aa gya lassitude

Aman sir English



Syn:- fatigue, weariness, lethargy

Ant:- energy, vigor, liveliness

Eg:- The hot summer afternoon brought a sense of lassitude to the whole town, as everyone sought shade and rest.

Recalcitrance :- the fact of being unwilling to obey rules or follow instructions; the fact of being difficult to control (आज्ञा न मानने की प्रवृत्ति)

Mnemonics:- Re kal se karenge bolke tarkana

Aman sir English



Syn:- stubbornness, defiance, resistance

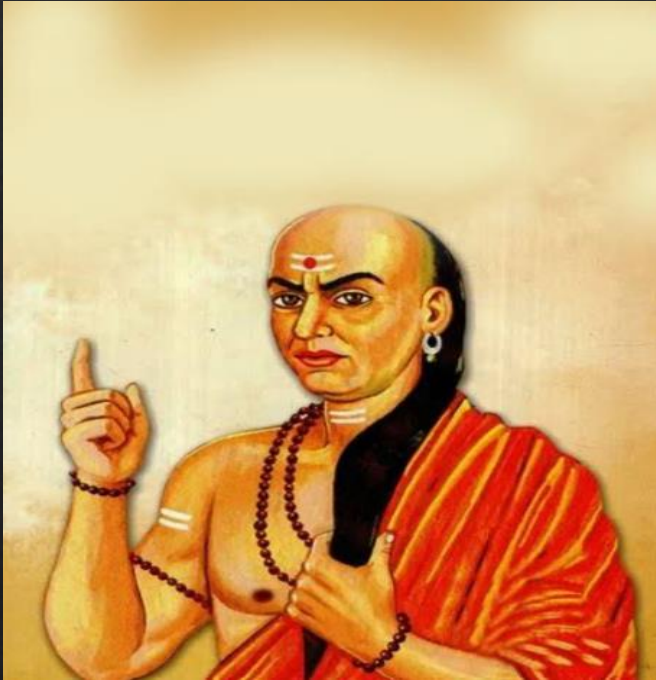
Ant:- obedience, compliance, submission

Eg:- Despite the principal's best efforts, the student's recalcitrance continued to disrupt the class.

Esoteric :- Difficult to understand and known only to a small group of people (केवल कुछ लोगों को ज्ञात)

Mnemonics:- Esi baat jo so(100) me ek (1) ko samaj aaye

Aman sir English



Syn:- obscure, mysterious, arcane

Ant:- common, clear, popular

Eg:- The esoteric language used in the ancient text made it difficult for modern scholars to decipher.

Soporific:- making you want to go to sleep (नींद लाने वाला)

Mnemonics:- Iss dwai ko khake sapne ayenge terrific

Aman sir English



Syn:- sleep-inducing, dull, sedative

Ant:- stimulating, exciting, alerting

Eg:- The soporific effects of the medication made it difficult for her to stay awake during the meeting.

Zany :- Amusingly strange silly or crazy in behavior. (हास्यास्पद और सनकी)

Mnemonics:- aaj kal ke Genz bache zany hote hain

Aman sir English



Syn:- crazy, goofy, eccentric

Ant:- serious, sensible, sober

Eg:- She was known for her zany fashion sense, often wearing bright colors and bold patterns.

Aman sir English

Fulsome :- too generous in praising or thanking somebody, or in saying sorry, so that you do not sound sincere (अत्यधिक और बनावटी प्रशंसा)

Mnemonics:- ful handsome hai bhai tu

Aman sir English



Syn:- excessive, exaggerated, insincere

Ant:- sincere, restrained, genuine

Eg:- The fulsome language used in the wedding vows made the ceremony even more emotional.

Incorrigible :- Having bad habits which cannot be changed or improved (सुधार से परे)

Mnemonics:- In (not), Corrigible (able to correct)

Aman sir English



Syn:- hardened, abandoned, incurable

Ant:- reformable, obedient, manageable

Eg:- Even after spending a year in jail, the young man remains incorrigible and unafraid of the law.

