

CAVIL:- To raise petty, unnecessary objections about small or unimportant details. (बेवजह दोष या कमियां निकालना)

Mnemonics:- Chhoti-chhoti baaton pe Will (वसीयत) की तरह ladna

Aman Sir English



Syn:- Quibble, Nitpick, Carp

Ant:- Agree, Accept, Approve

Eg:- The meeting slowed down because he chose to cavil on trivial points rather than contribute meaningfully.

CONFLAGRATION:- A very large, destructive fire that spreads quickly. (भीषण और विनाशकारी बड़ी आग)

Mnemonics:- pehle flag me aag lagi fir conflagration ho gya

Aman Sir English



Syn:- Inferno, Blaze, Wildfire

Ant:- Extinguishment, Calm, Peace

Eg:- The ancient city was destroyed by a sudden **conflagration** that spread through wooden houses within hours.

PHLEGMATIC :- Calm, unemotional, and not easily excited or upset. (शांत और स्थिर स्वभाव वाला)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- har feeling me rehta adig (constant)

Syn:- Calm, Unemotional, Composed

Ant:- Excitable, Emotional, Impulsive

Eg:- Her phlegmatic nature helped her make clear decisions under pressure.

TRENCHANT :- Forcefully clear, sharp, and effective—especially in speech or criticism. (असरदार, स्पष्ट और तीखा)

Mnemonics:- wo chen chen nhi karta trenchant view deta hai



Syn:- Sharp, Forceful, Cutting

Ant:- Vague, Mild, Indirect

Eg:- The lawyer delivered a trenchant argument that left no room for doubt.

IRREPRESSIBLE :- lively, happy and full of energy (जिसे दबाया या रोका न जा सके)

Mnemonics:- usse suppress nhi kiya ja sakta wo irrepressible hai Aman Sir English



Syn:- Uncontrollable, Unrestrainable, Lively

Ant:- Restrained, Controlled, Suppressed

Eg:- You cannot keep her quiet for long;
she's irrepressible!

INTRANSIGENT :- Unwilling to change opinions or compromise even when it causes problems. (अपनी बात पर अड़ा रहने वाला)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- IN hi rehna TRANSITION na karna”



Syn:- stubborn, unyielding, rigid

Ant:- flexible, cooperative, open-minded

Eg:- His intransigent attitude blocked every attempt at negotiation.

COMPLAISANT :- ready to accept other people's actions and opinions and to do what other people want (दूसरों को खुश करने वाला)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- 'Complete YES sir' type insaan



Syn:- agreeable, obliging, submissive

Ant:- assertive, resistant, uncompromising

Eg:- He was too complaisant to protest the unfair decision made by his boss.

DILATORY :- Causing delay by slow action or unnecessary postponement. (देर करने या टालने वाला)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- Delay kar di thodi



Syn:- Tardy, Procrastinating, Delaying

Ant:- Prompt, Quick, Efficient

Eg:- The government was criticized for its dilatory response, which made a serious problem even worse.

INVECTIVE :- an attack with words, especially strong verbal attacks. (कठोर और अपमानजनक अपशब्द)

Mnemonics:- inn jaise vyation ke khilaf to invective hona hi chahiye



Syn:- Abuse, Insult, Denunciation

Ant:- Prompt, Quick, Efficient

Eg:- The gesture infuriated him and he let out a stream of invective.

UPBRAID :- To criticize or scold someone sharply for a mistake or wrong behavior. (जोर से डांटना या फटकारना)

Mnemonics:- braid (चोटी) ko up karna matlb खिंचाई karna

Aman Sir English



Syn:- Rebuke, Scold, Reprimand

Ant:- Praise, Commend, Applaud

Eg:- He was upbraided by the teacher for ignoring instructions despite repeated reminders.

ANACHRONISTIC :- a person, a custom or an idea that seems old-fashioned (पुराने ज़माने का)

Mnemonics:- Aana CHRONology se bahar



Syn:- Outdated, Old-fashioned, Obsolete

Ant:- Modern, Current, Contemporary

Eg:- The costumes were anachronistic and specially designed for a Victorian play.

AWRY :- not in the intended manner, or out of position, or wrong. (टेढ़ा-मेढ़ा या योजना से अलग)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- Jab koi awry activity dekhte hain muh se nikalta hai "arey ye kya hua"



Syn:- Amiss, Askew, Astray,

Ant:- Right, Proper, Smooth

Eg:- When the serial killer was released from prison, everyone knew the justice system had gone awry.

TRUNCATE :- Cut short so that the ending part is removed. (छोटा करना)

Mnemonics:- TRUNK + CUT

Aman Sir English



Syn:- shortened, cut off, abbreviated

Ant:- complete, extended, full-length

Eg:- The video appeared truncated, as the ending scene was missing.

APOGEE :- The highest point or peak of success or power.
(चरम शिखर, सर्वोच्च अवस्था)

Mnemonics:- summit pe pahunch ke usne bola - apogee pe ab jake pahunchi

Aman Sir English

Syn:- peak, summit, zenith

Ant:- bottom, low point, nadir

Eg:- Reaching the summit of the Himalayas after years of struggle marked the apogee of his mountaineering career.

CAUSTIC :- Extremely harsh or sarcastic in speech or capable of burning and destroying things. (कटु, तीखा, दाहक)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- sarcastic



Syn:- Harsh, Sarcastic, Corrosive

Ant:- Gentle, Kind, Soothing

Eg:- Her speech was a caustic attack on government officials.

PERSPICUOUS:- Very clear and easy to understand.
(स्पष्ट, आसानी से समझ में आने वाला)

Mnemonics:- saaf saaf perceive ho rha hai

Aman Sir English



Syn:- clear, lucid, intelligible

Ant:- confusing, obscure, ambiguous

Eg:- She spoke in a perspicuous manner, leaving no room for confusion.

ABNEGATE :- To give up a right desire or privilege willingly often for moral or spiritual reasons. (त्याग करना, छोड़ देना)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- ab nhi karunga non veg ko ate



Syn:- renounce, relinquish, forgo

Ant:- accept, claim, retain

Eg:- The monk decided to abnegate worldly pleasures in search of inner peace.

EXIGUOUS :- Extremely small in amount or size. (बहुत कम मात्रा वाला)

Mnemonics:- exiguous gas bachi hai jaldi se exit karo

Aman Sir English



Syn:- scanty, meager, minimal

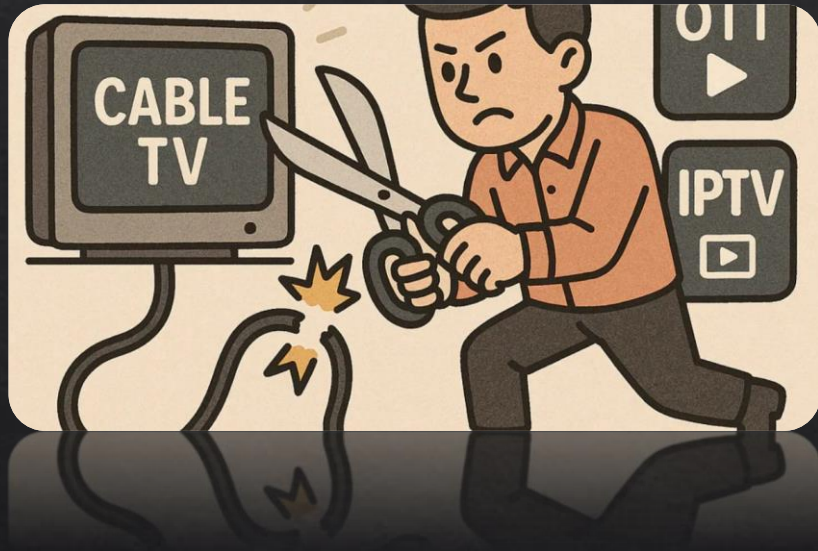
Ant:- abundant, ample, plentiful

Eg:- The villagers survived on an exiguous supply of water during the long drought.

IMPLACABLE:- Impossible to calm down or forgive. (बिल्कुल न मानने वाला)

Mnemonics:- Implacable father ke gusse me cable hi katwa di

Aman Sir English



Syn:- unforgiving, relentless, merciless

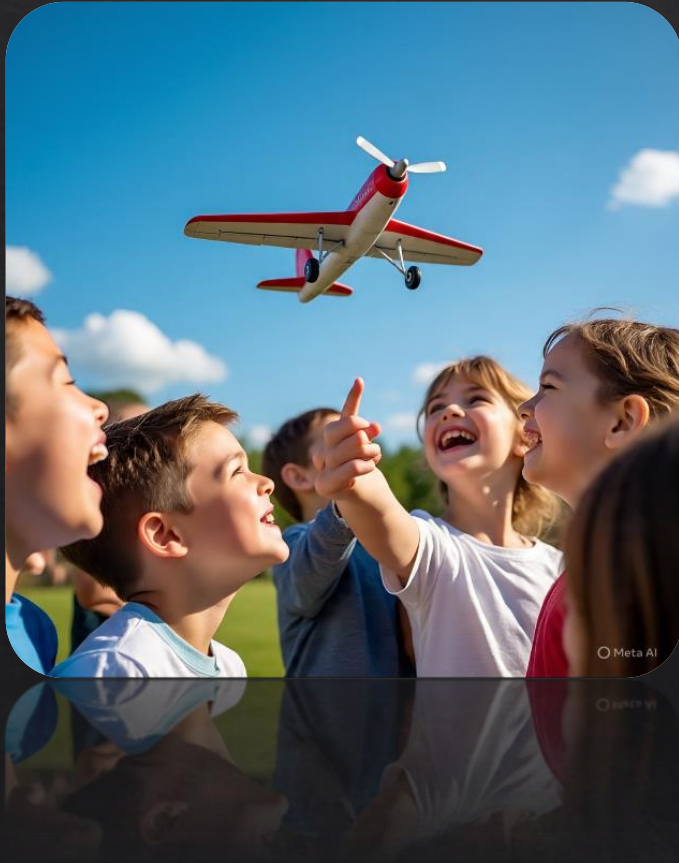
Ant:- forgiving, merciful, lenient

Eg:- He remained implacable, refusing to forgive even after a sincere apology.