Extirpate :- To destroy remove or eliminate completely from the root. (जड़ से समाप्त करना)

Mnemonics:- extra pet kaat dia

Aman sir English



Syn:- eradicate, eliminate, uproot

Ant:- preserve, maintain, protect

Eg:- She carefully extirpated the rotten layers from the onion before chopping it for the recipe.

Impecunious :- Having little or no money and living in poverty.
(बहुत गरीब व्यक्ति)

Mnemonics:- I am packing onions because I am impecunious.

Aman sir English



Syn:- poor, penniless, broke

Ant:- wealthy, rich, affluent

Eg:- I first met him when he was an impecunious student, barely surviving on instant noodles in a tiny studio apartment

Placatory :- Intended to calm anger reduce hostility or bring peace in a tense situation. (शांत करने वाला)

Mnemonics:- Plate katori ke peeche kyu lad rhe ho nyi aa jayegi

Aman sir English



Syn:- appeasing, calming, conciliatory

Ant:- provocative, aggressive, inflammatory

Eg:- Her placatory words prevented the argument from turning violent.

Transitory :- Lasting for a very short time not permanent. (थोड़े समय के लिए)

Mnemonics:- Train ki trah transient, aai aur chali gyi

Aman sir English



Syn:- temporary, short-lived, fleeting

Ant:- permanent, lasting, enduring

Eg:- Her feelings for him were transitory, and soon she moved on.

Refulgent :- Shining very brightly or glowing with brilliance.
(तेज चमकने वाला)

Mnemonics:- detergent se saaf karke kapde ho jate refulgent

Aman sir English



Syn:- radiant, brilliant, shining

Ant:- dull, dim, dark

Eg:- The refulgent stars shone brightly
in the night sky, a celestial showcase.

Opprobrium :- Strong public criticism shame or disgrace. (घोर निंदा और अपमान)

Mnemonics:- aap road pe rum piyoge to log opprobrium hi karenge Aman sir English



Syn:- disgrace, shame, condemnation

Ant:- honor, praise, respect

Eg:- The athlete's doping scandal led to opprobrium and a loss of sponsorships.

Pulverize :- To crush or destroy something completely into small pieces. (चूर-चूर कर देना)

Mnemonics:- pull pe oversize ka truck jayega ye pulverize kar dega Aman sir English



Syn:- crush, smash, demolish

Ant:- build, assemble, strengthen

Eg:- The machine can pulverize rocks into dust with its powerful blades.

Puissant :- Having great power strength or influence.
(बहुत शक्तिशाली और प्रभावशाली)

Mnemonics:- itna puissant (powerful) hai ki pees ke rakh
dega

Aman sir English

Syn:- powerful, mighty, strong

Ant:- weak, powerless, feeble

Eg:- The athlete's puissant physique was evident in his muscular build and chiseled features.



Reverence :- A feeling of deep respect or admiration for someone or something. (गहरा सम्मान और आदर)

Mnemonics:- humare mann me Ganga river ke liye reverence hai

Aman sir English



Syn:- respect, esteem, veneration

Ant:- disrespect, contempt, scorn

Eg:- The crowd stood in reverence as the national anthem, "Jana Gana Mana", filled the cinema hall.

Lachrymose :- Showing excessive sadness or tendency to cry easily. (बहुत दुखी रहने वाला)

Mnemonics:- cry + almost

Aman sir English



Syn:- tearful, sorrowful, mournful

Ant:- cheerful, joyful, happy

Eg:- After her husband passed away, she became a lachrymose woman who was easily brought to tears.

Pulchritude :- beauty, especially a woman's beauty (असाधारण सुंदरता)

Mnemonics:- Pulse chalni ruk jaye jise dekh kar.

Aman sir English



Syn:-beauty, attractiveness, loveliness

Ant:- ugliness, plainness, unattractiveness

Eg:- Although this actress is not a woman of great pulchritude, her vast talent has won her more awards than anyone else in the business.

Aman sir English

Lugubrious :- Looking or sounding sad gloomy or depressing.

(उदास और निराशाजनक)

Mnemonics:- Lugai barat se bhag gyi to groom ka face
lugubrious ho gya

Aman sir English



Syn:- gloomy, mournful, sad

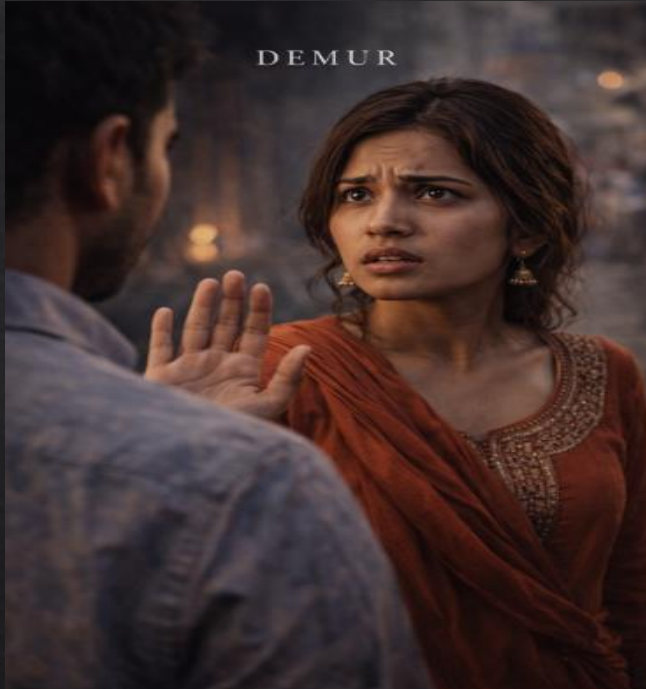
Ant:- cheerful, lively, bright

Eg:- He sat by the window with a
lugubrious expression, watching the
pouring rain.

Demur :- To express hesitation or objection, often in a polite or indirect way. (संकोचपूर्वक आपत्ति करना)

Mnemonics:- Dheere se mana karna

Aman sir English



Syn:- object, protest, hesitate

Ant:- agree, accept, consent

Eg:- Did the working class accept their circumstances without demur?

Mendacious :- not telling the truth; lying. (झूठ बोलने वाला)

Mnemonics:- Maine dekha isse crime karte hue.

Aman sir English



Syn:- dishonest, lying, deceitful

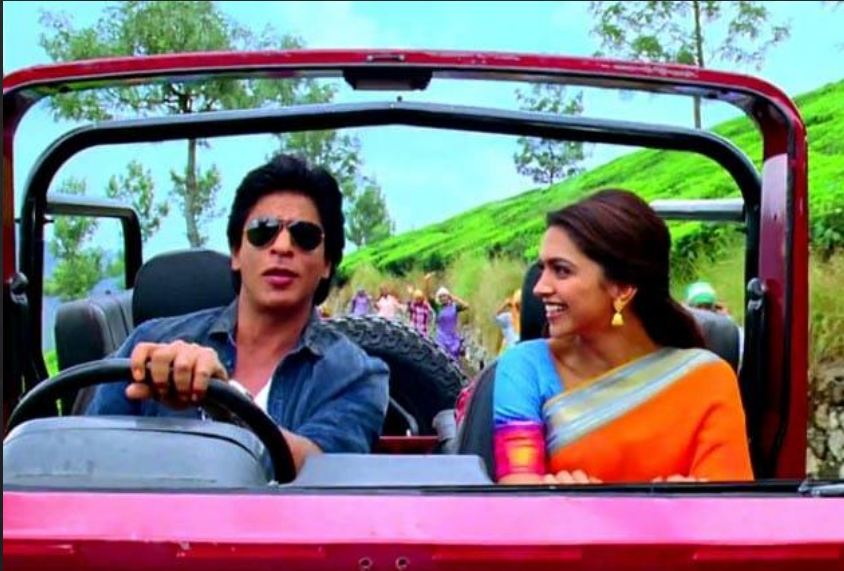
Ant:- truthful, honest, sincere

Eg:- The journalist was fired for spreading mendacious information.

Voluble :- speaking a lot, with confidence and enthusiasm (बहुत बोलने वाला)

Mnemonics:- Volume (jada quantity) me bolne wala

Aman sir English



Syn:- alkative, fluent, loquacious

Ant:- silent, quiet, reserved

Eg:-After my grandfather drinks a few beers, he becomes voluble and will not stop talking.