EXHILARATION:- A strong feeling of happiness excitement or joy. (अत्यधिक खुशी और उत्साह)

Mnemonics:- Itni HILARious feeling ki andar se excitement bahar aa jaye

Aman Sir English



Syn:- joy, excitement, elation

Ant:- sadness, depression, gloom

Eg:- She felt a rush of exhilaration as the plane lifted off into the sky.

SENTIENT:- Able to feel sense or experience emotions and sensations. (अनुभूतियाँ महसूस करने वाला)

Mnemonics:- senses ke through feel kar sakne wala

Aman Sir English



Syn:- conscious, aware, sensitive

Ant:- unconscious, insentient, unaware

Eg:- Humans are sentient beings who can feel pain joy and emotions deeply.

CORUSCATE:- To shine brightly with flashing or sparkling light.
(चमकदार रोशनी बिखेरना)

Mnemonics:- Core se uthi light SCATTER ho kar chamak rahi”

Aman Sir English

Syn:- sparkle, glitter, flash

Ant:- dull, fade, darken

Eg:- Her eyes coruscated with excitement as the results were announced.

FELICITOUS:- suitable or right and expressing well the intended thought or feeling/happy (बहुत उपयुक्त और सार्थक)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- I feel it is apt for us



Syn:- apt, appropriate, well-chosen

Ant:- awkward, unsuitable, inappropriate

Eg:- When my friend and I get together, we always enjoy felicitous Conversation.

PERFIDIOUS:- Deceitful and untrustworthy especially by betraying trust. (विश्वासघात करने वाला)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- :- parai aurat pe fida hoke wife ka trust tod dia



Syn:- treacherous, deceitful, traitorous

Ant:- loyal, faithful, trustworthy

Eg:- The king was destroyed by the perfidious acts of those he trusted most.

CHICANERY:- Tricky and dishonest behavior used to deceive people. (धोखेबाज़ी भरी चालबाज़ी)

Mnemonics:- chikni chupri baate karke chalaki kari/ chicken curry ki jagah kauaa curry

Aman Sir English

Syn:- trickery, deceit, fraud

Ant:- honesty, fairness, integrity

Eg:- The lawyer exposed the chicanery used to mislead the court and delay justice.



DELETERIOUS:- Causing serious harm or damage.
(गंभीर रूप से हानिकारक, अहितकर).

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- daily tala hua khana teri health ke liye deleterious hai.



Syn:- harmful, damaging, injurious

Ant:- beneficial, harmless, helpful

Eg:- Using cheap chemicals in food production proved deleterious for consumers.

Aman Sir English

Incandescent :- Glowing brightly because of heat or showing intense excitement or emotion. (तेज चमकता हुआ, जोश से भरा)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- :- Candle bhi incandescent hoti hai



Syn:- glowing, radiant, fiery

Ant:- dull, dark, unexcited

Eg:- Our incandescent Christmas lights illuminate the living room.

Redolent :- making somebody think of something /smelling strongly of something (याद दिलाने वाला, सुगंध से भरा)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- :- inn red roses ki smell redolent hai



Syn:- fragrant, evocative, aromatic

Ant:- odorless, unscented, bland

Eg:- The candy shop was redolent with the rich smell of chocolate.

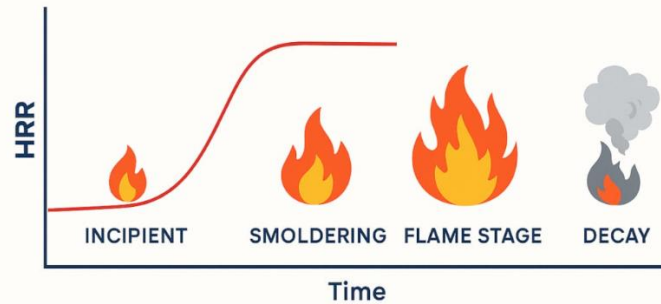
Incipient :- Just beginning to exist or develop. (शुरुआती अवस्था में, आरंभिक)

Mnemonics:- initial point

Aman Sir English

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Syn:- beginning, emerging, nascent

Ant:- mature, developed, complete

Eg:- Doctors detected the disease at an incipient stage, making treatment more effective.

Encomium :- speech or piece of writing that warmly praises someone or something (स्तुतिवाक्य, किसी की प्रशंसा में बोले/लिखे गए शब्द)

Aman Sir English

Mnemonics:- Inhone community ke bhut kuch kiya hai isliye inko encomium (tribute) dena chahiye

Syn:- badger, brag, browbeat

Ant:- criticism, blame, condemnation

Eg:- At the ceremony, an encomium was read to recognize her outstanding work.
